



PART ONE

Voice of Gatosthenes:



PART TWO

LISTEN to the two voices:

ACTIVITY

LISTEN to the two voices:

What do you say? He is a horrible cat after all. Those five will be saved, and the new patient won't be harmed. It's a way out. Remember, he is a murderer.

This is horrible. Even if the doctor is guilty he has repented. He is not a murderer, at least not yet. I agree he is guilty, but he should face the law. He should face a jury and a proper trial. Otherwise you are just as guilty as he is! Who are you to give him the death penalty?
