Pastor's Corner

Living the Resurrection: Called to Greater Things

Resurrection Sunday has come and gone. The songs were sung, the cross was lifted high, and the empty tomb reminded us of Christ's victory. But now that the celebration is over, what does it mean to live in the light of the resurrection, every day? The truth is, the resurrection wasn't the end of the story—it was the beginning. Jesus's triumph over death invites us into a new way of living, not just a one-time celebration. As His followers, we are called to be **resurrection people**—living lives marked by hope, love, and boldness because God calls us to greater.

Scripture shows that God never calls His people to remain stagnant. He calls us to **greater faith**, **greater purpose**, **and greater love**. One powerful example is the story of **Moses**. When God called Moses to lead the Israelites out of Egypt, Moses doubted his ability. He questioned, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" (Exodus 3:11). But God didn't call Moses because he was perfect—He called him because He had **greater plans**. Like Moses, we may feel unqualified or uncertain, but God's call is not based on our limitations but on His power. The resurrection proves that **God's power transforms weakness into strength, fear into courage, and doubt into faith**. And resurrection allows us to expand our vision.



James Baldwin once said, "If the concept of God has any validity or any use, it can only be to make us larger, freer, and more loving." This speaks to the heart of resurrection living.

The resurrection is about personal salvation and Expanding Our Vision to see the world through God's eyes. It is about stepping into the greater purpose He has for us. And how do we live this out? Romans 6:4 says, "just as Christ was raised from the dead... we too might Walk In Newness of Life." That means shedding old habits and embracing the fruit of the Spirit—love, joy, peace, patience, all of them! We must be bold in faith.

After the resurrection, the disciples were transformed. Frightened men became fearless witnesses. The same power that raised Jesus is available to us. Let's not shrink back. Let's share the Good News with conviction, serve with compassion, and love without limits. Then we must *Live with Hope* – The resurrection proves that death does not have the final word. In a world full of pain and uncertainty, we have unshakable hope. That hope should radiate from how we speak, pray, and live.



As we move past Resurrection Sunday on the calendar, let's not leave behind the meaning of the resurrection. Let it shape our choices, our relationships, and our vision for the world. He is risen—and so must we rise, daily, to the life He's called us to live.







National Museum of African American History and Culture

- In response to President Trump's March 27 executive order criticizing certain Smithsonian exhibits for promoting a "divisive, race-centered ideology," Black churches across the U.S. are rallying to support the Smithsonian National Museum of African American History and Culture. Clergy leaders, including Rev. Robert Turner of Baltimore and Rev. Otis Moss III of Chicago, are encouraging their congregations to make financial contributions to the museum, emphasizing its vital role in preserving African American history. Rev. Turner, known for his advocacy for reparations, incorporated the museum into his recent protest activities, laying a wreath in solidarity. Other church leaders, such as Rev. Jacqui J. Lewis and Bishop Timothy Clarke, have also voiced their support through donations and public endorsements. The executive order, which appointed Vice President ID Vance to oversee efforts to review museum content. has been met with criticism from various quarters, including prominent Democrats, who view it as an attempt to whitewash significant aspects of U.S. history.
- Black churches across the U.S. are coming together to support the Smithsonian National Museum of African American History and Culture in response to a recent executive order by former President Trump criticizing its exhibits as "divisive." Faith leaders like Rev. Robert Turner and Rev. Otis Moss III are urging their congregations to take a stand by contributing financially to help preserve and celebrate African American history. 
