# Bible Study Hour




**Classes for every age.


All children's and youth classes are in a secure, welcoming space led by caring, safety-trained, background-checked teachers and helpers.

On December 13, experience our walk-through outdoor program bringing the Christmas story to life. Bring a friend, volunteer behind the scenes, or join the cast.




### Nursing Home Christmas Bags

Financial Peace University is coming in January! Learn practical, biblical steps to manage money and find freedom.




### Valentines Dinner
