
## OUR APPROACH



## MAKING EAST HARLEM BLUE

This map of Manhattan is what drives us in our work to transform outcomes for the children of East Harlem. In the blue shaded areas, residents have a high percentage of college completion, unemployment is low, and a majority of families have health insurance. For families in East Harlem (the yellow section of the map), there are broad and far-reaching consequences of living in an underserved and under-resourced community.



## THE CAMPAIGN **FOR EAST HARLEM**

In 2014, EHTP launched the \$45 million Campaign for East Harlem. The Campaign will help support over 2,000 scholars annually through every step of their education.

#### \$30 MILLION EAST HARLEM **EDUCATION CENTER**

Our plan includes a new 50,000 square-foot comprehensive learning center at the corner of 105th Street and Second Avenue. In addition to housing after-school programs and community spaces, the center will provide a permanent home for our first public charter school, East Harlem Scholars Academy.

#### **\$15 MILLION GROWTH FUND**

The Growth Fund will allocate \$6 million to expand EHTP's after-school and charter schools and develop a Pre-K program, invest \$3 million in our College Scholars program to help future high school graduates finish college, and dedicate \$6 million towards building our operational reserves.

#### THE CHALLENGE

Philanthropist and EHTP Board Member Marilyn Simons and her husband Jim have made a \$15 million investment in EHTP – among the top five individual gifts awarded to New York City K-12 public education, and the largest ever to East Harlem. This gift will match public and private donations dollar-for-dollar up to \$15 million.







#### **INCOME ANALYSIS FY15 | \$4,545,138**




#### **EXPENSE ANALYSIS FY15 | \$4,012,792**

#### **INCOME ANALYSIS FY15 | \$8,195,351**


