

INFANT CLASSES

Register based on your baby's age when the class starts.

Talk about bonding, brain development, milestones, daily routines, feeding, sleep and more.

Families stay together the whole class. No one is separated.

Class registration is limited: Each child may register for one ECFE class (7+ weeks) and one Saturday class. This helps us serve more families.

The Fourth Trimester

(Birth to 12 weeks)

The first 12 weeks after your baby is born are very important for you and your baby. This class helps you understand what to expect, gives you helpful resources and lets you know that challenges are normal.

You will weigh and measure your baby, watch their growth and learn about sleep, bonding, development and mental health. Join us to connect with other families, share experiences, learn and grow together.

Infant classes

(Birth to 18 months)

Spend time with your baby in a space made just for infants. Meet other families and enjoy play, songs and support.

Learn about bonding, brain growth, baby milestones, feeding, sleep and daily routines. Get ideas for play and tips to support your baby's development.

Infant Massage

(Birth to 9 months)

Use gentle massage to connect with your baby. Learn how to understand your baby's signals and use massage to help with sleep, digestion, brain growth and bonding.

BIRTH TO FIVES CLASSES

For children birth to five-years-old at the start of the class.

Multi-age classes are for families with children from birth to fiveyears-old. You will explore together through activities that engage every age and stage. Parent discussions cover topics like milestones, positive guidance, sibling relationships, screen time and more, tailored to the group's interests.

Infants under five months stay with their parents during discussion time. Separation for older children depends on the group's needs.

Class registration is limited: Each child may register for one ECFE class (7+ weeks) and one Saturday class. This helps us serve more families.

Adventures with Dad

Enjoy time with your child in a class full of fun, learning and connection. You will also talk about parenting and what it's like to be a dad or father figure.

BIPOC Parenting Community


EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING

PRESCHOOL & PREK

Support your child's first school experience with a curriculum aligned to district kindergarten standards. Licensed teachers create inclusive classrooms and partner with families on learning goals. Choose flexible morning or afternoon classes, two to five days per week, at multiple locations.

Preschool is available for children who turn three by Sept. 1 at three locations. Pre-K is available for children who turn four by Sept. 1 at seven locations, with possible free transportation. Tuition is based on family income and scholarships are available.
