What is the food like?

Just like you, we like good food! The daily breakfast is usually an extensive buffet selection. We specially select the included dinners, not just those in your hotel but also special ones in authentic local taverns, restaurants, bistros and beautiful wine estates. Sometimes leisurely, feature lunches are also included. We purposefully leave a few evenings free for you to discover your own local restaurant or bistro.

Can you cater for special dietary needs?

Yes, of course. Please provide your dietary needs on your Traveller Information form at the time of booking. Once you arrive and begin your tour please reconfirm your dietary needs with your Tour Manager. What time do I need to get up each morning?

Later! It is rare we start a day before 8:30am. Our longer stays mean you are not constantly checking in and out of hotels all the time and packing and unpacking your bags is not a repetitive chore. The pace is so much more relaxed and most mornings you have time for that second cup of coffee over a relaxing breakfast.

What standard and size of coaches do you use?

We use first-class, full-size touring coaches with 40 – 45 seats. This means where the average group size is 22 travellers, everyone gets a window seat and a spare seat! WiFi is available on most coaches and there is an on-board toilet for emergencies. Note: Occasionally we may also use day charter coaches for sightseeing and in rare cases when touring groups numbers are below 15 we may use a smaller coach, without a toilet.

How much walking is involved on your tours?

Our tours require a moderate level of fitness due to the unique places we visit and stay. On some occasions coach drop off points are 10 minutes or so walk away from an old town centre. If you are joining us on one of our walking tours we recommend comfortable shoes and that you are able to walk at a moderate pace.

Prices stated are in NZ\$D (or \$AUD if you are based in Australia and accessed our albatrosstours.com.au or albatrosstours.com websites) and are current at the time of publication. The most up to date pricing is available on our website. The price includes accommodation, transportation and other inclusions as per the published itinerary.

Prices shown are our standard prices. Where permitted by law, a surcharge may apply for certain payment methods and will not exceed our cost of acceptance. Payment options and any applicable terms will be confirmed prior to payment.

International and domestic airfares and airport/hotel transfers are not included unless specifically stated. Costs associated with passports, visas, vaccinations, insurance, meals (other than those stipulated), emergency evacuation costs, gratuities, and all items of a personal nature are not included.

Price Surcharges

We reserve the right to vary the cost of your travel arrangements prior to commencement of circumstances beyond our control such as the imposition of fuel surcharges or new or amended Government charges.

We also reserve the right to vary the cost of your travel arrangements due to currency fluctuations. However, we will not vary the cost for currency fluctuations once full payment has been received by us and we will absorb the first 2% of any negative currency fluctuation.

Deposit

A 10% non-refundable deposit per person is required within 7 days (unless otherwise stated) of us accepting your booking. A 10% deposit also applies to pre and post accommodation if selected.

The deposit represents a fee payable to us for services associated with the processing and confirmation of your booking and any consultations on travel arrangements that we may provide to you. Because these services are provided as soon as we confirm your booking, the deposit is non-refundable other than where we cancel your travel arrangements for reasons other than Force Majeure (see below).

Please note that we may not hold any services for you until we receive payment of your deposit, meaning that services may become unavailable, or prices may increase, in which case you will be responsible for paying the increased price, and we will not be responsible if services become unavailable.

Final Payment

Payment in full must be received by no less than 90 days before commencement of your trip. Note: some trips may require payment (including full payment) earlier or in additional instalments and this will be advised with the booking confirmation.

For late bookings (bookings within 90 days of departure), full payment is required at the time of request. You acknowledge that we may not be able to confirm services, in which case we will provide you with a refund.

If you fail to make payment by the due date, we will remind you to make payment. In addition

to the payment, you will also be responsible for any costs imposed on us by suppliers resulting from late payment. If we do not receive payment within 7 days after the reminder, you will be deemed to have cancelled your booking.

Cancellations by You

We require written notice and will make refunds to you less the cancellation fees in accordance with the table below, calculated from the date which we receive written notice:

- Over 90 days before commencement: 10% Deposit
- 90 days to 60 days before commencement: 50% of the booking value
- Within 59 days or no show: 100% of the booking value less any amounts designated as payable to third parties specifically to deliver your travel arrangements which the third party agrees are no longer payable*

*As we will be subject to third party terms and conditions, we make no guarantee that any third party will agree that amounts are no longer payable

You agree that the deductions and cancellation charges specified above are reasonable, represent a genuine pre-estimate of our loss and are required to protect our legitimate business interests. For group departures, a transfer of a confirmed booking to another departure date at your request is deemed to be cancellation of the original booking.

Illness or Vaccination Status Preventing Travel

If due to any illness, suspected illness or failure to satisfy any required tests or vaccination requirements: an airline or other common carrier refuses you carriage; a hotel or vessel refuses to accommodate you; or

- we or our suppliers (acting reasonably) exclude you from the trip and you are consequently prevented from commencing or continuing your trip, then:
- if you have already commenced your trip, we will provide you with reasonable assistance to arrange alternative travel arrangements or to continue the trip. This will be at your cost.
- if you have not commenced your trip then we regret we will not be in a position to provide such assistance.

We will not be liable to refund the cost of your trip (or any part of it) because we would have already paid (or committed to pay) suppliers and we would have already performed significant work preparing for the delivery of your trip and servicing your booking. We will not be responsible for any other loss or loss you incur in connection with your booking (for example, airfares and visa expenses) if you are prevented from commencing or continuing your trip in these circumstances.

We strongly encourage you to purchase travel insurance that adequately responds to cancellations and curtailments associated with illness and other unforeseen events as soon as you have paid your deposit.

Other Cancellations

In these Booking Conditions, the term Force Majeure means an event or events beyond our control and which we could not have reasonably prevented, and includes but is not limited to: (a) natural disasters (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide, volcanic eruption), adverse weather conditions (including hurricane or cyclone), high or low water levels; (b) war, armed conflict, industrial dispute, civil strife, terrorist activity or the threat of such acts; (c) epidemic, pandemic; (d) any new or changed law, order, decree, rule or regulation of any government authority (the events in (d) being "Government Restrictions").

Force Majeure – Prior to travel

If:

- in our reasonable opinion we (either directly or through our employees, contractors, suppliers or agents) determine that your travel arrangements cannot safely, lawfully or reasonably proceed due to a Force Majeure event; or
- you give us notice no more than 14 days prior to commencement of your booked travel arrangements that you cannot reasonably make use of them due to Government Restrictions.

then we may:

- reschedule your travel arrangements, but only if you are agreeable to the rescheduled arrangements; or
- cancel your travel arrangements, in which case our contract with you will terminate.

If we cancel your travel arrangements, neither of us will have any claim for damages against the other for the cancelled arrangements. However, we will either:

- issue you with a credit equal to payments received by us for the cancelled travel arrangements, redeemable within 12 months of issue against any travel services offered by us; or
- refund payments attributable to the cancelled travel arrangements less: (a) unrecoverable third party costs and other expenses incurred or payable by us for the cancelled travel arrangements; (b) overhead charges incurred by us relative to the price of the cancelled travel arrangements; and (c) fair compensation for work undertaken by us in relation to the cancelled travel arrangements until the time of cancellation and in connection with the processing of any refund.

Please note that our ability to issue you with a credit may be dependent on our suppliers issuing corresponding credits to us. We cannot guarantee that our suppliers will issue corresponding credits and so in such circumstances we may opt to pay you a limited cash refund as outlined.

Force Majeure – During travel

If due to Force Majeure we cancel travel arrangements after your trip has commenced, we will provide you with a refund of recoverable third party costs for cancelled travel arrangements only.

Force Majeure – General

Where a limited cash refund is to be paid by us, we will use reasonable endeavours to recover payments from third parties attributable to your booking, but we make no guarantee that we will be able to recover these payments either partially or at all. If after we have paid you a limited cash refund (or after we determine that no cash refund is currently payable) we recover payments from third parties attributable to your booking, then we will pass on this payment to you.

We will not be responsible for any other loss or costs you incur in connection with your booking (for example, airfares, insurance and visa expenses) if your trip or particular travel arrangements are cancelled due to an event of Force Majeure.

If we provide you with any alternative services or assistance where travel arrangements are cancelled or rescheduled due to Force Majeure, then you agree the amount to be refunded to you will be reduced by the value of these services and assistance.

You acknowledge that the terms in this section are reasonably necessary to protect our legitimate business interests. We strongly encourage you to purchase travel insurance that adequately responds to cancellation and rescheduling risks associated with Force Majeure events as soon as you have paid your deposit.

Other Cancellations

If we cancel your travel arrangements for reasons other than Force Majeure or a failure to satisfy minimum numbers (see below), you will be offered (at your election) a refund of all funds paid, or the offer of a trip of substantially equal quality if appropriate.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, we will not be responsible to you for any other expenses or loss you incur resulting from our cancellation.

Minimum Numbers

Our group tours are based on a minimum number of passengers travelling. If a tour fails to satisfy minimum numbers, the tour may be cancelled or re-costed. We will give you notice no later than 60 days prior to the tour's commencement. If the tour is re-costed, you will have the option to either accept the new cost or to cancel your booking. You must make this election within 14 days of receiving notice from us. If the tour is cancelled or if you cancel your booking in these circumstances, we will at your election refund all payments made or credit payments towards alternative arrangements.

We will not be responsible for any other travel arrangements affected by, or any additional costs incurred, as a result of cancellation in these circumstances.

Amendments by You

We will endeavour to accommodate amendments and additional requests. You acknowledge that these may not be possible to fulfil, and for group departures a transfer of a booking to a different departure is deemed a cancellation. An **amendment fee of \$250** will be levied to cover communication and administration costs for any changes to bookings. You will also be required to pay any additional costs charged by suppliers.

Amendments by Us

Prior to travel

Due to the dynamic nature of the travel industry, we may occasionally need to make amendments or modifications to the itinerary and its inclusions and you acknowledge our right to do this. Most changes will not be significant. If we become

aware of any significant changes to your itinerary or its inclusions that materially detract from the overall characteristics or value of the tour (where we determine it can still proceed), then we will notify you within a reasonable time and you may elect to:

- proceed with the tour, in which case we will refund you an amount attributable to the reduction in value determined by us acting reasonably; or
- cancel your tour, in which case we will refund you all payments received by us at that time.

If you do not make an election in writing within 7 days of us notifying you of the significant change, then you will be deemed to have elected to proceed with the tour.

During travel

You acknowledge that the itinerary, modes of transport, accommodation and/or the trip's inclusions may need to change during your trip due to local circumstances beyond our reasonable control, including road conditions, poor weather, changes in transport schedules, and/or vehicle breakdowns. You agree that we have the right to pass on any costs we incur for alternative arrangements we put in place for your benefit in these circumstances.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you have a suitable level of health and fitness to undertake the trip of your choice.

To the fullest extent permitted by law: (a) we will not be responsible for any omissions or modifications to the itinerary or the inclusions due to Force Majeure or other circumstances beyond our control happening after we have accepted your booking. This includes any loss of enjoyment or distress caused by omissions or modifications; (b) if you are entitled to any compensation for any modifications or omissions, then you agree it will be reduced by the value of any alternative services we provide which you accept; and (c) we will not be responsible to you for any other expenses or loss you incur resulting from any amendment or change to the itinerary or its inclusions.

Unused and Denied Services

No refunds will be made for any travel arrangements included in your tour not utilised, whether by choice or because of late arrival or early departure other than due to our negligence. This includes the failure of transport to operate according to schedule, which we disclaim responsibility for.

We will not be responsible to you for any loss or expenses you incur (including loss of enjoyment or the costs of alternative arrangements) if you are denied services by a supplier. No overseas supplier or associate is authorised to promise a refund on behalf of Albatross Tours for unused or denied services.

Exclusion from Tour

We reserve the right, acting reasonably, to exclude you from the tour at our discretion if: (a) you fail to comply with our (or any of our supplier's) reasonable instructions (which may include personal hygiene directions consistent with generally issued medical guidance to reduce the incidence of infectious diseases such as COVID 19, influenza or severe colds); (b) if you threaten the safety of yourself, our or our suppliers' personnel or other tour guests; (c) if we (or our supplier) acting reasonably consider that you are materially interfering with the other travellers' enjoyment of the tour; or (d) if you require special assistance which we cannot reasonably provide due to an existing medical condition or disability not previously disclosed to us. If we exclude you from the tour, then you will not be entitled to any refund for any remaining portion of the tour and you will be responsible for all costs associated with your onward travel.

Client Names – Exactly as per Passport

For security reasons, airlines and our overseas suppliers require names to be given exactly as stated in your passport. If you do not advise the correct information and we have to re-issue airline tickets or other documentation, then you will be responsible for any fees charged (such as airline cancellation charges or re-issue fees) in addition to our own reasonable administration fees.

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of your booking that you are adequately insured for the duration of your trip. We recommend comprehensive travel insurance to cover cancellation, medical requirements, luggage, repatriations and additional expenses. The choice of insurer is yours. Please check the details within your product disclosure statement and ensure you are aware of its conditions and omissions. We strongly suggest you purchase insurance at the time you pay your deposit. This is because cancellation fees and charges are payable from that time. If you have any questions please contact our European Tour Specialists.

Transportation

When group sizes are considered too small to use a full-sized touring coach, we reserve the right to use a smaller coach. Smaller coaches and any vehicles used for local transfers and occasional day excursions may not have toilet facilities on board. Wi-Fi on coaches is usually available but cannot always be guaranteed. Individual country and EEC laws regarding coach transportation and safety, including the wearing of safety belts where applicable, will be abided by at all times. Failure to abide by local laws may result in you being excluded from the tour.

Where a vehicle is equipped with seatbelts, you must always wear your seatbelt when onboard. To the fullest extent permitted by law, our liability to you for any personal injury, death or other damages or claims arising from an accident or incident involving a vehicle you are travelling on as part of the tour will be limited or excluded to the extent your failure to wear a supplied seatbelt contributed to or caused your injury or death.

Accommodation

Due to the dynamic nature of the travel industry, we may need to substitute hotels, vessels and other forms of accommodation with properties or vessels of a substantially comparable or higher standard. We will endeavour to minimise substitutions. You acknowledge that these substitutions will not be considered a significant change.

Solo Travellers

We contract double rooms for sole use for guests paying the solo traveller price. Whilst we contract the same standard of room for all guests, it is at the discretion of the hotel as to the allocation of rooms. Due to the unique nature of our contracted hotels, allocated rooms may vary between guests and Solo Travellers may receive a smaller sized double room or in some cases a twin-bedded room.

The Solo Traveller price reflects fees and charges passed on to us by our suppliers.

Child Travellers

The minimum age for a child travelling with Albatross Tours is 5 years of age and they must be accompanied with their parent and/or guardian on the same Albatross tour.

Children under the age of 12 years are not encouraged (with the exception of our European Christmas Markets, Christmas Tours, Christmas Holidays and New Year Tour programmes) and are accepted or rejected at OUR sole discretion. If you have any questions please contact our European Tour Specialists.

Twin and Triple Share Rooms

Throughout much of central Europe traditional hotels sometimes offer 'French or Continental Twin' sleeping arrangements whereby two separate single beds and mattresses are attached together, often sharing a single headboard. Many modern hotels now have glass-walled bathrooms, with or without privacy curtains. Please consider this when booking a twin share room.

Triple rooms may be available on festive tour departures only. If available, triple rooms may consist of one double, or two single beds and the third bed may be a 'rollaway' or sofa bed, which is not suitable for an adult. Therefore, triple share rooms are only suitable, when the third person is 15 years or younger at the time of travel. In most cases, the addition of a third bed will result in the space in the bedroom being limited.

We will not be held responsible for any distress or loss of enjoyment as a result of such arrangements or failure to recognise the possibility of such arrangements prior to booking.

Porterage

Unless otherwise stated, hotel porterage for one suitcase per person is included at each stay during your tour. Porterage is not included on the first or last days of your tour when arriving or departing your hotel independently.

Passports and Visas

It is a requirement that you hold a valid passport and any required visas for your trip. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are in possession of the necessary documentation to comply with the laws and regulations of the countries to be visited.

Vaccinations

It is your responsibility to obtain the necessary vaccinations and preventative medicines as may be required for the duration of your trip. Whilst compulsory vaccination is not required to join an Albatross group tour, we do highly recommend you keep your vaccination status as updated as possible. Naturally you will have to comply with the requirements of the countries we will be visiting, and restrictions may apply.

Please note, it is your responsibility to check the updated rules and regulations of the countries you will be visiting to ensure you are allowed entry and are able to be on tour.

Health and Fitness

Minimum Mobility Requirements

It is your responsibility to ensure that you have a suitable level of health and fitness to undertake the trip of your choice.

Albatross offers a range of tours to a variety of destinations. A number of tours include visits to hilltop towns, which may have some steep, uneven cobblestoned streets or castles, and attractions with steep staircases and no lifts. Additionally, some larger cities only provide coach passenger drop off points beyond the city-wall limits of old town centres. A reasonable amount of walking will be involved on all tours and therefore a certain level of fitness and mobility is required. If you have walking difficulties or mobility limitations our tours may not be suitable, and we reserve the right not to accept your booking. If you have any concerns or wish further information or clarification on minimum mobility requirements, please call our office, or write to us via email via info@albatrosstours.com.au.

Existing Medical Conditions

If you have a medical condition which may reasonably be expected to increase your risk of needing medical attention, or which may materially affect the usual conduct of the trip, then you must advise us prior to or at the time you make your booking request.

We may request you to provide an assessment of your medical condition from a qualified medical practitioner. If the assessment indicates that you are not fit to travel or will require special assistance which we cannot reasonably provide, then we may cancel your booking. Provided you notified us of your medical condition prior to or at the time you made your booking request, we will provide you with a full refund of funds received [less an administrative fee of \$250].

If you fail to provide a medical assessment within a reasonable time, then this will be considered a cancellation by you and cancellation fees and charges will apply (See 'Cancellation By You' section above).

New Medical Conditions

You must advise us of any new or changed medical conditions which may reasonably be expected to increase your risk of needing medical attention, special assistance, or which may materially affect the usual conduct of the trip.

We may request you to provide an assessment of your medical condition from a qualified medical practitioner. If the assessment indicates that you will require special assistance which we cannot reasonably provide or if you fail to provide a medical assessment within a reasonable time, then this will be considered a cancellation by you and cancellation fees and charges will apply (See 'Cancellation By You' section above).

Non-Disclosed Medical Conditions

If any non-disclosed medical conditions mean that you will require special assistance which we cannot reasonably provide, then we, acting reasonably may exclude you from the trip. This will be considered a cancellation by you and cancellation fees and charges will apply (See 'Cancellation By You' section above).

Dietary Requirements

Special dietary requests are required to be notified to us within 7 days after we confirm your booking. We will endeavour to communicate your requirements to relevant suppliers. However, we cannot guarantee requests will be met by suppliers. It is your responsibility to check that meals and beverages do not contain any allergens. We expressly disclaim any liability for meals or beverages that contain allergens other than in circumstances where we have been negligent.

Image Release

When on tour, we may take photographs or make recordings of you and your activities that identify you. We reserve the right to use any images and/or recordings for promotional and marketing purposes. You consent to this use and acknowledge you will not be entitled to any payment or other compensation. If you do not consent to the use of your image or likeness, please advise us at least 21 days prior to the commencement of your tour.

Independent Additional Services

We are not responsible for any additional activities or excursions which are not included in the booked itinerary or which we sell as agent for the principal operator. Any advice or recommendation made by a guide or local representative is made in good-faith, based on known information, and does not make us responsible for the acts or omissions of the principal operator of the excursion or activity.

Accuracy

Albatross Tours makes every effort to ensure the accuracy of information in our brochures and on our website, in many cases we rely on third parties to provide us with information and descriptions and we cannot reasonably verify all information and to the fullest extent by law will not be liable if the description or information is inaccurate.

White Christmas Tours – Snow

A large part of Central Europe is normally covered by snow over Christmas time. Please note that weather conditions vary from year to year and snowfalls cannot be guaranteed.

Northern Lights Tours – Aurora Borealis

The Aurora Borealis ('Northern Lights') are a natural phenomenon and reliant on nature and clear skies. We will be staying in the North of Scandinavia and Iceland at some of the very best Aurora spotting locations. The chances of catching a wonderful display are very high however, this cannot be guaranteed.

Acceptance of Risk

You acknowledge that travel involves personal risks which may be greater than those present in your everyday life. This could be as a result of the adventurous nature of your trip or the visiting of destinations which present geographical, political or cultural risks and dangers.

You should consult guidance issued by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) applicable to the destinations within your itinerary for Australian customers, and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT) for New Zealand customers. You acknowledge that your choice to travel is made having had the benefit of DFAT or MFAT guidance, and you accept any additional personal risks associated with your travel. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we disclaim any liability for these risks.

Responsibility

Services supplied by independent suppliers

Where a third party over whom we have no direct control (Independent Supplier) is the supplier of travel arrangements that form part of your trip, you acknowledge that our obligations to you are limited to taking reasonable care to select a reputable Independent Supplier and arranging for them to provide those travel arrangements to you. Independent Suppliers over whom we have no direct control could include but are not limited to airlines, railway and cruise operators, hoteliers, independent transport companies (i.e., vehicles not operated by us), attraction and venue operators, restaurants and common carriers.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, we will not be responsible to you for any loss, damage, personal injury or delay attributable to the actions or omissions of an Independent Supplier and not caused by our negligence. Any claims you have in this regard must be made against the Independent Supplier. You acknowledge that the Independent Supplier's liability to you may be limited by their own terms and conditions.

Services we directly supply

To the extent only that we are the principal supplier to you of travel arrangements or other services which we control, then we will provide those travel arrangements and services with reasonable skill and care.

We will only be responsible for our employees in the course of their employment, and for our agents and contractors (where we have direct control over them) if they were carrying out the work we had asked them to do.

We will not be responsible for any loss, damage, claim or expense caused by the acts or omissions of yourself, of any other third party not connected with the provision of the travel arrangements or services, or due to an event of Force Majeure.

While we endeavour to meet scheduled arrival and departure times, we cannot guarantee this. We will not be responsible for any loss or additional expenses you incur for any missed connections/services attributable to delays.

Recreational services

If we supply any recreational services to you, then to the maximum extent permitted by law we exclude any liability for death, physical injury or mental injury or any other liability referred to in section 139A(3) of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) resulting from our failure to comply with a guarantee that applies under Subdivision B of Division 1 of Part 3-2 of the *Australian Consumer Law*.

This exclusion does not apply to significant personal injury caused by our reckless conduct.

Recreational services means services that consist of participation in the activities referred to in Section 139A of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth), being participation in:

- a sporting activity or similar leisure time pursuit; or
- any other activity that:
 - involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and
 - is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure.

General liability limitation

We do not guarantee our schedule. We will not be responsible for any loss or additional expenses you incur for any missed connections/services attributable to delays outside of our control.

You acknowledge that travel arrangements or services which comply with local laws and regulations will be deemed to have been properly performed, even if this would not be considered the case in Australia.

Australian Consumer Law and corresponding legislation in State jurisdictions in certain circumstances imply mandatory guarantees into consumer contracts ("Consumer Guarantees"). These Booking Conditions do not exclude or limit the application of the Consumer Guarantees other than to the extent they can be excluded or limited, in which case we limit or exclude the Consumer Guarantees to the fullest extent possible. Other than the Consumer Guarantees, we disclaim all warranties and guarantees.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, our maximum liability to you under these Booking Conditions, in tort (including negligence) or at law is limited to arranging for the travel arrangements to be resupplied or payment of the cost of having them resupplied.

Complaints

In the event of a problem with any aspect of your travel arrangements you must tell us or make our representative or our local supplier aware of such problems as soon as possible. This is so we or our suppliers have had the opportunity to put things right on the ground.

If you notify us of a problem during travel and we haven't resolved it to your satisfaction, please follow this up in writing within 30 days from the end of your travel arrangements. This is so we have the opportunity to pursue the claim with our own suppliers (if relevant). Making a complaint does not guarantee any outcome.

If you fail to follow this procedure, this may limit your rights to make a claim.

Deemed Acceptance

If you place a booking on behalf of another party, you represent and warrant to that you are duly authorised to provide the agreement and consent of the other party to be bound by these Booking Conditions. You agree that you will be responsible for any loss or damage we incur if this is not the case.

General

The contract between Albatross Travel Group Pty Ltd trading as Albatross Tours and you is governed by the laws of the State of Queensland. Any disputes shall be dealt with by a court with the appropriate jurisdiction in Queensland. If any provision of these Booking Conditions is found to be unenforceable, then to the extent possible it will be severed without affecting the remaining provisions.

Any personal information you provide to us will be collected, stored, used, protected, and shared in accordance with Australian Privacy Principles, and our Privacy Policy, which is published here www.albatrosstours.com/privacy-policy.
