

The Susquehanna Chorale

The Susquehanna Chorale, founded in 1981 by Artistic Director Linda L. Tedford, has been widely recognized as one of the outstanding choral ensembles in the United States. The 40-voice auditioned chamber choir is committed to the highest standards of artistic interpretation of repertoire from many styles and time periods.

The group has performed a number of East Coast premieres as well as commissioned works from today's finest contemporary composers. Past seasons have included performances at Chautauqua Institution in upstate New York, the PA State House of Representatives, the Washington National Cathedral, and conventions of the American Choral Directors Association. The Chorale has toured Great Britain, Switzerland, Austria, and Germany, and celebrated its 40th anniversary with a tour of Ireland in July 2022. The Chorale performs regularly with the Harrisburg Symphony Orchestra and as part of the summer series at the historic Mt. Gretna Tabernacle.

Awards include Chorus America's highest honor, the *Margaret Hillis Achievement Award for Choral Excellence*, and a tie for second place in the 2020 American Prize Competition. Four of the group's recordings received consideration for a Grammy nomination.

The Chorale co-sponsored the Central PA Choral Festival for 17 years, bringing internationally known conductors to Central Pennsylvania. Its Educational Outreach Program currently includes four training choirs serving hundreds of local students from third grade to the first year of college and offers a conducting internship for college music majors.

Linda L. Tedford

Artistic Director, Founder, and Conductor

Linda L. Tedford is the Artistic Director, Founder, and Conductor of the award-winning Susquehanna Chorale, established in 1981. She developed the Chorale's Educational Outreach program which now reaches hundreds of local student singers annually. Ms. Tedford is Professor Emeritus, Director of Choral Activities, at Messiah University in Grantham, PA. Choirs under her leadership have performed at regional and state conventions of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) and the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association (PMEA); for the Legislature and Governor of Pennsylvania; and in several European venues. Her work is featured on over 16 professionally produced recordings, and her choirs appear regularly with the Harrisburg Symphony Orchestra.

In 1994, Ms. Tedford and the Susquehanna Chorale received Chorus America's highest lifetime award, The *Margaret Hillis Achievement Award for Choral Excellence*, and in 2020, tied for second place in the American Prize competition. Ms. Tedford received ACDA-PA's Elaine Brown Award for Choral Excellence for outstanding lifelong work in the choral art, Theatre Harrisburg's *Award for Distinguished Service to the Arts in the Capital Region*, and Central Penn Business Journal's *Women of Excellence Award*.

Ms. Tedford holds a Master of Music degree in Choral Conducting from Temple University, where she studied with internationally renowned conductor Robert Page. She pursued additional study at Westminster Choir College, as well as with prominent conductors Robert Shaw, Gregg Smith, and Dale Warland. As a

member of the Mendelssohn Club of Philadelphia, she performed with the Philadelphia Orchestra under the direction of Eugene Ormandy, Ricardo Muti, and Claudio Abbado. She served as a member of the Choral/Opera Panel for the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, and she has been the Community Choruses Repertoire and Standards Committee Chairperson for ACDA in Pennsylvania and in the Eastern Division. She is an active member of Chorus America and the American Choral Directors Association. Ms. Tedford frequently serves as a clinician and guest conductor.

Pianist, Susquehanna Chorale

Daniel L. Dorty is Director of Music and Organist at Derry Presbyterian Church in Hershey. He attended Messiah University in Grantham, Pennsylvania, where he majored in organ performance. Mr. Dorty maintains a private studio, teaching organ, piano, and voice and frequently serves as a collaborative pianist and organist throughout the region. His private teachers include Linda L. Tedford, Helen-Louise Wagner, Philip Shuman, Randall Williams, and Shawn Gingrich. Mr. Dorty is a member of the American Guild of Organists and the American Choral Directors Association.
