Provider access legislation:

Use **Which Way? Your Way!** to ensure your school is compliant

The updated Provider Access Legislation came into force in January 2023 and mandates schools to provide opportunities for all young people to explore all the pathways available.

The Skills and Post-16 Education Act 2022 sets out new requirements on the number and types of encounters schools will need to deliver for their pupils with providers of technical education or apprenticeships

The legislation specifies schools must provide at least six encounters with approved providers of apprenticeships and technical education for all their students:

- Two encounters for pupils during the 'first key phase' (year 8 or 9) that are mandatory for all pupils to attend
- Two encounters for pupils during the 'second key phase' (year 10 or 11) that are mandatory for all pupils to attend
- Two encounters for pupils during the 'third key phase' (year 12 or 13) that are mandatory for the school to put on but optional for pupils to attend

This new legislation will become a key mechanism to further help learners understand and take- up, not just apprenticeships, but wider technical education options such as T-Levels and Higher Technical Qualifications.

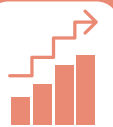

Apprenticeships

An Apprenticeship is a real job, with a real employer, where the apprentice will work full-time whilst learning new skills and knowledge towards an Apprenticeship standard.

Apprenticeship benefits

Apprenticeships are an exciting paid option for anyone wanting to gain experience, upskill or change career because they offer the chance to earn a wage whilst they work and study.

*Changes to the way that Apprenticeships can be delivered from 2025 mean that some can be completed in a shorter timeframe; instead of the traditional 12 months some may be shorter in duration, but will still require a minimum of 8 months.

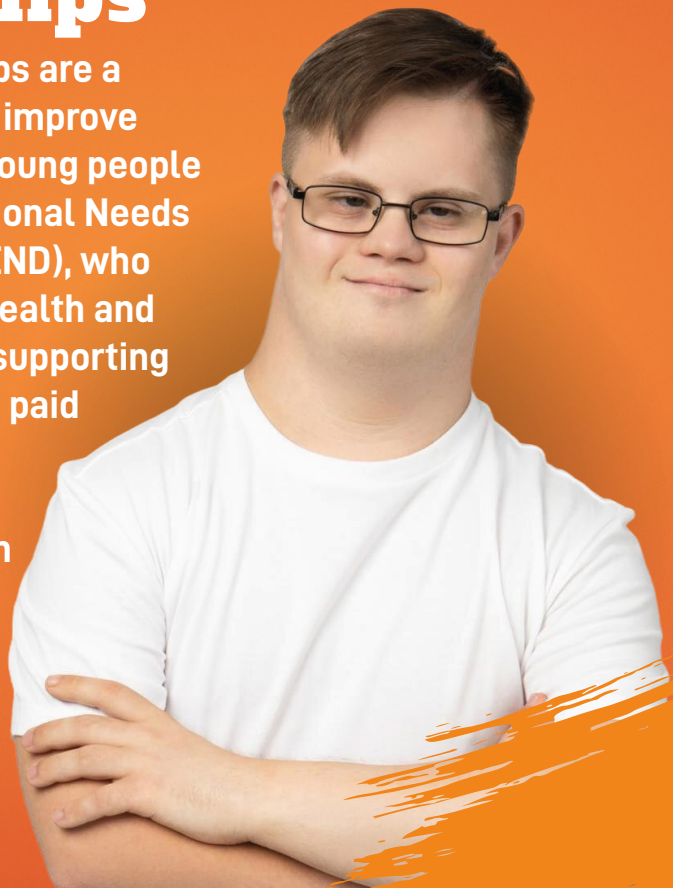

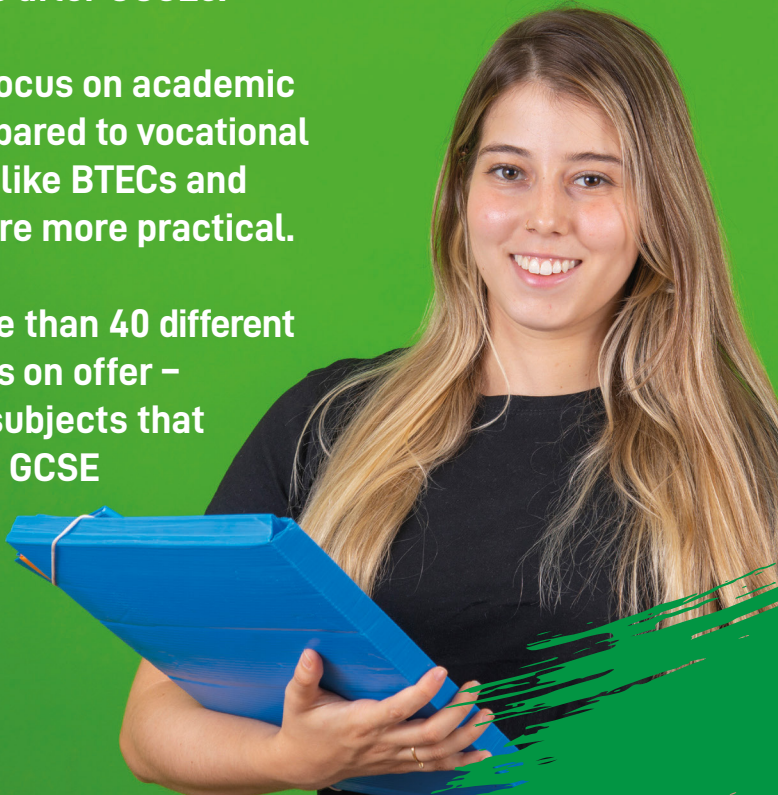

A Levels

Short for Advanced Level, A Levels come after GCSEs.

They usually focus on academic subjects, compared to vocational qualifications like BTECs and NVQs, which are more practical.

Vocational & Technical Qualifications (VTQs)

VTQs are practical qualifications designed to give you the skills and experience you need for a certain job. They might be for you if you have a strong interest in working in a particular industry. There are a wide range of different subjects available across the different VTQs.

Each subject focuses on a specific job or a broad employment area, such as childcare, engineering or IT.

After completing a VTQ you could follow a range of progression routes, including entering the world of work, going onto higher education or progressing onto an Apprenticeship.

Some L3 Qualifications Attract UCAS Points

Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQs)

HTQs are Level 4 and 5 qualifications. They focus on high quality technical skills that are sector specific and include qualifications such as HNCs, HNDs, and Foundation Degrees.

HTQs are a quality mark and have been approved by Skills England against employer standards. Employers outline the skills they need and help develop the standards for HTQs.

HTQs are usually taught in the classroom and teach industry relevant practical skills. They provide a blend of academic and technical learning and projects.

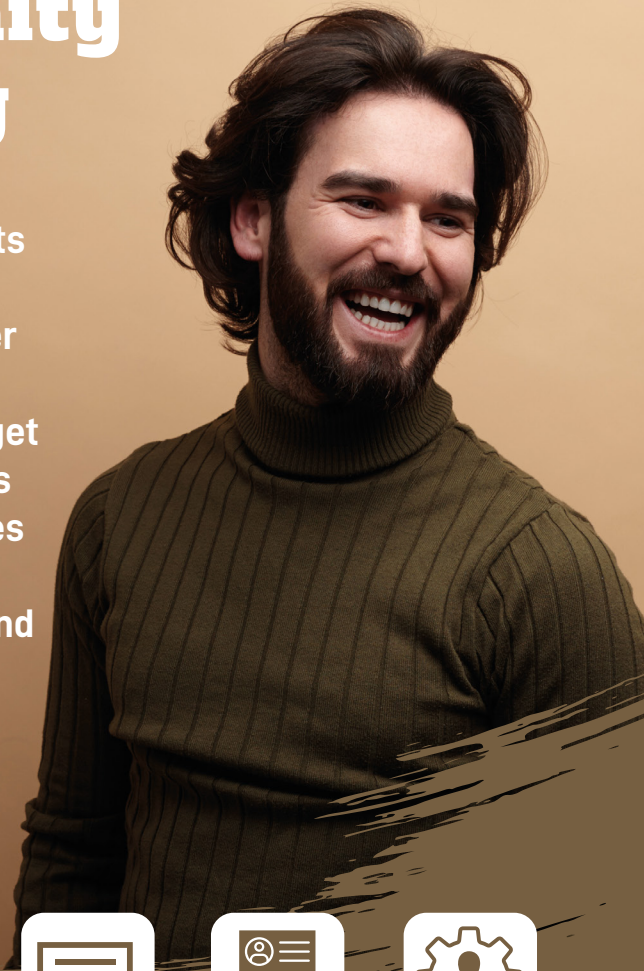

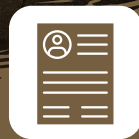

V Levels

V Levels... a new route into vocational pathways...due to launch September 2027. These exciting new qualifications, which will be equivalent to existing Level 3 qualifications, will allow young people to explore their career options by enabling them to experience a specific sector such as IT, Early Years & Finance.

V Levels will combine academic learning (as in A Levels), technical skills and industry work placements (as in T Levels), and practical learning (as in BTECs). Each V Level is equivalent to one A Level and can be studied in a variety of ways, e.g. you may decide to study two subjects at A Level and undertake a V Level alongside them. V Levels aim to create a joined-up, high-quality pathway that bridges academic study and practical skills.

Who can study V Levels?

The first learners able to study V Levels will be young people who were in Year 9 during the 2025–2026 academic year. The courses will be rolled out, initially, in three core subjects: education, accounting and finance, and digital systems and data. More subject areas will follow over time.

What do they consist of?

V Levels are different to T Levels (which require studying a single large vocational area), as they are the size of one A-level. This allows young people (16-to-19-year-olds) to "mix and match" them with other routes and qualifications e.g. A Levels or other V Levels.

Studied over two-years V Levels will combine external exams with substantial non-exam assessment (coursework or practicals) to ensure a mix of theoretical knowledge and practical competence. V Levels include attached industry work placements with employers playing a role in assessment, and perhaps project setting.

V Levels focus more on hands-on project work and applied content rather than purely exam-based assessment.



Where can they take you?

A key role for V Levels will be their use to support progression onto higher study, higher technical training or Apprenticeships. They aim to provide structured routes into several post-16 destinations, including:

- University degrees (designed for HE progression)
- Higher or degree Apprenticeships
- Direct skilled employment

By studying V Levels you will gain:

- Practical skills and knowledge needed for your future career
- Flexibility to combine different subjects
- Qualifications that are recognised by employers, universities and higher education institutions
