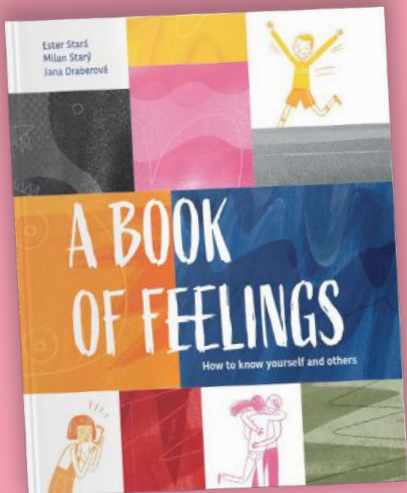

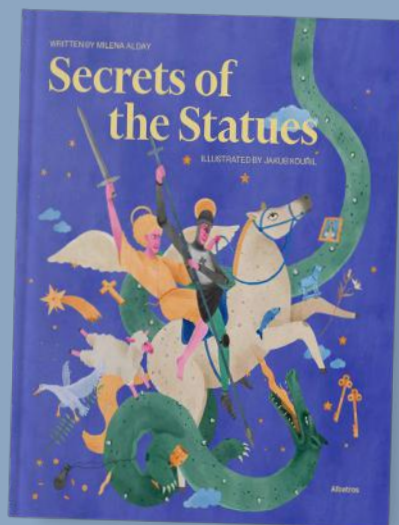

Her body miraculously healed each time she was thrown on a wheel. According to legend, she threw them the mark of the cross, and angels came to her body in the hour of death.

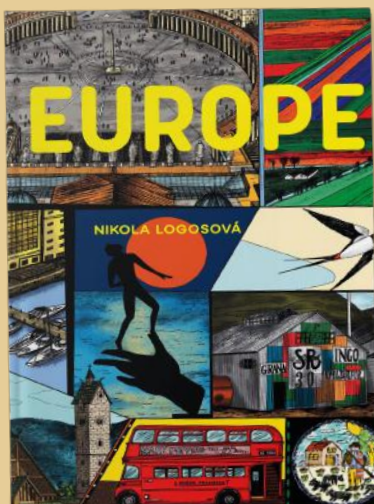
