In this exclusive interview, Proaudio Sound Press Magazine sits down with the dynamic father-son duo behind Cantrel-Neil and Jesse Breytenbach. Neil and Jesse open up about their music, their relationship, and their message of hope, positivity, and connection through their art.

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Interview with Cantrel *By Proaudio Sound Press Magazine*

Combining the seasoned experience of Neil, best known for his **legendary role in Prime Circle**, with the fresh energy and creativity of his son Jesse, Cantrel offers a unique blend of musical styles that bridges generations.

From their lockdown beginnings to international performances, the Breytenbachs share their inspiring journey of crafting music that resonates deeply with fans worldwide.

They discuss the creative process, the challenges and triumphs of working as a family, and their vision for Cantrel's future.

With a versatile sound that effortlessly shifts between energetic rock anthems and stripped-down acoustic ballads,

Cantrel is winning hearts both locally and globally.

As a father-son duo, how did the idea for Cantrel come about, and what has the journey been like so far?

Jesse: It started during lockdown when I was at home doing online schooling. My dad and I began jamming together in our home studio, and it sounded really good. We started writing songs and jamming more often, and after I left school, we began playing live gigs together. The response has been phenomenal.

Neil, you've had a long career with Prime Circle. How does working with your son differ from your experiences with a band, and what unique dynamic does Jesse bring to the table?

Neil: Musically, working with Cantrel and Prime Circle is actually a very easy fit. Writing with my son Jesse for Cantrel feels like a very natural and authentic process, just like it does with Prime Circle. Nothing is forced—it all just happens naturally. Both bands have their own unique sound, which is amazing. Jesse is a grunge kid at heart, so we've grown up listening to the same music. However, he definitely brings a fresh approach to our musical style that's mind-blowing at times. It's a huge honor for me to be in a band and release music with my son.

Jesse, what is it like collaborating with your father, especially as a young artist? How has his influence shaped your musical style and growth?

Jesse: It's such a privilege and an awesome experience writing and playing music with my dad. It's pretty cool that we have similar tastes in music, so when we write, it has a nice flow. Being around Prime Circle and my dad my whole life, I've always been surrounded by music. I'm constantly learning new things, both musically and in real life, which I love.



You've mentioned blending various styles like rock, rap, and acoustic music. How would you describe Cantrel's sound, and what message do you hope listeners take away from your music?

Neil: Cantrel's style is definitely a blend of energetic, feel-good rock music with a splash of adult contemporary acoustic music and strippeddown, beautiful unplugged songs. We like to be chameleons—versatile enough to entertain any audience. Companies booking us can choose between an energetic rock show, an acoustic set, or a blend of both. We want people to leave our shows feeling good and happy, with our songs stuck in their heads.

With your debut album *Drive* and the EP Something in the Orange, what themes or stories were you most excited to explore in your music?

Neil: Our album *Drive* is layered with positivity. It tells the story of breaking out of negative circumstances and looking toward a better future—breaking the chains that bind you and driving yourself toward a better tomorrow. *Something in the Orange* is our rendition of a country song, re-imagined in an adult contemporary style.

You've had the chance to perform both locally and internationally. How have audiences responded to your music, and do you notice any differences in the energy or reception?

Jesse: It's been amazing to see that wherever we go, people love the songs and the performance. It's great to see how alive rock music is internationally and how people embrace the heavier songs, not just the chilled acoustic stuff. The responses, both locally and internationally, have been phenomenal, and we're so happy that our music is touching so many hearts around the world.


We don't face too many challenges because we have such a good relationship. I love that I get to perform an art I'm so passionate about with my dad.

Family is at the heart of Cantrel. How has this relationship impacted your creative process, and what have been some of your most memorable moments together?

Jesse: I love that I get to perform an art I'm so passionate about with my dad. Being in the band together has brought us closer. After being in boarding school and my dad touring overseas, we didn't see much of each other, so I'm excited to get that time back through touring and being on the road. My mom is so proud of what we've created, and we can't wait to see what else we can produce.

What challenges have you faced as a father-son duo in the music industry, and how have you overcome them?

Jesse: We don't face too many challenges because we have such a good relationship. The biggest issue is probably when we go back and forth about how we want a song to sound. But even then, within five minutes, we make a decision, stick with it, and there's no more debating.





Looking ahead, what are your goals for Cantrel in the coming year? Are there any exciting projects, collaborations, or tours you can share with us?

Neil: Cantrel is touring Germany in February 2025 with Prime Circle, and we've just released our brand-new single, *Walls*. It will be on radio and TV soon, so please support it when you hear it. Contact the stations and give it some love! *Walls* is dedicated to people suffering from mental health issues, and we hope it inspires people to "save yourself from yourself."

For the rockers,

we're working on a really cool rock album that will be *released in 2025*.


For aspiring musicians and bands, what words of wisdom would you offer based on your experiences as both an established artist and a new duo?

Neil: Practice every day. Market your brand. Music is a business, so reach out to lawyers and accountants for help. Write as many songs as you can—they'll get better over time. Learn from other artists you admire, follow their positive actions, and stay focused on your goal.




ON NOVEMBER 20, 2024,





In this exclusive interview, we catch up with Dirkie Coetzee, a trailblazer in the South African trance music scene. From his early beginnings inspired by Paul van Dyk and Derek "The Bandit," to launching his own global record label and event brand, *We Are Trance*, Dirkie shares his journey of passion, perseverance, and production.

With emotional stories behind his tracks, milestones like performing alongside Cosmic Gate, and his vision for uniting the trance community, Dirkie gives us a glimpse into the mind of an artist dedicated to his craft. Dive into the world of trance as Dirkie reflects on his career, creative process, and the bright future ahead.



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Interview with Dirkie Coetzee | Proaudio Sound Press Magazine

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You began your journey in the EDM scene at the young age of 16. What was it about electronic music that first drew you in?

Dirkie Coetzee: I used to listen to Derek "The Bandit" on 5FM, and that's where I got my first taste of EDM. Paul van Dyk's "For an Angel" was the track that cemented my love for Trance music. I joined a DJ school, and the rest is history, as they say.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: How did your early experiences performing in nightclubs and radio stations shape your growth as an artist?

Dirkie Coetzee: I got my first residency when I was 17 or 18 years old, and I played every weekend for a few years at the time. I loved the Peace-Love-Unity-Respect aspect among clubbers—it always had that "family" feeling. The underground music movement offered a lot of inspiration for me to become a producer.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine:

Learning music production without formal training is a challenging feat. What advice would you give to aspiring producers who are taking a similar selftaught approach? Dirkie Coetzee: Back in the late 90s and early 2000s, online resources were scarce, and the only way to learn music production was by trial and error. Nowadays, there's an abundance of tutorials online to learn from, and I still use online resources to learn new tricks. In my opinion, there isn't a right or wrong way to make music—it's a creative process. If you box yourself in, you might miss some powerful creative outcomes.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: Your music has been signed to some of the best record labels in the industry. How did it feel to have your work recognized by labels like Black Hole Recordings, Armada, and Perfecto Records?

Dirkie Coetzee: As a producer, you will always crave recognition for your music, and to me, the "pat on the back" was when my music was slowly but surely being picked up by some of the best labels and artists in the world. I dreamt that one day my heroes would play my music, and with a lot of hard work and sacrifice, I managed to achieve that dream. To this day, it means everything to me to be associated with the best labels in the world.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've collaborated with some incredible vocalists in the trance world, including Emma Lock and Jan Johnston. Can you share a memorable collaboration experience and how it influenced your music?

Dirkie Coetzee: The collaboration with Jan Johnston was a really emotional experience. My dad had passed away, and I decided to make a song in his honor. We wrote "Only the Beginning." When Jan sent me the initial idea, I was in tears hearing the message come to life. To this day, I get emotional hearing it again. The first time I played it at a club, the audience lit their lighters—it was one of the most emotional experiences of my life as a DJ.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: Trance is a genre that relies heavily on emotional and melodic elements. How do you approach creating a track that captures that emotional depth? Dirkie Coetzee: I'm one of those artists who must have an idea in mind before heading into the studio. Sometimes it takes months to form an idea, and then I try executing it in the studio. A lot of the music I write is inspired by real-life experiences and feelings, especially the love I have for those closest to me. You'll always hear that in my music.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've performed on stages across the world, including Russia, Ibiza, Amsterdam, and Malta. How does performing internationally differ from your experience here in Southern Africa?

Dirkie Coetzee: I've been blessed to have some of the most passionate followers here at home, so playing for them will always be special to me. The few times I did play internationally, I was lucky to always find myself in front of equally passionate crowds. But as they say, there's no place like home.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You recently shared a stage with Cosmic Gate at H2O. What was it like meeting and performing alongside one of trance music's legendary acts?

Dirkie Coetzee: Cosmic Gate has been a big influence on my music journey for as long as I can remember. Over the last few years, they've been supporting many of my music releases, so sharing a stage with them was a massive honor. Even though we've been on the same lineup multiple times, we only met for the first time at the last H2O.

They joked backstage about how it took 20 years for us to meet. It was a great experience—they were super humble and respectful, which made it even more special.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: When it comes to DJ gear, what is your preferred Pioneer DJ setup for gigs, and how do you use it to elevate your performances?

Dirkie Coetzee: In 2021, I celebrated 10 Years of Dirkie Coetzee with an open-toclose set at The Soundroom, and they had just gotten the CDJ-3000s. I completely fell in love with them. The larger digital touchscreens make it easier to find music when scrolling through playlists, and they feel much better than the previous CDJ-2000 models. My preferred mixer is the Pioneer DJM-900, which still seems to be the industry standard when we tour international DJs for We Are Trance events.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You launched your own label and event brand, "We Are Trance," providing a platform for artists globally. How has the brand evolved since its inception?

Dirkie Coetzee: We Are Trance turned 10 years old in 2024. We started as a record label under the legendary Bonzai Music as our parent label. Since then, we've become a fully independent label and have released over 500 tracks. On the event side, we've hosted nearly 100 events in 10 years and toured almost 30 international artists. **Proaudio Sound Press Magazine:** What role do you play in curating the music and events for We Are Trance, and what's your vision for its future?

Dirkie Coetzee: I have two amazing colleagues, Suzy Solar in America and Corrie Theron in South Africa, who manage the A&R side of the label. They curate and release the bulk of the music. I focus mainly on event planning and touring international talent. Our goal is to continue bringing the best trance talent to South Africa as often as possible. Without us, the local trance scene wouldn't get to experience these artists, so we invest a lot of effort to make it happen.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: We Are Trance Family has become a well-known name in the trance scene. How do you keep the brand fresh and engaging for both fans and artists?

Dirkie Coetzee: When we established We Are Trance in 2014, it was a direct rebellion against local music politics that were causing division in the industry. Our vision was to dismantle the hierarchy and unite trance followers. The DJs, artists, and followers all became one under the We Are Trance banner. Our logo, designed as a shield, represents our commitment to protecting the integrity of the trance community. The support we've received from our fans has been incredible, and they've stood with us since day one.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You use KRK studio monitors in your studio. What other key pieces of equipment or software are part of your production workflow?

Dirkie Coetzee: My studio software is Ableton Live, and I keep things simple by using stock FX plugins as much as possible. My go-to soft synths are Diva and Serum because I've taken the time to learn them inside out. Less is really more in my studio, and it has worked well for me over the years.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: Do you have any specific techniques or processes you rely on to maintain creativity and productivity in the studio?

Dirkie Coetzee: I've started using templates with a basic structure and FX channels already built in. This allows me to quickly translate ideas into music and helps keep the creative flow alive.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: What upcoming releases or projects are you most excited about in 2024?

Dirkie Coetzee: I recently released my second artist album under my Deeper Calling alias, which focuses on melodic techno and progressive house. However, you'll still hear plenty of trance influences in the album, *Spacewalk*. I'm currently working on new music for 2025, which will include more vocal elements—I'm very excited about that.



Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: Finally, what's one thing you hope to achieve in the next phase of your career, whether it be in production, DJing, or growing your brand?

Dirkie Coetzee: On the DJ side, I've been trying to get onto the ULTRA SA lineup, but it seems impossible. We Are Trance will always be my biggest passion project, and I hope to launch our first outdoor festival soon.

That would be a dream come true.

A Rising Star in the DJ Scene

In this insightful interview, we sit down with Justine Winterboer, a talented DJ who has quickly made waves in the South African music scene since starting her journey in 2022.

From her love for Pioneer DJ gear to balancing her full-time career, family life, and passion for music, Justine shares her experiences, challenges, and the joy of creating unforgettable moments through her performances. Join us as she talks about her growth, mentorship, and the unique bond she shares with her cats and her B2B partner, DJ Abi Danger.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've performed on various Pioneer DJ controllers at gigs—how does that experience compare with using the CDJ-3000 setup? Do you have a preference?

Justine Winterboer: As you know, I'm still relatively new to the industry, so I don't have a solid preference yet. That said, I do have a special place in my heart for the CDJ-3000. My first encounter with this 'performance unit' gave me butterflies in my tummy. All I saw were four jog wheels, four screens, and a lot of channels, and I started to panic—I was so overwhelmed!

But once I started my first mix, I got into the groove, had a tequila, and my nerves were gone. I've never backed out of a challenge, and I conquered it and LOVED it! The CDJ-3000 turned my initial panic into pure excitement and joy.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: When prepping for a set, how does your approach change when you're using a controller versus CDJs?

Justine Winterboer: Honestly, my set preparation isn't determined by the equipment provided. I do like to familiarize myself with what will be available because different gear offers different effects and features. But when it comes to prepping, I focus on my music and the audience I'm playing for. Whether it's a controller or CDJs, my main goal is to make sure everyone's having a blast. **Proaudio Sound Press Magazine:** With being married for nine years, how do you manage the balance between family time, playing music, and selecting gigs that work for you?

Justine Winterboer: I keep my personal life private, but I have a 'family comes first' rule because they are my top priority. My husband and I maintain an open line of communication, always discussing future events to ensure they fit within the boundaries we've set together. We both have our hobbies—his is golf and mine is music—so we make sure to set aside time for these passions. But ultimately, being home with our cats is number one for us. This balance allows me to enjoy my music career while keeping my family life strong and fulfilling.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: What's your favorite piece of Pioneer DJ or AlphaTheta DJ gear and why?

Justine Winterboer: I've only ever played on Pioneer DJ gear, so I haven't had the chance to try out AlphaTheta just yet. But I'm a huge fan of experimenting with different controllers and CDJs. Being tech-savvy, I love diving into new gear. Right now, my favorite piece of Pioneer DJ gear is the XDJ-XZ. It's not called the 'powerhouse' for nothing! It's my number one because I was mentored on it, which makes it quite sentimental for me. Plus, it has all the features I need to get creative with my mixing.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You play at a lot of private parties. Do you find these gigs better than nightclub performances? How are they different?

Justine Winterboer: I do prefer private parties over the nightclub scene, mainly because I have a full-time job as a medical device sales representative. Prioritizing rest is crucial so I can be 100% on top of my responsibilities at my kick-ass day job. Plus, the nightclub scene doesn't really align with my family life.

Private parties are more intimate for me; someone is hiring me specifically to create epic vibes and bring energy to their event. That said, I'm not opposed to playing at nightclubs, as long as the genre, the vibe, and the booking times align with my other responsibilities. So, if you see me at a nightclub, you know it's going to be a special night!

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine:

Since starting in 2022, you've seen great success as a DJ. For upcoming DJs, what advice would you give for landing gigs and finding quality gear?

Justine Winterboer: W.W.L.D. (What Would Lea Do) C I was lucky to be mentored by Lady Lea through her Flipside Mentorship program. I owe all my success thus far to her as she's guided me and helped me get to this point. My advice to upcoming DJs is to get the right coaching, put yourself out there at events, and always be humble—it's a small industry, and support goes a long way. With regards to finding quality gear, find a reputable audio supplier—I personally use Proaudio as my supplier. Their team has always been professional and helped me with any questions or needs I might have.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You were known as DJ Dispicable early on. What led to the decision to change your stage name?

Justine Winterboer: Well... when I started lessons with Lady Lea, I was asked to pick a DJ name. I didn't know what to choose because I'm quite an indecisive person. So Lea asked me what my mother calls me, and I answered cheekily, "My mother calls me despicable," and that's how that name came about for a fraction of time. I decided to change it due to the fact that I like my government name, and everyone knows me as Justine—so why change it?


When you were starting out, you often used the Pioneer DDJ-400. What was your favorite feature of that controller?

Justine Winterboer: I like that it's compact and easy to transport to gigs. It is the first controller I ever bought and will always hold a sense of nostalgia for me. I am looking at upgrading in the near future to a controller that can operate without a laptop, as I find the DDJ-400 a little limiting.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: On a fun note, we hear you're a big cat lover! Tell us about your cats.

Justine Winterboer: Oh, absolutely! My cats are like my backup dancers, but with more attitude and less coordination. I've got four of them. There's Big Ted, who loves to scratch (mostly the furniture, unfortunately). Hank is the smooth operator, always lounging around like he owns the place.

Luna is the chatterbox, always vocal about her opinions on my playlists. And finally, Jinjie, who's always the life of the party, especially when the catnip comes out. They keep my life interesting and my home filled with unexpected remixes of chaos and cuddles!



Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You often play back-to-back sets with DJ Abi Danger. How do you go about preparing for those collaborative performances?

Justine Winterboer: We are PIRs (Partners in Rhyme), and we talk pretty much every day. When we do play B2B sets, our collaborative stage name is "Just Danger." We like to spend time together, either in person or on the phone, discussing the music we think would best suit the audience for the event.

We share our playlists with each other and add to it as we see fit. We like to have a pre-jam session as well—not just for the events but also for the social aspect of our friendship. We also plan our outfits... this is necessary to build our brand!

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've been to South Africa a few times, and you always bring the house down. I remember you playing your track "I Don't Want Nobody" here—how did the crowd respond to that song during your performance? Do you have any standout memories from your shows in South Africa?

Tom Novy: Oh, there are plenty of crazy stories! Once, I was supposed to play at Halifax in Johannesburg, and I did a major radio show there to promote the track and the party. When we got to the club that night, the place was empty.

The owner told me they'd had so much demand that they closed off the street behind the club and turned it into a minifestival! There were thousands of people dancing out there. It was magical. But honestly, I have nothing but great memories of my shows in South Africa. The people there have such a good vibe and know their house music. Every gig was amazing.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've worked on some legendary remixes, like Fragma - Toca's Miracle (Tom Novy & Jashari Deepdown Mix). How was it to remix such an iconic track? Did you feel any pressure when reworking a song that had already made such a big impact? Tom Novy: You always think, "What could I make better here?" Sometimes it works, and sometimes it doesn't quite hit the mark. Not every remix carries the energy it should. That's probably why I don't remix as much as I used to. For "Toca's Miracle," we wanted to bring our beat to the track. It's a magical vocal, and there wasn't a deeper version out there that really did it justice. With that breakbeat switch, it gets this cool vibe, and the guitar shines through. It still rocks today crazy!

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine:

Recently, you posted a rather direct comment on Facebook about the current state of DJing and how you feel the profession has changed, especially with social media. Could you elaborate on what you think has gone wrong with today's DJ culture, and what advice would you give to new DJs trying to make it in this environment?

Tom Novy: Look, it always sounds like an old artist complaining about the new times, right? But it's a fine line. My post wasn't about hating but raising awareness about what DJing should really be about: music. I think the priorities in our industry have completely drifted.






What's even real anymore? And why is everything so overhyped? Now it's all about the clown act: make a fool of yourself to go viral. Forget your ideals and do anything for followers and likes. Then you might have a shot at a career. That's truly sad. People think art is expendable, but it's actually the answer to everything. My advice for new DJs? Be yourself, build a real community with your music and your skills. Forget all the other stuff.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: Your latest track "Tom Novy & Lukas Love -Lights Get Dark" has a very cool, fresh sound. How would you describe your musical evolution over the years, and how does this new track fit into the direction you're heading as an artist?

Tom Novy: Yeah, the new track turned out great. It's got a bit of that UK garage soul that's trending right now. I've never been one to stick to just one genre. As an artist, you need the freedom to cross genres. Otherwise, it gets boring, and you end up being known for just one style. And if that style fades? Then what? That's too narrow-minded for me.

I stick with house music in all its forms. My side project, Cosmic Soul, is more about my musical roots and the chill side of Tom Novy. That might be a bit much for some people. I just released a new album on Bandcamp exclusively. Check it out if you like:




Proaudio Sound Press Magazine:

You've had a career spanning decades with worldwide chart successes, from "Superstar" to "Your Body". What do you think has been the key to your staying power in an industry that is always changing?

Tom Novy: I think you have to stay true to yourself and not get caught up in chasing fame or money at any cost. I got big when social media wasn't a huge influence yet, and it wasn't the billion-dollar business it is now. DJ fees were high, but they reflected how many people came to an event for a specific DJ.





Today, some artists are overhyped even before anyone's really heard of them. I think that's working to my advantage now. People remember you because you're actually in their heads.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've produced and remixed for some huge artists like Ludacris, Eric Morillo, and 10CC. Do you approach remixes for major artists differently than for your own productions? What do you enjoy most about working on other artists' music?

Tom Novy: Back then, we did it to tap into the reach of big stars. There was no TikTok, limited internet, no social media. Now, everyone's just doing edits instead of remixes. The Afro House hype right now is all based on edits and versions of pop songs or classics across genres. Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've performed on stages all over the world and alongside major names in the industry. Who were some of the DJs or artists that you felt you clicked with the most, and what were some of your most memorable gigs?

Tom Novy: I've generally gotten along well with most of my fellow DJs. The connection has always been the music. We're kind of like family that way. So many performances are unforgettable and close to my heart. My time in Ibiza was huge for me—14 years as a Space resident and seven years running the Timeless party at Lio. And playing at the Love Parade in front of over a million people is something I'll never forget.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: In addition to DJing, you've hosted TV shows and have been a long-standing radio DJ. How has your experience as a host influenced your approach to music, and do you prefer connecting with your audience through the radio or live in clubs?

Tom Novy: Oh yeah, I still love doing radio. No live show right now since I'm short on time, and radio itself is in a bit of a transition. But I produce two mixed streams for a local radio station in my hometown, Munich. One is called Tom Novy Mix and features the latest club music—all in the mix. 24/7, just tune in, hit play, and dance. Tom Novy Mix Tom Novy Chill Out Mix





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Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: When producing new music or remixing a track, what's your creative process like? Do you start with a specific idea, or does it evolve while you're experimenting with sounds?

Tom Novy: Oh man, there's all sorts of stuff. My day is full of music. I listen to a lot, constantly surrounded by it, always on the lookout for samples and ideas, or just humming something and playing it out later. It's not really planned or coordinated. Some days I'm super creative, and some days, nothing good comes out. I've shifted from analog tools to digital over the years. That's just how it's evolved.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: Before a gig, how do you prepare your set? Do you plan out tracks in advance, or do you prefer to improvise based on the crowd's energy? How do you use Rekordbox in your preparation process?

Tom Novy: After so many years, the library's set in my head. Sure, I use Rekordbox, but I keep it pretty relaxed. I make my playlists and check what I feel like playing that night. Big festival, small club—I'll adapt. But at the end of the day, you walk into a club, take in the vibe, read the crowd, and get a feel for the energy. It's different everywhere. I think that's the most important skill a DJ should have. The party has to be unforgettable.

Proaudio Sound Press Magazine: You've

already achieved so much in your career, but what's next for Tom Novy? Are there any upcoming projects or collaborations we should be excited about?

Tom Novy: There's always something new going on. Music, more music, new shows, a residency at an amazing beach club in Split, Croatia, next summer. Our own Timeless parties, the two labels it's rare that I'm bored. But I've turned my hobby and passion into a career, and I'm grateful every day for what I've been able to experience and achieve. Future projects? Staying healthy, spending time with family and close friends, and making as much great music as possible.






