## Welcome to the Lab's Bimonthly Newsletter: The Antitrust Dispatch!

The GW Competition & Innovation Lab continues to go from strength to strength. Our Senior Fellows and affiliates are our strongest asset. This was proven once again last month when one of our Senior Fellows, [Professor Philippe Aghion](#), received the Nobel Prize. Together with Peter Howitt, Professor Aghion was awarded the Nobel for his groundbreaking theory of sustained growth through creative destruction. Professor Aghion seminally conceptualized the relationship between competition and innovation as an inverted U-shape—a concept that lies at the heart of our Lab, which is named in its honor.

I am particularly delighted by Philippe's Nobel. Not only has he joined our Lab and contributed actively to its success (see page 5 of this newsletter), but I am also personally affiliated with his Farhi Innovation Lab at the Collège de France in Paris, where he teaches. This cross-relationship underscores the shared research agenda between our Lab and Professor Aghion's, and it promises to generate even more collaborative projects in the future.

Professor Aghion's elegant modeling of Schumpeterian gales of creative destruction within a framework of endogenous growth shows that profound conceptual questions can still be addressed through rigorous yet accessible research. This is precisely what we aim to foster at the GW Competition & Innovation Lab, through our regional initiatives and diverse projects where academic excellence meets conceptual clarity and practical relevance.

Beyond Professor Aghion's Nobel in September, our Lab had an exceptionally active month—highlighted by the inaugural conferences in London and Brussels for our UK Regional Initiative and EU Regional Initiative, led respectively by Miroslava Marinova and Oscar Borgogno. We also continued to engage with responses to several EU consultations.

### Satellite Event Spotlight




