To elevate the atmosphere and provide a seamless auditory experience across multiple areas, the management sought a sound system that would deliver high-quality background music while allowing flexibility in volume control across different zones.



OBJECTIVE

The primary goal was to install a sound system that could deliver consistent and comfortable background music in various sections of the restaurant and surrounding areas. The system needed to be versatile enough to accommodate different volume levels and sources, ensuring an enjoyable experience for diners, conference attendees, and visitors across all areas of the venue.

SOLUTION

To meet these requirements, the Saddle & Spur team opted for the following setup:

- 1 x Soundtown STCA 360-6Z 360w 6 Zone Mixer Amplifier
- 11 x Soundtown Tarvos 65B Wall Mount Speakers

IMPLEMENTATION

The installation was strategically planned to cover five distinct zones within the Saddle & Spur premises:

- 1. Restaurant Area: Three Soundtown Tarvos 65B speakers were installed in the main dining area. This zone allows for a soothing background music level, creating an inviting atmosphere for diners without overpowering conversation.
- 2. Conference Room Upstairs: Two speakers were allocated to this zone, providing clear and balanced audio suitable for both background music during meetings and potential presentations or audio-visual needs during conferences.
- 3. Lower Deck Downstairs: Two speakers on the lower deck ensure that guests who prefer dining outdoors can enjoy the same quality of background music as those inside. This zone adds to the overall ambience while blending the indoor and outdoor dining experiences.
- 4. Upper Deck: Another pair of speakers were placed on the upper deck, offering a similar outdoor experience to the lower deck but at a higher elevation. This area provides a different perspective of the venue while maintaining the audio consistency found throughout the restaurant.
- 5. Outside the Tuck Shop: The final two speakers were installed outside the tuck shop, an area frequented by visitors looking for a quick snack or refreshment. Here, the sound system creates a welcoming environment, even in this more casual setting.

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

Q: What was it like performing your first opera, Aida, with the Free State Symphony Orchestra at just 14 years old?

A: Performing Aida at 14 was a wild ride! Juggling school, homework, and latenight rehearsals, plus giving up weekends, was no joke. Anyone who plays an instrument will tell you it takes serious discipline and hard work. But despite all that, it was an absolute blast. I loved every minute of every opera, symphony concert, and musical I played in. The experience gave me a treasure trove of memories that I'll cherish forever. Plus, it definitely taught me how to function on very little sleep!

Q: Transitioning from classical music to DJing is quite a shift. What motivated you to pursue a career in DJing and electronic music?

A: Oh, totally different worlds—classical music and DJing are like comparing a grand piano to a turntable! But hey, music is universal, and when it grabs you, it's hard to ignore. These days, I even sneak a bit of classical into my DJ sets. It's like mixing up a fancy cocktail with a splash of classical flair!



What really got me hooked on DJing? Well, first off, my best friend is a DJ. Watching her spin was like seeing magic in action—I knew I had to give it a go myself. She's still my DJ hero and keeps me inspired.

Then there was that unforgettable night at a big club event with Fabio and Moon. I was right up front, and when their set dropped this deep bassline that literally made my whole body vibrate, it was like an epic light bulb moment. From that point on, I was all in and determined to make DJing my thing.

Q: You have a deep love for Psy Trance. Can you tell us what drew you to this genre and how it influences your sets?



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A: I absolutely do! Psy Trance was the first genre I was introduced to when I "discovered" EDM and the club scene. At festivals, my friends always knew where to find me. While I did explore other dance floors, I inevitably found my way back to the trance floor, sometimes sooner rather than later. . But that was years ago, when I was just getting into EDM. Since then, my tastes have evolved considerably, and I now find myself playing a lot of House and Techno as well.

Q: How did your experience working in marketing and events management prepare you for your career as a DJ?

A: I think someone with a marketing and events background has a huge advantage, getting into DJ-ing. My experience has taught me how to self-promote and the importance of social media. Understanding the importance of branding and creating a unique identity is crucial. Managing events gave me organizational skills and the ability to handle logistics smoothly, making sure everything runs like clockwork. (Parties and Festivals are definitely something that I will dabble in.)

It's also taught me how to connect with people, understand what they like, and tweak my sets to make sure everyone has a great time. Overall, I think my background in marketing and events has provided me with a solid foundation to navigate my way and make a success of it.

Q: Running your own events company for 16 years must have been quite a journey. What were some of the biggest challenges and rewards during that time?

A: Hahaha, how much time do you have? Let's start with the last part of your question. It's the easiest to answer. The biggest reward for all the hard work, stress, long hours, and little sleep was seeing a happy, smiling customer at the end of the day. That absolutely made everything worthwhile.

Now, regarding the challenges, I'll list my top three:

1. The Loneliness of Leadership:

Running your own business can be incredibly isolating, despite the constant interaction with people in events management. You have staff, but at the end of the day, the responsibility for decisions and finances falls solely on you. Being a perfectionist, I was deeply involved in every aspect of our events, which meant the work never truly ended. However, the flip side is that you're doing it for yourself, and the hours you put in directly impact your reputation and success.

2. Reliable Suppliers: Finding trustworthy suppliers was crucial. I was fortunate to establish strong relationships with reliable suppliers early on. For instance, my AV and sound company has been my go-to for years. Having dependable suppliers makes the job significantly easier and ensures that

customer service remains top-notch.



3. Venue Challenges: Selecting and managing venues was another major challenge. I always conducted thorough site inspections and met with the General Manager and department heads to ensure the venue met our standards. However, even the best hotels could sometimes fall short. In such cases, I found myself micromanaging the venue, which could detract from focusing on my client. Despite these hurdles, these experiences were invaluable and taught me a great deal about adaptability and problemsolving.

Throughout my journey, there were many moments when I thought about writing a book on the highs and lows of event management. The stories are endless, with some being fun and others not so much!

Q: COVID-19 had a significant impact on many industries, including yours. How did losing your company during the pandemic influence your decision to pursue DJing full-time?

A: Losing my company during the pandemic was a tough blow, forcing me to reevaluate my life and prioritize what truly matters. Without the responsibility of running my own business, I suddenly found myself with the time and freedom to pursue dreams that I previously didn't have the capacity for. This challenging period presented the perfect opportunity to focus my energy on my passion for DJing and music production. It allowed me to turn a difficult situation into a chance for personal and professional growth, dedicating myself to a path that brings me immense joy and fulfillment.
