# DAY 6


## Xi'an

The day starts with a visit to the extraordinary Terracotta Warriors, one of the most remarkable archaeological discoveries of the 20th century. Thousands of life-size soldiers, each uniquely crafted over 2,000 years ago, stand in silent formation to protect Emperor Qin Shihuangdi in the afterlife. Walking through the excavation pits offers an unforgettable look at the artistry, engineering, and history behind this UNESCO World Heritage Site.



## City of Ancient Wonders

In the afternoon, explore the Big Wild Goose Pagoda, a revered Tang Dynasty landmark built to house sacred Buddhist scriptures brought from India. Continue to the Ancient City Wall, the largest and best-preserved fortress of its kind in China, showcasing Xi'an's rich past and strategic importance. A local dinner follows, and the day concludes with the dazzling Tang Dynasty Dinner and Show, celebrating Xi'an's cultural brilliance through music and dance.

## Treasures of Dunhuang

Spend the morning exploring the remarkable Mogao Caves, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to one of the world's greatest collections of Buddhist art. Carved into dramatic cliff faces, these grottoes contain exquisite murals and statues spanning over a thousand years of history. As you walk through selected caves, you'll encounter vivid depictions of Buddhas, bodhisattvas, and ancient Silk Road life preserved through centuries.

In the afternoon, travel to the Sounding Dune and Crescent Moon Spring, an oasis where golden sand mountains rise beside a shimmering crescent-shaped lake. Enjoy a camel ride and take in sweeping desert views from the dune's summit. A Western dinner awaits back at the hotel, followed by an evening visit to the lively Shazhou Night Market.

# Across the Desert



## Ruins & Red Mountains

Visit the Emin Minaret, Xinjiang's largest ancient pagoda and a unique example of Islamic architecture in China. Continue to the legendary Flaming Mountain, a dramatic landscape of red sandstone ridges made famous for its intense heat and striking colors that shift under the desert sun.

Explore the Thousand Buddha Caves and the ancient city of Gaochang, once the capital of the Huigu Kingdom and an important Silk Road oasis. These remarkably preserved ruins offer a vivid look into Turpan's historic role as a center of culture and trade. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and a special dinner hosted in a local home, complete with traditional music and dance.

# Silk Road Engineering

Visit the Karez Well system, an impressive ancient irrigation network that brought underground water to Turpan's farms and sustained life in this desert region. Continue to the Jiaohe Ruins, a remarkably preserved earthen city set between two rivers and once a major Silk Road stronghold over 1,600 years ago. After lunch, transfer to Urumqi, where you'll check into your hotel and enjoy a Western-style dinner.

## Heavenly Lake & Culture

In the afternoon, explore the Xinjiang Regional Museum, home to over 50,000 cultural relics showcasing the diverse history and traditions of the region's many ethnic groups, including the famous 4,000-year-old Loulan Beauty mummy. Continue to the vibrant Xinjiang International Bazaar, a lively marketplace filled with local foods, handicrafts, spices, textiles, and souvenirs. Lunch is served at a local restaurant.

Explore the atmospheric Old Town, where traditional mud-brick homes and narrow lanes offer a glimpse into centuries-old daily life. Here, guests can enjoy a unique cultural experience as local Uighur women demonstrate the traditional osma eyebrow dyeing practice. Lunch is served at a local restaurant, followed by a special dinner to complete this immersive day.
