Shrewsbury Parks and Recreation is working hard to ensure as many kids as possible have the opportunity to participate in essential programming and amenities such as summer camps, swimming lessons, passes and more. Through the **SPARK (Shrewsbury Providing Access to Recreation for Kids) Fund**, qualifying children can participate in these programs with the assistance of scholarship funds. Scholarships are available to Shrewsbury residents only, youth ages 18 and under. Children that qualify will be entitled to partial scholarship for recreation programs or passes, up to 75% discount (or at the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Director). Limits and exclusions may apply. The Shrewsbury Sharks Swim Team is part of the Southwest St. Louis County Municipal Swim and Dive League. The league is a recreational summer swim and dive league with teams from around the St. Louis area. Membership is open to swimmers ages 6-18, Residents & Non-Residents.

Swimmer Eligibility: All swimmers must meet our minimum safety requirements to join the team. Swim team is not a replacement for swimming lessons. For their safety: all swimmers on the team must be able to demonstrate the following skills: Swim one length of the pool (without stopping or holding on to walls/lane lines); appropriate freestyle arm movement, body position, and kicking to propel themselves in the water, and rhythmic (side to side) breathing with face in the water.

A new parent informational meeting will be held in early April. Keep an eye on our social media page for the date and additional details.

The meeting is required for all new families interested in joining the team. During the meeting, we'll discuss practice times, meets, team communication, volunteering requirements, swimmer readiness guidelines and the registration process. 

GREATER ST. LOUIS DOG TRAINING

The Greater Saint Louis Training Club (GSLTC) is a non-profit 501c3 organization that advocates and delivers innovative force-free canine training, sponsors events, and provides education for dog enthusiasts to advance the human-canine bond.

All of our training starts with the Just for You Behavior and Training Seminar (BAT 101). The BAT 101 seminar will get you prepared for our puppy and family dog classes, as we cover state-of-the-art training methods, leadership, and training equipment. You'll learn the most effective way to train your dog, how to manage common behavior problems, and how to prepare for class. This 60-minute online presentation provides you with a solid foundation for your first class.

To register for the seminar, go to our website www.gsltc.org and under the login tab create a new student account. You will need to add your dog in order to register for any dog training classes. After the Behavior and Training Seminar, register for Puppy Kindergarten or Foundation Manners, based on your pet's age.

All puppies attending class must have Bordetella by a veterinarian and at least one round of DHPP. Each dog is allowed up to 2 handlers.


