



## CORE-Script (2001)

Anet Jackson blazed the trail for Audio Bible recording. After years of hauling large suitcases filled with scripts, there came time to invent a simpler format. The ability to digitally organize files and filter information, combined with the portability of a laptop, allowed the CORE script to replace paper and serve as the "core" script-building tool for over two decades.



### Proclaimer (2004)

As we record Scripture in more languages, reaching the remaining communities becomes increasingly difficult due to hostility toward Christianity and limited infrastructure. Remoteness paved the way for the Proclaimer. To this day, Faith Comes By Hearing delivers the Gospel on Proclaimers to remote and secure regions all over the world.



## OBT/Render (2016)



## Vessel and AI (2025)

As advancements in technology revolutionized Audio Scripture recording, the need for post-production efficiency became clear. Thanks to innovative partners, a groundbreaking artificial intelligence program-trained in more than 1,000 languages—accelerated the proofreading process. This program utilizes speech-to-text technology to flag potential discrepancies between the text and audio. As Al continues to evolve, editing will become easier and faster.

## **Edge of** The World

In a world looking for hope, our mission is to unlock it for the oral majority. Providing truth in the form of audio Scripture recordings is having an eternal impact across the globe. Our part in all of this? To capture the stories of incredible people and the evidence of lives that are forever changed...This is our journey to the Edge of the World.

You may recognize the opening lines of Faith Comes By Hearing's travel series, "Edge of the World," freely available on YouTube. In season one, viewers traced the footsteps of Bible access pioneers, faithful servants whose lives are spent in recording and distributing God's audible Word in the world's farthest regions. Audiences met courageous men and women who implement Bible engagement through Proclaimers, Acclaimers, and Bible apps. Vivid landscapes, unique cuisine, and fascinating cultures served as the backdrop for life transformation stories inspired by meaningful access to Truth.

In episode three, the team sampled world-renowned coffee, surrounded by Ethiopia's vibrancy, and witnessed the eternal difference God's Word has made. Endrias. our partner from the Bible Society, led the way. For more than 13 years, Endrias has served as Audio Bible Programs Manager, helping thousands connect with Scripture in what he described as Ethiopia's listening culture.

Viewers visited a school that provides a holistic curriculum specialized for sight-impaired children and saw a congregation celebrate as they heard the Audio Bible for the first time. They discovered that prison was no match for freedom in Christ, as Bible engagement empowered incarcerated men and women to rebuild their lives. In a hospital, they learned that the Word comforts and heals bodies and souls because a humble pastor plays the Proclaimer over the PA system and prays with patients. Thousands in Ethiopia have heard God speak their language and given their hearts to Christ.

Ethiopia was just one of several stops on Edge of the World's global adventure to gather true stories of real people and evidence that lives are forever changed by God's Word. The team explored the outcome of Audio Bible engagement and shared more testimonies from faithful partners in several other countries in season one. New and fascinating destinations await in season two of "Edge of the World."









# World-Changing Unity



The sun-baked air draws moisture from the skin. Acacia trees cast long shadows over a well-worn path. In the marketplace, baskets overflow with ripe mangoes, their sweet scent mingling with the smokiness of roasting grain. Laughter rings out as children dart between stalls, their bare feet kicking up clouds of red dust.

Beyond the market, a group gathers in a shaded clearing, waiting. The hum of voices quiets as an elder presses play on an Audio Bible. Suddenly, the words fill the air—familiar to them, perhaps foreign to others, but unmistakably their own. A young girl leans in, her lips moving silently as she takes in every syllable.

Here, in the heart of Africa, faith awakens, truth takes root, and hope rises like the morning sun.

The imposed propaganda aimed at youths in Mukadi's Congolese territory propelled him into the violence of war. Still very much a child, he was forced into armed conflict. Hostility toward enemy tribes consumed him. But God had other plans for the boy.

Mukadi met a pastor who shared the Gospel in audio form and explained the plan of salvation. The young man put his faith in Christ.

Leaving combat came with a price; one Mukadi struggled to pay because he only knew life as a soldier of war. But whenever brutal conflict called, God's Word spoke louder, leading him into a transformed life of peace.

Regular engagement with Scripture in his heart language, Walungu, encouraged and strengthened his resolve to follow Jesus. Mukadi never returned to war. Instead, he has formed more than 20 Bible listening groups where people gather and learn to battle spiritually from the foundation of God's Word.

## "I feel like a new person. God has performed a great miracle in my life."

The night teems with life. Somewhere, a guitarist strums a relaxing tune, blending with the murmur of voices emanating from apartment windows and shop fronts. The warm scent of corn tortillas lingers in the briny breeze from the coast.

In a small courtyard, a gathering has formed, faces illuminated by the flickering glow of a single lantern. A voice begins to speak—not from a pulpit, not from a page, but from a device cradled in a woman's calloused hands. Her grip tightens as the words unfold, clear and certain.


From the Andes to the Amazon, from the Caribbean to Cape Horn—the Word is here, no longer distant, no longer unheard.

"I was ill-bedridden for a long time," Camila tells us. "As I listened to the gospel of John, I felt God's presence deeply. In just one week, I played it seven times. Peace replaced my restless nights, my strength and appetite returned, and I began reconnecting with friends."

She shares that John 15:4-5 spoke to her heart, teaching her the power of relying on God. "Even the doctors were amazed at how quickly I changed," she says. "But I know it was the Audio Bible at work."

Today, Camila finds joy in living again. She has returned to work, to community, and to faith, regularly joining church programs to listen to Scripture. "I feel like a new person. God has performed a great miracle in my life."

Rain taps against umbrellas as locals and foreigners alike rush along wide streets, past temple courtyards and sky-scraping apartments. Motorbikes blur past, their horns swallowed by the steady roar of life all around.

Down an alley, a nondescript home waits. A group begins to form inside—one person at a time to avoid suspicion from the authorities. Once everyone has assembled, a voice low and measured, a voice belonging to someone in their very community, speaks truth from the Audio Bible. Comforting Scripture draws silent tears as men, women, and children long for their Savior's return.

In places where dead, cold religion has reigned for centuries, the Word, warm and alive, whispers the sound of hope, of belonging.

Jaya shares, "I was born blind. My family, desperate to restore my sight, sought healing through gods, goddesses, and witchcraft. But nothing changed. When evangelists visited our home, they shared about Jesus, the divine healer. My family and I, hoping for a miracle, gave our lives to Christ.

"My blindness remained. Disappointed, my mother turned back to her old beliefs-but I held on to Jesus. Then I met Wati, who gave me an Audio Bible. She and Bintang, a church planter, walked me through God's Word, and my faith grew strong.

"Though my physical eyes have not been opened, my heart now sees clearly. Jesus is my salvation, my peace, and my joy. I pray my mother will one day worship Him with me again."

# **EURASIA**/ MIDDLE EAST/ NORTH AFRICA

"I want my friends to know about Jesus, even if they judge me."

Sand drifts along the path and quickly obscures footprints—transience is the norm among the desert communities. Old men, gathered on stone steps after a long day of work, chat in rapid fire as their loosely held cigarettes turn to ash. The aromas of cardamom and strong coffee diffuse the smoke.

A mud-brick residence stands at the end of this history-drenched avenue. The one-room home becomes a beautiful palace as the Acclaimer projects the story of the King. A man leans against the doorframe, enraptured. A child sits cross-legged on the rug and tilts her head as she watches. The words wrap around all gathered like a familiar song.

In a place where words have long been measured and guarded, something sacred transpires - something unshaken, something eternal.

During a film shoot in a secure region, a local pastor brought Faith Comes By Hearing's video team to a modest rural home. The family had recently left the country's major religion to follow Jesus and faced severe persecution—extended relatives rejected them and stole their crops, livestock, and possessions.

Our team showed the family a Gospel Film in their language. As the story of the paralytic whose friends lowered him through the roof to meet Jesus unfolded on a bare wall, the family shared their reactions.

The father said, "You can imagine the challenge of caring for a sick person, but with this film, even those who can't read can feel the power of being with Jesus."

The mother added, "Being a Christian here is hard. The government forbids us from having a Bible, and all the Bibles are in a language we don't speak. Watching this together lets us understand and discuss the Word."

In a rare moment of courage, the teenage daughter said, "I want my friends to know about Jesus, even if they judge me. This film shows that no matter how often we sin, Jesus forgives us."

## "I became a Christian and renounced my life of crime."

Palm fronds rustle as salty breezes drift in from the ocean, a pulsing crash of waves against the reef setting the evening's pace. The fragrance of woodsmoke gradually fills the air. Children laugh and play along the shore as the daylight bids its slow farewell.

In the hush of dusk, a circle forms. A woman presses play. The words that emerge are ancient, but for many, this is the first time they are spoken in the language of home.

From the islands where rhythm is life, where stars shine clear in the dark, a new story unfolds—a story of the Light of the world.

God's Word in audio made a profound impact on Roland's life. His heart changed when he heard Scripture in his mother tongue. Now, he carries the Audio Bible with him and spreads the Gospel in his village in Papua New Guinea.

Roland testifies, "I led the life of a criminal and taught the members of my gang to do likewise. Our terrible actions hurt more people than I can count. But today, I thank the Lord because I heard Him speak Ese.

"I remember how the first chapter of the book of Romans explained God's wrath and convicted me of my godless behavior. I became a Christian and renounced my life of crime. Now, I minister to my former gang members. Please pray I can help my lost brothers realize their need for Christ as I share the Audio Bible with them."

# Celebrating with the Senga

"We just need one matchstick to set fire to the whole bush...by the time you know it, the whole village is set on fire for the Lord."

In 2019, Oral Bible Translation (OBT) ignited a miracle of Scripture access for 120,000 Senga speakers in Zambia. Members of the community eagerly received the responsibility to translate with open hands. Their humble agreement sparked a fire to orally translate the book of Luke into the language of their dreams and prayers. Was God only God for the literate? OBT proved a resounding, "No!"

The Senga Scripture recording was used to adapt a Gospel Film—Faith Comes By Hearing's 1,000th film adaptation—and the flames shot higher. An unrelenting hunger for more of God's Word drove continued translation until every word of every gospel came to life in the Senga language.

But hearts and minds craved more of the Word's purifying fire and guiding light. Translators forged ahead, book by book, until the entire New Testament was illuminated for their Senga brothers and sisters.

The New Testament recording launched with celebration in Lusaka, Zambia's capital. The Vice President herself stood as a beacon of national support and proclaimed the importance of God's Word. Her speech echoed the very heart of our shared vision, not as a formality, but as a personal testimony of passion for Scripture and Zambia's Christian identity.

Meanwhile, in Chama, the heartland of the Senga people, cabinet members flew in. They joined local leaders and thousands of Senga men, women, and children who packed a stifling warehouse and waited hours, never once losing their joy. The people worshiped and responded with vibrant enthusiasm as the minister and guest of honor led songs and emphasized the deep significance of Scripture in their own tongue.

The fire that ignited in 2019 has erupted into a national blaze. The Senga OBT project has become a divine signal flare. Thanks to you and ministry partners in Zambia, dozens more OBT projects are underway, each carrying the torch of Scripture into yet another community. From the fields of Chama to the seat of power in Lusaka, the Word is ablaze, and the people rejoice.




## **Digital Progress:** Reaching a **Changing World**


Through these digital tools, we ensure more people experience God's Word in their heart language, fostering deeper relationships and spiritual growth.


## A Full Measure in Fiscal Year 2025





- Launch of Acts film adaptations, bringing the story of the early Church to life for churches and watching groups worldwide.


