ARTIST STATEMENT

After retiring, I was finally able to dedicate time to pursuing my artistic aspirations, which had been present since my youth. This marked the beginning of my exploration into sculptural techniques and the utilization of materials such as concrete and timber. After visiting Chihuly's exhibition in Kew Gardens and Tremenheere Gardens in Cornwall I became interested in how sculptures can interact with the exterior environment.

My early fascination with the simplification of forms observed in tribal and ancient art motivated me to create my own interpretations of masks and totems using materials like concrete, bamboo, and wood, with the intention of placing them in outdoor settings.

The stark reduction of form seen in Brutalist metropolitan architecture near my home, in contrast with the natural surroundings, inspired me to combine forms, textures, and patterns in my artwork. My sculptural pieces engage in a play with the viewer's perception of positive and negative space, and their interaction with light and darkness, as well as soft and sharp elements. A minimalistic color palette is utilized to allow each shape to convey its unique presence. Presently, my preferred medium is timber, including both softwood and plywood. My sculptures and reliefs are treated with chalk paint and protected with a soft wax or varnish finish.

ABSTRACT SCULPTURES

My preferred material to currently work with is timber and my favorite color is black. The sculptures are treated with chalk paint and protected with a soft wax (indoor) or varnish (outdoor) finish.






