




















































































Value of the Month - Respect



Fine Motor Activity: Open and Close the Lid



Nature Based Engagement

Nature-based engagement provides ample opportunities for young children to explore and inquire about the world around them as curious learners. Moreover, it enriches the diversity of children's sensory play experiences, contributing to healthy childhood development.









Circle Time

Circle time is when the whole class gathers in a circle to discover and practice new concepts or skills. This can involve singing songs, playing games, or listening to stories. It helps children interact with their peers in a structured manner. Moreover, during circle time, our children have the opportunity to practice important skills such as taking turns and sharing their ideas. It also teaches them the value of listening to and respecting the thoughts of others.
