Editorial for the Newsletter

The journey of Unnati started with a great set of volunteers who wanted to make a difference. We are very proud about this fact because the volunteers over the years have demonstrated resilience, persistence and consistency in every aspect. They have pushed themselves really hard to make a difference.

How many organisations in this country can talk about the admin expenses being less than 5% and yet deliver at these levels and scale? It has been possible only because of the dedicated team Unnati has always had. The entire top management and many in the next levels have been giving pro bono services. I read this somewhere which is so apt for Unnati-- "Volunteers do not get paid, not because they are worthless but because they are priceless".

I want to dedicate this issue to all those volunteers who have at some time or the other contributed to the success of the organisation over the years. There have been volunteers who have participated for a few hours but made a huge impact. We always used to talk of divine intervention and volunteers actually come and show us that there is this power available in the Universe.

The first segment of people I am talking of are the people who have been contributing their time and resources continuously over a long period of time. If you see various segments in Unnati, you will understand that all vertical heads are managed by volunteers. Finance, HR, Operations, IT, Pedagogy, Placements and procurement.

The 2nd segment of volunteers are people who are there for a period of time and are very task driven. They help the organisation immensely. They help reduce the costs while we get the expert to support us and help us cross the line each time we have a mission to complete.

The 3rd segment is the involvement of company officials who as part of the CSR not just support us with funds, but also participate in various activities. This is a growing segment and helps us raise funds. When volunteers from the companies participate and see the impact of the program, we are very happy because this ensures continuity of their support in the years to come.

As of 2023 March we had touched 80000 youths. Our staff strength last September was less than 140 people and while we are attempting 1 lakh youth during this financial year, the number of staff is continuously moving forward. We have crossed over 500 as I write this note.

How do you bring in the mindset of a volunteer in your staff? This will remain the challenge for any organisation. A dedicated volunteer takes responsibility. For the volunteer it is about commitment. There is no compulsion from anyone to make it happen, yet the volunteer pushes oneself to make things happen.

A volunteer puts aside time, money and other interests to make this a part of their mission in life, and delivers.

A volunteer hardly gets recognized because many times they are silently doing their job and moving out.

A true volunteer is sans Ego. The conditions offered many times are not perfect, but they still come and deliver. A volunteer is many times not like the main Chef who gives the final touches but a person who is involved in path breaking work to ensure the continuity of the organization.

He is the true 'Karma Yogi' as described in the Bhagavad Gita.

To make a difference in someone's life, you don't have to be brilliant, rich, beautiful or perfect. You just have to Care.
