Scenic rides to Jasper... "Where the Buffalo Begins"

Scenic AR 7 is an outstanding serpentine ride out of Harrison featuring all the fantastic scenery a rider should expect from a tour in the Heart of the Ozarks. Every section has a different personality that will not fail to please.

The wonderful free-flowing rivers and streams of the area have sculpted the crooked pathways forming the magnificent highways visitors relish.

In the '70s 'back to the earthers' (aka hippies) moved to Newton County and found kindred spirits among the local hill folk. Both groups enjoyed the natural beauty of the mountains of the county.

In days-gone-by, elk and buffalo freely roamed the valleys and mountains of Newton County. Though the buffalo and elk were hunted out, elk were reintroduced in the mid-1980s.

Today, residents embrace motorcycle tourism as part of the area's economic engine. Thanks to the riders who enjoy the winding roads and scenic beauty, motorcycle-friendly Jasper is thriving.

Top 5 motorcycle safety tips when riding in the Ozark Mountains.

1. Check Your Gear and Bike Before Riding

Before hitting the road, ensure that your bike and riding gear is in top condition. Check tire pressure, brakes, lights, and fluid levels.

2. Watch Out for Wildlife and Road Debris

The Ozark Mountains are home to various wildlife and animals like deer, that can suddenly appear on the road. Hazards, like gravel, can suddenly appear, even where there was none two weeks ago.

3. Be Prepared for Changing Weather Conditions

As in many parts of the country if you don't like the weather wait 10 minutes. Likewise in the Ozarks, changes can come on suddenly.

4. Take It Slow on Twists and Turns

The Ozarks are known for their scenic and often winding roads with sharp curves. Don't be afraid to take a familiarization run first.

5. Plan Your Route and Know Your Limits

Map out your ride in advance and be aware of the distance, road conditions, and available amenities like gas stops and rest areas.

These tips will help ensure a safe and enjoyable ride through the beautiful Ozark Mountains!


