On the edge of The Cotswolds is the historical market town of Deddington, just 10 minutes from M40 junction 10, it's ideal for a cultural visit, shopping and sports - with Oxford, Burford, Stratford-upon-Avon, Blenheim Palace, Bicester Village, Soho Farmhouse and Silverstone all within easy reach.

Deddington's pretty Market Square is a bustling destination with a wide variety of independent businesses, including an art gallery, fashion boutiques, hotels, pubs, restaurants, beauticians, bicycle shop, food hall, coffee shop, award winning farmers market and free parking.

The village itself is steeped in history, dating from Saxon times. Deddington's former 11th Century Castle was home to Odo, Bishop of Bayeux (half-brother of William the Conqueror) although the Castle no longer exists, the Castle Grounds offer a lovely dog walk, place to picnic and space to play. Parts of the ruins are believed to have been used in the structures and fireplaces of the many local Coaching Inns.

We hope you will find this brochure inspiring and useful. Deddington is a wonderful location for a holiday or a day out and we look forward to welcoming you.

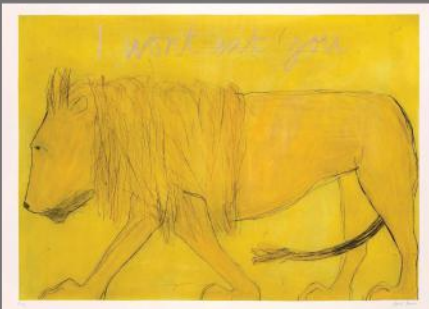


Offering affordable original art in an historic building, The Old Town Hall, in the centre of Deddington.

THE DEDDINGTON ARMS HOTEL

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HISTORY - A SNAPSHOT

Back in the 11th century, Deddington was more prosperous than Banbury, taxes were higher, daily life included luxuries.....though being perched on a hill ultimately meant trading became trickier than in the Cherwell Valley below. Hey-Ho, Deddington has remained quaint and unspoilt, with a plentiful history.

Deddington Castle was built in the 11th Century for Odo, Bishop of Bayeux, half-brother to William the Conqueror.

Deddington became a market town in the 12th Century, with pigs and sheep sold in the market place and horses traded in Horse Fair, as recorded in One of the Hundred Rolls of King Edward I. The Castle was reported as being in ruins in the 14th century :(

Sheep! In 1454 sheep were overburdening the commons, with each local man owning 200. Sheep were known as 'walking money' for their meat and fleece.

In the 16th century Deddington residents paid more tax than those in Banbury, as after the Black Death Deddington became very prosperous again.

In 1644 King Charles I stayed at Castle House during the first English Civil War.

In the 18th century Deddington was famous for clock and watch making (Fardon family).

In the 19th Century The Bowler family invented the hard material Lockes of London used to design a new protective riding hat. The Bowler Hat was named after this Deddington family and their former home (opposite Jocy) is now named 'Bowler House'.

In 1956 Lord of The Rings author JRR Tolkien opened Deddington library - which is still a hive of library activity today, though used to be the Court House and Prison!

In 1984 BBC drama 'Blott on The Landscape' starring George Cole, Jimmy Nail & Simon Callow was filmed in Deddington Market Place.
