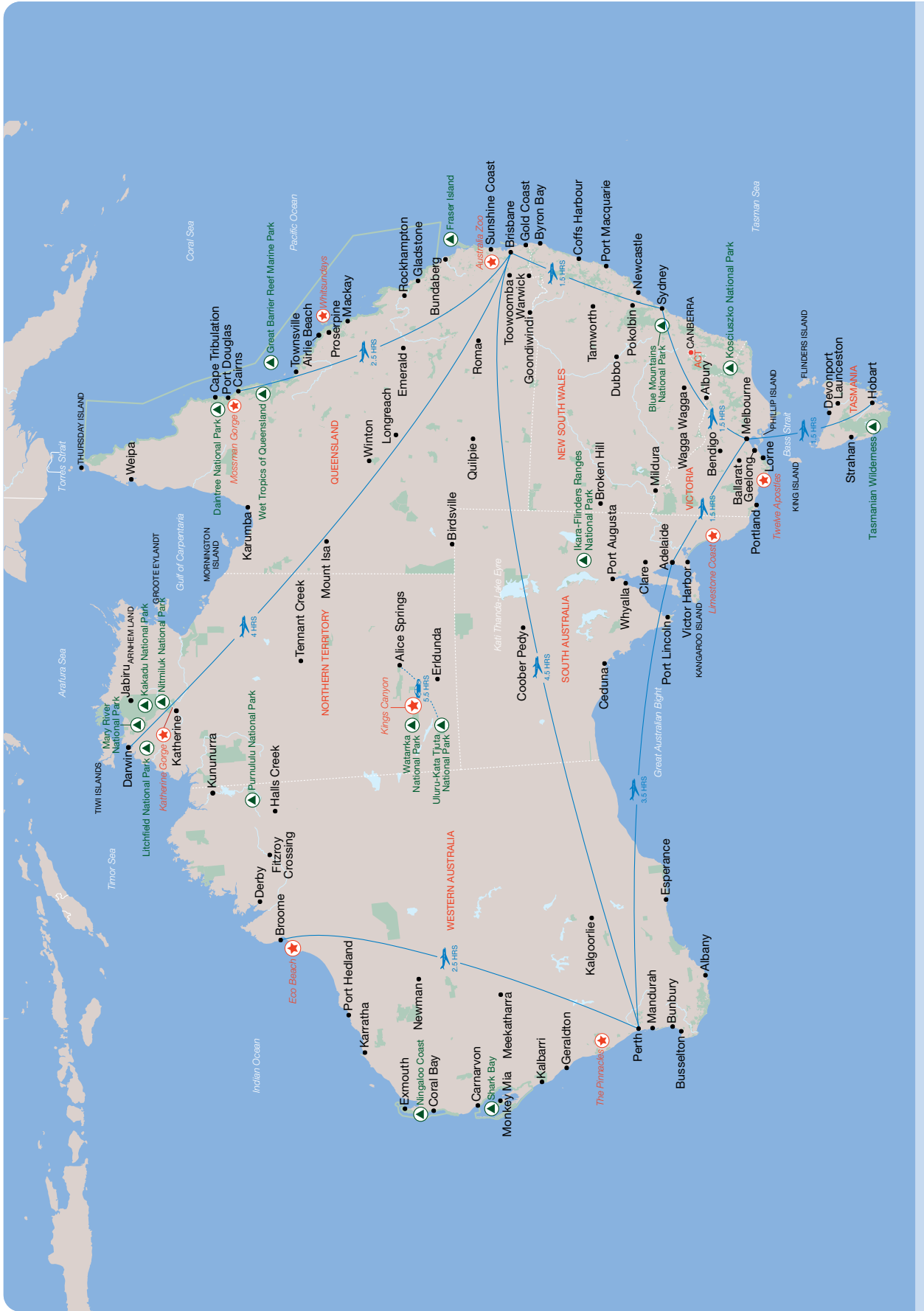

# TRAVEL TIPS

## WHEN TO GO

### Queensland

Queensland has two seasons hot and wet during summer and warm and dry during winter. The Southern Queensland areas of the Gold Coast, Brisbane and Sunshine Coast are popular destinations to visit all year round with subtropical climates. While Tropical North Queensland is hot and wet during summer, making the winter months of May–October the most popular times to visit.

### New South Wales & Australian Capital Territory

New South Wales' climate is mild throughout the year. Travelling from September to November and March to May provides mild sunny weather, bright blue skies and generally less crowds. Australian Capital Territory is a year-round destination however most popular during spring September to November which also features the colourful Floriade Festival.

### Victoria

Victoria has a diverse climate and three distinct climate zones: the dry warmer north-west, the north-east alpine snowfields and the cool and temperate southern and coastal region. Melbourne in the southern region enjoys a variable climate including cool autumn and winter months and a warm summer and spring.

### South Australia

With a mediterranean style climate, South Australia has warm dry summers and mild winters. Warmer in the north and cooler in the south of the state. A visit to Adelaide during the autumn months of March to May will see days of sunshine and mild temperatures with stunning autumn colours in the Adelaide Hills.

### Western Australia

In the southern half of the state including Perth there are four seasons with many sunny days and a warm climate. In the north towards Broome and the Kimberley Region there are two seasons wet in the summer and dry in the winter.

### Northern Territory

The Top End, including Darwin has its wet season November to March and dry season from April to October. The Red Centre has extreme highs during summer and extreme lows during winter at night.

### Tasmania

Enjoying four seasons throughout the year. The summer months of December to February are the best months to travel to Tasmania. Hobart has pleasant average daily temperatures during summer with dry warm days.

Day Light Saving is observed in New South Wales, Victoria, Tasmania, Australian Capital Territory and South Australia.

Queensland is 3 hours; Northern Territory is 3.5 hours and Western Australia is 5 Hours behind New Zealand. Day Light Saving is not observed in Queensland, Northern Territory and Western Australia.
