Frequently Asked Questions

- What Show is my dancer in?
 - Please refer to the show order (posted below beginning April 9th) and find your dancer's class(es) to determine your dancer's show time.
- What is the Call Time for the Showcase?
 - See 'DANCER CALL TIME' above.
- How long is the show?
 - The Dance Recitals should last about 90 Minutes and will include an inside look into Intrigue Dance Company's Competition routines for the season, as well as our STAR, NOVA PRE-PRO, and COLLECTIVE division dancers.
 - The production of Willy Wonka Kids should run about 45-60 minutes

- Will I be able to go backstage as a parent?
 - No. Only parents appointed as volunteers and designated class parents will be allowed backstage. After checking in, your dancer will be escorted backstage and be supervised by volunteers, teachers, and staff. Dancers will remain backstage throughout the show, and you will pick them up at the check-in location after the show ends. Get your backstage pass by signing up to be a class parent volunteer. There are only a few spots left!

- How should the dancers wear their hair?
 - All dancers should wear their hair in a slicked-back proper ballet bun. If your dancer's hair is short, please slick it back in a ponytail or half-ponytail. Makeup is optional and up to your discretion.
 - For dancers only in hip-hop, please have their hair slicked back in a ponytail.

- What will the dancers wear?
 - Your dancer should arrive at their designated rehearsal and recital call time dressed in their costume, with full hair and makeup, and appropriate tights and shoes. Dancers will not be permitted to bring a bag with them backstage.
 - Pre-Pro and Company Dancers are the only exceptions.
 - Costumes will be distributed in April (See COSTUME PICK UP INFORMATION).
 - As a reminder, parents are NOT ALLOWED BACKSTAGE, so prepping your child's dance wear properly is key.

- My dancer is performing in more than one show. Do I need to purchase tickets for each show?
 - Yes. If you'd like to attend more than one show, you will need to purchase a ticket for each. A discount will be offered to anyone purchasing tickets for multiple shows. Please refer to Tutuix for more information when purchasing.
