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THE FEZ & THE FINE PRINT

Greetings fellow Nobles:

Spring is right around the corner which means parade and fund-raising seasons will be upon us.

The Serious Part:

Did you know that pursuant to the Shriners Community Volunteering Guidelines, Shrine Temples, their clubs and units are allowed to raise money and donate money to charities other than the Shriners Hospitals? Under the De Minimis Safe Harbor provision, a Temple, Unit, or Club may raise and donate money to community-based activities up to \$1,000 per year (Cumulative including a Temple, its Clubs, and Units).

Examples of qualified de minimis contributions include:

- Temple sponsoring a children's sports team (e.g. little league) for \$500.00.
- Temple making a \$500.00 donation to enhance a local playground.
- A club or unit donating to a Masonic foundation for \$200.00.
- A club or unit buying \$300.00 in flowers and planting them in a community park.

While the vast majority of our fund-raising efforts are meant to support the hospitals, it is also permissible to make small donations to other worthy organizations.

Did you know that in California bumblebees are legally considered fish? 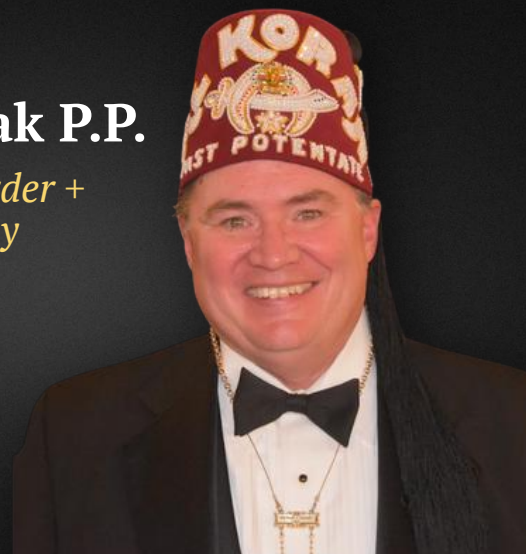

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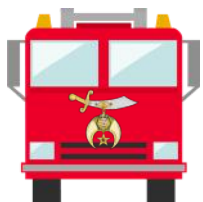

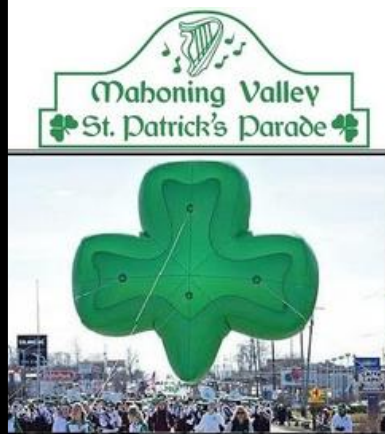

Alison Cernich, Ph.D., named director of Shriners Children's Research Institute

Shriners Children's is proud to announce that Alison Cernich, Ph.D., has accepted the position of director of our Research Institute. In this role, Dr. Cernich will oversee the recruitment of researchers as well as the design and construction of the institute's 150,000 square feet of laboratory space at the Science Square location in Atlanta, Georgia.

An experienced research leader and neuropsychologist, Dr. Cernich most recently served as acting director and deputy director of the Eunice Kennedy Shriver National Institute of Child Health and Human Development at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland. In that role, she helped oversee a broad research portfolio spanning child health, development, women's health, disabilities, and rehabilitation medicine, and contributed to strategic initiatives across NIH.

"We are thrilled to welcome Dr. Cernich to Shriners Children's at this pivotal moment in our journey," said Chairman of the Board of Trustees Leslie D. Stewart, M.D. "As we advance Vision 2035, her leadership will help shape the future of our research enterprise, accelerating discoveries that improve care for children and families across our system."

Dr. Cernich holds a Ph.D. in clinical psychology from Fairleigh Dickinson University, where her training focused on traumatic injury and disability-related research. She earned her bachelor's degree in psychology from Loyola University New Orleans and is board certified in clinical neuropsychology. Her academic background spans clinical science and translational research, providing a strong foundation for research leadership.

Dr. Cernich has held senior leadership roles across major federal health and research organizations, including the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and the U.S. Department of Defense. Across these settings, her work has focused on advancing research and innovation for children and individuals with disabilities — particularly in rehabilitation, medical devices and data-driven approaches — by bringing together clinicians, researchers, and partners to address complex, interdisciplinary challenges.

"This is an amazing opportunity to shape a research institute from the ground up," said Dr. Cernich. "Bringing Shriners Children's research and innovation together allows us to move discoveries from the lab into practice faster, so families see the impact through stronger outcomes and new possibilities in care." Originally from New Orleans, Louisiana, Dr. Cernich enjoys hiking and spending time outdoors.

"We very much look forward to Dr. Cernich leading the transformational change in research at Shriners Children's," said Marc Lalande, Ph.D., vice president, research programs. "Please join me in welcoming Dr. Cernich to Shriners Children's."

Shriners Children's Ohio is seeking Associate Members to join their Board of Governors.

If you have a Noble that is interested in contributing their specific skill per the current Hospital and Rules and Regulations, Article 5, 105.1 Membership, (5), Article 5 stating:

***(5) Nomination.** In January of each year, the Chairman of the Board of Governors shall contact, in writing, the Potentate of each Shrine Temple that sponsors the Hospital (with copies to the Recorder of each such Shrine Temple and all members of the Board of Governors), soliciting nominations for all anticipated vacancies which occur on the Board of Governors at the end of that calendar year. The Recorder of each such Shrine Temple shall promptly distribute/publicize this information to Temple Membership in the Temple newsletter and any other applicable application requesting nominations for anticipated vacancies on the Hospital Board of Governors. The letter will specify the requirements and professional skills or experience necessary or desired for selection as a Board of Governors member, and will enclose a copy of the Job Description for Board of Governors Members approved by the Board of Trustees. All nominations accompanied by the required application form are to be submitted to the Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors **not later than May 1** of that year. The Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors shall evaluate all nominees and determine those who meet the qualifications of the membership skills list, above, and select from those qualified the individuals whose skills and experience will satisfy the current and/or anticipated requirements of the Board of Governors. The Nobles selected by the Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors shall be asked to participate in in-person interviews, at the Hospital, to be conducted by the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors shall then make its recommendations for nominations to the Board of Governors. Upon approval of those recommendations by the Board of Governors, the nominations shall be forwarded not later than September 1 to the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, with a copy to the Executive Vice President, for approval by the Board of Trustees.*

Further, the Shrine Temple making a recommendation shall be considered affiliated to Shriners Children's Ohio prior to September 1, for approval by the Joint Boards.





§105.1 Membership.

(a) Regular Members.

*(1) **Qualification.** A member of a Board of Governors must be a Noble in good standing in the Shrine. Each nominee for membership shall indicate in writing on forms approved by the Board of Trustees, that he possesses a high level of business or professional experience and a reputation for community leadership, which together will likely bring to the Board of Governors active, intelligent and insightful service of high quality. Together, the nominees shall offer to the Board of Governors diverse talents, abilities and points of view derived from varied business and professional lives, and, among them, may be included one or more attorneys, accountants, bankers, insurance agents and commercial builders or contractors. Regardless of the location of any Hospital relative to any Shrine Temple, no Shrine Temple shall be entitled to a specific number of Board memberships. The Nominating Committee of each Board of Governors shall select from all nominated Nobles, those individuals whose skills and experience will provide the most effective management of the Hospitals. **Efforts shall be made to select a Board of Governors with members from all or most of the Temples affiliated with the Hospital;** however, the priority shall be to select individuals who possess the skills and expertise needed to satisfy the defined criteria with regard for the need to have members of the Board of Governors available between meetings to perform tasks or duties at or near the Hospital.*

Shrine Temples may only have one (1) noble designated as an Associate.

We ask that your recorder disseminate this information to the membership of your Temple via Newsletter, etc. Any interested parties should ask their Divan to submit a letter stating their interest to serve along with their qualifications. These letters should be forwarded to:

Earlier this year, 25 motorcycle riders led by the Iron Knights left Savannah, Georgia, to rumble 1,000 miles in 24 hours. The goal? To deliver a donation check of over \$30,000 to Shriners Children's in Greenville, South Carolina.

To ride that far in one day, you don't stop very much – gas when necessary, maybe two or three rest stops. "It's a very tough thing we do," said Duane Bartels, vice president of the Alee Shriners Iron Knights. "We ride 1,000 miles in 24 hours, nonstop, in part to remind ourselves a little bit about how hard it is for some of these children and what they go through."

The concept was adopted from an American Motorcycle Association 1,000-miles-in-a-day trek, promoted as an "Iron Butt" ride. However, the Iron Knights event has a higher purpose: to help Shriners Children's and the patients it serves. Bartels said the Alee Shriners Iron Knights unit-led ride is notable because it so strongly demonstrates the essence of the organization – a group of men who enjoy fun and fellowship and are defined by a dedication to philanthropy.

"Our ride reflects that duality of activities that epitomizes the Shriners," said Bartels. The route for the ride took the group down from Savannah through Mobile, Alabama, and then through Knoxville and Nashville, Tennessee, to arrive in Greenville at the same time they left the previous day – 5 p.m. Bartels and his daughter, Bella, who is a Shriners Children's patient, went on a local morning television show in Savannah a week before departure, and even more donations than they expected poured in.

One gift of \$6,000 came from an 86-year-old man who said that he wanted what little he could spare to go toward something important.

Bartels said there is a feature that was unexpected when these rides were initially conceived. Many who sign up for the ride come bearing a burden and seeking catharsis by getting outside themselves and doing things for others. Many are looking for connection as well.

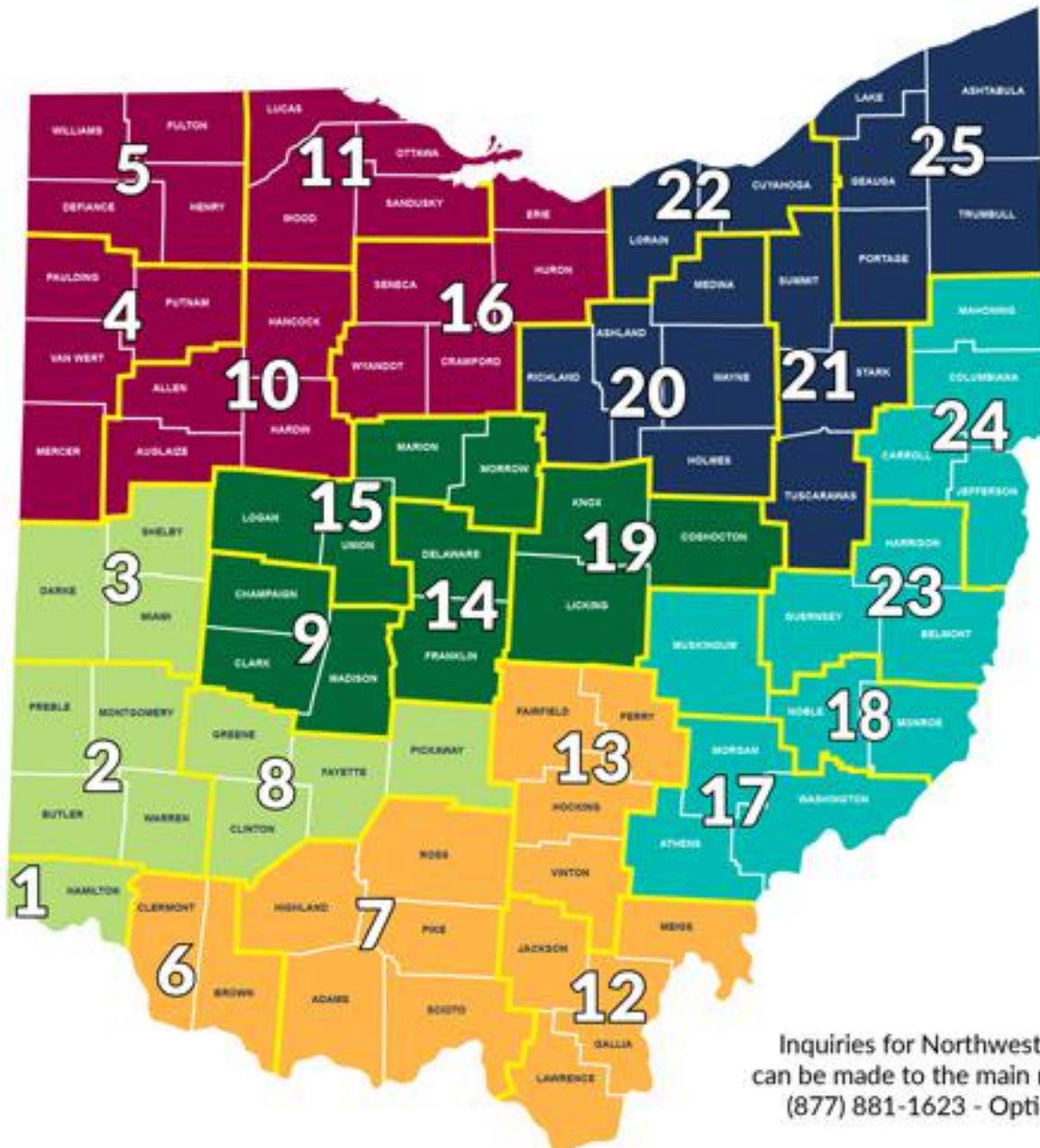

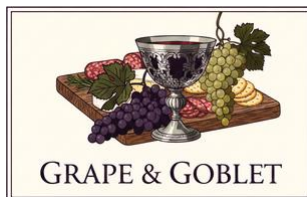

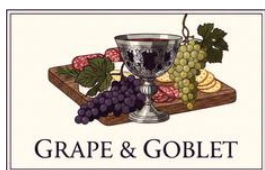
