## ABOUT THE RESILIENCE HUB

The Resilience Hub is a dynamic “Community Nest” located in the heart of downtown Albuquerque. Operated by New Mexico Community Capital (NMCC), this newly expanded 4,000 sq ft space is designed to elevate Indigenous entrepreneurship, wellness, storytelling, and creativity. It is more than a venue – it is a living symbol of revitalization, culture, and community empowerment.

## 1. The Gathering Hall

- A high-tech, flexible event space ideal for community events, panels, celebrations, pop-ups, and more.

### Capacity:

- Theater Style: Up to 170 people
- Banquet Style: Up to 120 people
- Open Flow/Reception: Up to 200 people standing

### Included Amenities:

- Existing AV system (16'x9' ft. LED Video Wall, Microphones, Speakers, Conference Accessibility Zoom/Google)
- Modular furniture (Tables, Chairs, Portable Staging, Bar, ADA Stage, Stantions)
- Wi-Fi access
- Podium and presentation equipment
- On-site event support
- Uplighting / Spotlights

### Recommended Uses:

- Workshops, Conferences, Panels, Pop-up markets, Cultural celebrations, Banquets, Video/Book releases

## 2. Podcast Studio in the Resilience Seed Hub

- Perfect for content creators, media teams, and visual artists.

### Capacity:

- Up to 2-4 people

### Included Amenities:

- Podcast-grade audio recording equipment
- Adjustable lighting and backdrop
- Small seating area for interviews or livestreams
- Wi-Fi access

### Recommended Uses:

- Podcast or video interviews
- Art or fashion photography
- Small creative team work session

## 3. Wellness Sanctuary

- A peaceful, intimate setting ideal for mindfulness, reflection, and healing.

### Capacity:

- Up to 5- 10 people

### Included Amenities:

- Soft seating and yoga mats
- Calming décor and plants
- Natural light and tranquil ambiance
- Optional access to sound bowls or guided session leaders

### Recommended Uses:

- Meditation or breathwork sessions
- Mental health workshops
- Intimate support circles or wellness check-ins

## Evening & Weekend Rental Fees

Additional staffing, security, or building access coordination may be required outside of normal business hours (Mon-Fri, 9am-5pm).

Scenario	Additional Fee
Evening Event ending after 7:00 pm	+ \$200 flat rate
Weekend Rental (Saturday/Sunday)	+ \$250 per day
Holiday Bookings	Custom Quote Required

## Tech Support Fees

While AV equipment is included, hands-on tech support is optional but recommended for large or complex events.

Service	Fee
On-site tech support (4 hrs)	\$200
Livestream or hybrid meeting setup	\$200
Additional microphones, cameras, or lighting	Custom quote available

## Cleaning & Reset Fees

To ensure the space is ready for the next event, standard light cleaning is included. Additional fees may apply if:

Service	Fee
Heavy cleaning needed after event (e.g., food, glitter, decor teardown)	\$250
Furniture reset or custom layout changes	\$50 - \$100
Trash not disposed of in bins	\$75

### Main Entrance:

Located off 3rd Street with direct access to the Gathering Hall

### Central Hallway:

Connects all three spaces with intuitive, open navigation


### Breakout Flex Areas:
