At Nimmo Bay, guests are given time and space to reflect, relax, and reconnect with nature. By tuning into the rhythm of all these surroundings and having experiences that make it easy to embrace the wisdom of the ocean and forest world, any distraction, guests can truly escape.

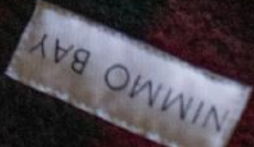
