


Currumbin Sanctuary - Gold Coast Qld Wild Island Entry Statement

A life-time of Replicating the ART of NATURE



Wild Island is one of the most spectacular native-based Australian themed educational playgrounds ever built in Australia



This is a copy of the concept art of the Currumbin Sanctuary's original entry statement for the adventure playground before they came to Natureworks. I soon convinced them that parents did not want their kids going into a mysterious playground call Predators Island - We charged it to Wild Island - extraordinary don't you think?

Luna Park Entrance The Face Of Luna Park - Sydney



In 1993, Natureworks was commissioned by the Luna Park Trust to faithfully Re-capture the exact personality of the original face.

The original was built with

deteriorating old fashioned material which had failed the test of time. After nationwide assessment of capabilities David Joffe and his team of artists was chosen to re-create the most famous giant face. The result

was spectacular now over 22 years and showing no wrinkles. The design and materials will last another 100 years from now and will still be as young at heart as it was when built.


Sculpting the Eye.

This photo also shows the enormous size of this fun entry statement.

At over 8 metres high we realised that it had to be sculpted in a vertical position so that we could properly assess its progress from the same angle at which it would be finally displayed.

Once the polystyrene sculpture was perfect, we fibreglassed a heavy duty shell over the front of the piece and then applied a coloured texture to the skin of the face. The styrene became sacrificial.

It was delivered by barge vertically across Sydney Harbour just for the fun of it! Yes the photo on the barge was a publicity stunt to provide maximum attention to the re-opening of the park after years of closure.



Natureworks also built the Mountain, the Giant Tumblebug and the domed minarets and many of the other hero features for the park.

Luna Park - Tumblebug 7m High - Entry Statement to Ride





Stage 1 - Original Scaled Model

The Tumblebug of Luna Park in Sydney was rebuilt based on a small plasticine scale replica of the original.



Stage 2 - Building the Body



Stage 3 - Building the Head

The Tumblebug is based on massive steel pipe leg supports, the sculpture was formed in a 10mm mild steel bar frame to which perforated silver builders paper was stapled.

This was then sprayed with a high density polyurethane foam both internally and externally, which was then fibreglassed and colour - gelcoated.

Sea World Resort - Gold Coast Qld Shark Bay - Entry Statement




Shark Bay Sea World exhibit and entry statement



Shark Bay was built by the Natureworks team in 2003. The positive formed rock work was constructed over a six month period for both the shark & pelagic oceanarium and the coral reef habitat tank.

Over 10,000 artificial corals were fabricated to complete the coral bommie diving lagoons, along with kelps, giant clams and numerous soft corals.

The immersive diving habitat was created to allow the public to swim freely in a rich coral reef environment. The shallow touch pools allow the public to get close up to live marine organisms.








Sea World Resort Qld - Polar Bear Shores Entry Statement








Movie World - Gold Coast Qld Wild West Ride

Movie World - Wild West Adventure Ride Entry Sign to Wild West Falls Area.






Movie World - Gold Coast Qld Loony Tunes Ride Entry & Ride




Gondwana Rainforest Sanctuary Brisbane City - Entry Statement and Exhibit



lead the world in education the global community in the desperate need to conserve this dwindling resource.








Sopoong Shopping Mall - Seoul South Korea - Tree of Life - 2008

"Of all the places in the CONCRETE JUNGLE of South Korea"

The irony of this was to pay tribute to the value of trees to the planet, and to make the point of "treading lightly on the planet. This tree was built at a cost of

\$1.7 million in 2008 by a team from Natureworks. The trunk was built on site by the Natureworks Team, but the branches were prefabricated at the Highvale

studios in Samford, Australia and shipped in 10 x 40ft containers to site. This tree rises through 6 levels of a shopping mall in Sopoong in Seoul, South Korea.











The clients' intent was to lay claim to building the largest artificial tree in the world. It is over 11 metres in diameter at the base, through which the public can walk and the diameter where it "breaks through" the ceiling is still 6 metres wide.








Natureworks sculptured an indigenous boy riding the legendary Goori-Goori Bird.

This Giant Koala family on tree trunk was originally sculptured for backbone. It was meshed with the Coffs Harbour Zoo in 1994, but is now situated at Billabong Wildlife Park in Port Macquarie, N.S.W.


bar over a 500mm diameter pipe wire netting and silver insulation foil, then sprayed in five rated PU foam internally and externally, carved to shape and fur textured It was formed in 10mm mild steel in glass fibre reinforced cement

and the exposed painted surface. Now over 20 years old it has another 80 years of life left. It was fabricated in our studios and loaded onto a tandem trailer and delivered to site and craned into position. No Cracks!

Daydream Island Resort - Whitsundays Qld 3 Mermaids on Rocks - Entry Statements



The mermaid statues are named Serenity, Aphrodisia & Infinity, representing respectively mind, body & spirit.



They were commissioned at $1^{1/2}$ times life size by Vaughan Bullivant the creative force behind the new look Daydream after he bought the resort in the late 90's


This entry statement to the Daydream Island Mini Golf Course - depicts the varied habitat of the Australian landscape.








Character Tree - Adds a fun element to the entry of the mini Golf at Carindale Shopping Centre, built in 1990 in Brisbane Qld.



Australian Reptile Park, Ourimbal - N.S.W - Giant Frilled Neck Lizard Entry Statement





This dead ringer "frilly"was formed over a 10mm mild steel bar armature, meshed with wire netting internally and solid trowelled with glass fibre reinforced cement and textured with specially shaped scale trowel stamps. It travelled 650 miles by truck and was craned into position.

No Cracks! It is now over 20 years old and is good for another 50 years at least.




Australian Reptile Park - N.S.W Giant Crocodile God - Entry Statement



At 5 metres high this piece was sculpted in foam and hardcoated in epoxy.


This crocodile God is the entry to the Temple of Doom exhibit at the Reptile Park. (note the live crocodiles in the foreground "serve"the master.

Escape Theme Park - Singapore Giant Earth Spike Entry Statement - 13m High






This 13m Earthspike is prefabricated in 3 hollow sections concertinaed into each other to enable shipping in a 20ft container to Singapore as the entry feature to the park.

The Columns are fabricated in fibreglass to replicate basalt columnar jointing with deep cracks to reveal internal red strobe lighting & the 2m crown is cast in clear fibreglass with a rotating gobo of coloured lights.





The family commissioned Natureworks to design and build the 1 Million exploding volcano entry feature at Dundoora. Every half hour the volcano erupted"as part of an animated show which blew the socks off diners within the restaurants seated over 1,000 people


"Each restaurant has it's own spectacular special effects show, there is the active volcano at Bundoora (the spectacular erupting volcano lights the night sky against the backdrop of the city skyline), the water garden at Ringwood, the musical fountain and, the waterwheel at East Burwood and of course the superb Salty the Seal and King Neptune shows as well as the giant marine aquarium at Cunningham Pier, Geelong." . Large waterfalls and rainforests with creeks and pools enrich the dining experience."








Natureworks - Temple of Doom Entry Statement
