





LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR AGRICULTURAL ENGINEERS

The Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Biosystems Engineering licensure examination has seen a positive trend in recent years, with the overall passing rate of students from the College of Agriculture, Resources, and Environmental Sciences (CARES) consistently higher than the national passing rate from 2018 to 2022. Moreover, the passing rate of firsttakers and repeaters has been evenly distributed over the last five years. In 2018, 100% of first-takers passed the licensure examination. These results demonstrate the quality of education and preparation **CARES** Faculty provides and the student's dedication.



ANY ERASURE OR ALTERATION HEREON NULLIFIES THIS CERTIFICATION

In 2019, four students took the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Biosystem Engineering licensure examination. Of these four, only one student failed to pass, leading to a 75% passing rate for first-timers. Additionally, one repeater took the exam but unfortunately failed to pass. The overall passing rate of the exam was 60%, which is significantly higher than the national passing rate of 37.70%. CARES's overall passing rate was still higher than the national passing rate, showing that the students taking the licensure examination for Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Biosystem Engineering are well-prepared for the exam.

SEPTEMBER 2021-



In 2021, twenty first-time takers and three repeaters attempted the licensure examination for a Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Biosystem Engineering. Of the first-time takers, fifty percent passed the exam, while the repeaters had a passing rate of 66.67%. This led to an overall passing rate of 52.17%. The national passing rate is 36.42%, meaning the overall passing rate was higher than the national passing rate.

In 2022, the Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Biosystem Engineering licensure examination had three first-takers and 11 repeaters take the exam. Unfortunately, only one of the first takers did not pass the licensure examination, giving a passing rate of 66.67%. However, out of the 11 repeaters, nine were successful, giving a passing rate of 81.82%. When the first and second takers are combined, the overall passing rate for the 2022 licensure examination is 78.57%, much higher than the national passing rate of 42.28%.
