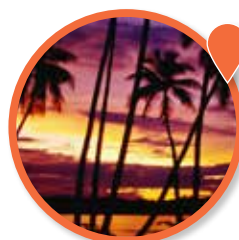
Fiji's Adventure Capital

Culture in Nadi

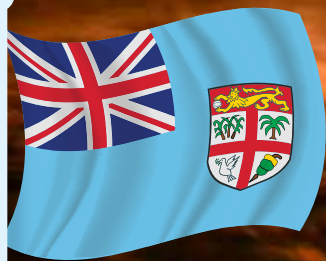

TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Sitting firmly in the tropics, you can expect warm weather all year round. The wet season is from November through to April, and if you don't mind the odd afternoon thunderstorm, this is also the best-value time to travel.

Most resorts in Fiji cater to families, so school holidays are the busiest time to travel.

Fiji is generally the same time as New Zealand. Fiji does not observe Daylight Saving Time.

CURRENCY

The official currency of Fiji is the Fijian dollar (FJD). Major credit cards are accepted in resorts and tourist areas. Tipping is not encouraged anywhere in Fiji, a smile and a thank you is generally enough.

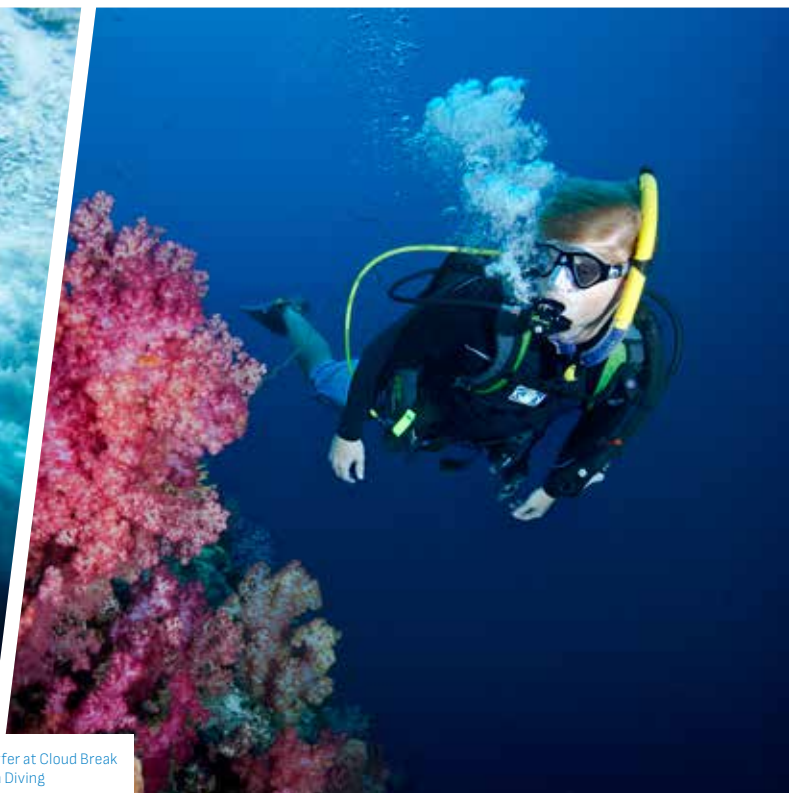

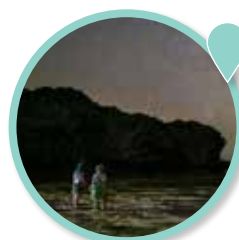
Flagstaff Hill – Norfolk Island

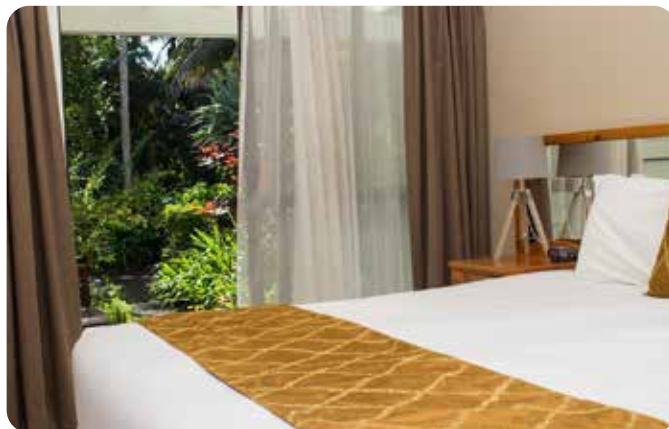
