O tournament rules O

The 2023 Bend Winter Classic Youth Ice Hockey Tournament is a USA Hockey sanctioned tournament. All USA Hockey rules apply unless otherwise stated in this document.

GENERAL RULES

- The zero tolerance rules for coaches, players and parents for abusive or inappropriate language, gestures, and behavior will be observed as outlined in the USA Hockey rules..
- Team rosters are frozen after the team's first game of the tournament. Score sheets must be signed by all coaches on the bench prior to the start of each game.
- CONDUCT. Coaches, Team Managers, volunteers, players and spectators may not argue with any
 USA Hockey Official, on or off the ice. If there is a complaint, then the complaint must be brought
 to the tournament director for resolution.
- **SPORTSMANSHIP.** Fighting will not be tolerated; USA hockey rules apply with suspension from the game and subsequent game. Match penalties will result in expulsion from the tournament. A hearing may be held with a written request from the team within one hour of the game. All decisions are final and information shall be forwarded to players' affiliates.

GAME FORMAT

- 3-minute (3:00) warm-up for all games.
- 1 hour games consisting of three 16-minute (16:00) run-time periods. Stop time will be used in
 the last two minutes of any game with a goal differential of two or less (hard 1-hour game curfew
 applies). NO mid-game ice scrapes.
- 1 minute (1:00) break between periods—after the horn, officials will wait 10 seconds then blow the whistle; if teams are not lining up to face off immediately after the officials' whistle, a minor penalty for delay of game will be issued to the offending team(s).
- One, 60-second TIMEOUT per team, includes overtime (OT) period. No second timeout will be
 added for overtime if a timeout was used in regulation. (same rule for lining up at the conclusion
 of timeout applies as stated above.)
- OVERTIME period will be played if necessary in BRACKET and CHAMPIONSHIP games only.
- NO OVERTIME period for ROUND-ROBIN games.
- All rosters are frozen after commencement of the first tournament game.
- It will be the decision of the referee or Tournament Director to run the clock in order to maintain the schedule.
 - » Prior to the third period, if the timekeeper and referee feel there is insufficient time to play the period as listed, the referee will notify both teams that it is necessary to shorten the period by a specific number of running clock minutes.
 - » If a 6-goal differential occurs at any time during play, subsequent goals will continue to be recorded on the official scoresheet, but NOT be shown on the scoreboard. Consequently, if at any time the score returns to a 6-goal or less differential, the standard scoreboard posting format will resume.

PENALTIES. All USA Hockey rules for penalties shall apply.

- MINOR PENALTIES will be two minutes (2:00) in length and will carry over into OT periods.
- MAJOR PENALTIES will be five minutes (5:00) in length and will carry over into OT periods.

STANDINGS. Team ranking for bracket play will be determined by the total number of points earned by teams during round-robin play.

- Teams can earn points in several ways during the tournament—the emphasis here is sportsmanship and hard work. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - » Two (2) points for a win; One (1) point for a tie; zero (0) points for a loss.
 - » One (1) point for the FIRST goal scored in the game
 - » One (1) point to the team with the lowest penalty minutes in each game. If both teams have no penalties, each will be awarded One (1) point. Further, if both teams have the same number of penalty minutes, no extra point will be awarded.
- Tiebraker points will be awarded as needed, to further determine ranking in bracket play.
 Tiebraker points will be awarded as follows:
 - » One (1) point for the lowest total number of goals allowed in round-robin play
 - » One (1) point for the lowest total number of penalties assessed in round robin play, if necessary.
 - » One (1) point for fastest goal scored in any round robin game, if necessary.

OVERTIME PERIODS

- » First OT period will be a One, 5-minute (5:00), running-time, 5 vs 5 sudden OT death period.
- » 1 minute (1:00) break prior to starting OT and teams will switch sides.
- » Timeouts will be allowed in overtime only if it was not used during regulation time..
- » Penalties will carry over.
- 2nd OT Period (if needed), will be a 5-min 3 vs 3 sudden death OT period; the goalies will NOT switch sides.
- 3rd OT Period (if needed) will be a 3 person shootout, followign these rules below::
 - » Teams must immediately proceed to their benches except goaltenders, who will remain in their nets.
 - » Each team must designate **three(3) shooters**; a player in the penalty box at the end of OT is not eliqible for the shootout.
 - » The Home Team chooses who will shoot first.
 - » The first player from each team will alternately take their shot with the second and third following. When all players have taken their shots, the results will be tallied.
 - » The team with the most goals will be the winning team.
- Extra shootout rounds will be played until a winner is determined; a player may not shoot twice
 until all skaters on their team have taken their shot.
- All decisions of the Tournament Director are final. All disputes concerning rules and judgment
 applied on ice by an on-ice official will not be overturned by the Tournament Director. The
 Tournament Director will administer the tournament rules, player eligibility, discipline and any
 other disputes or issues.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to add to, amend or remove any Bend Winter Classic Youth Ice Hockey tournament procedures, policies, rules or regulations.







