Hosting a civic organizing virtual summer conference in partnership with multiple social impact technology start ups.



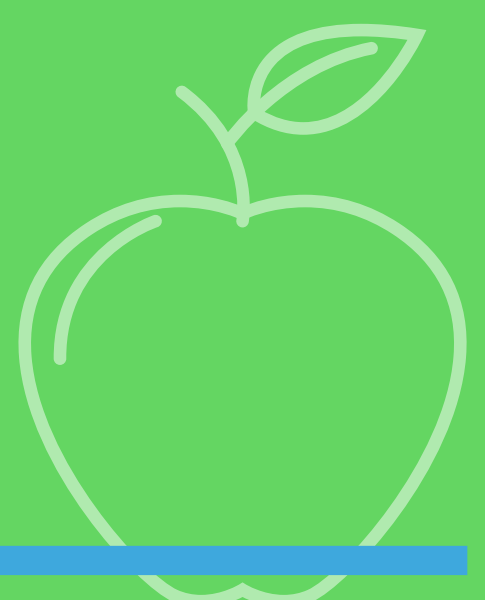

Fellowships

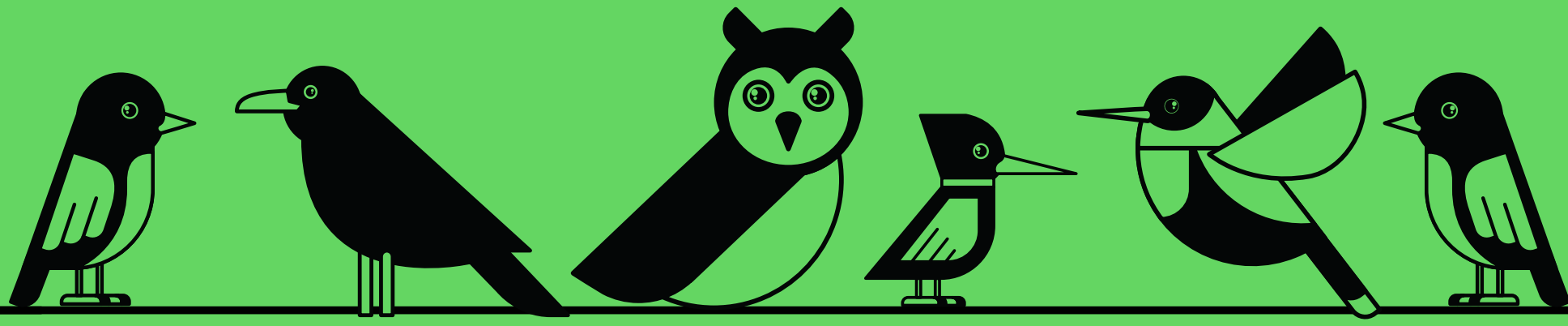
Launching our civic organizing fellowship for teachers and community leaders in partnership with the Bonner Foundation.

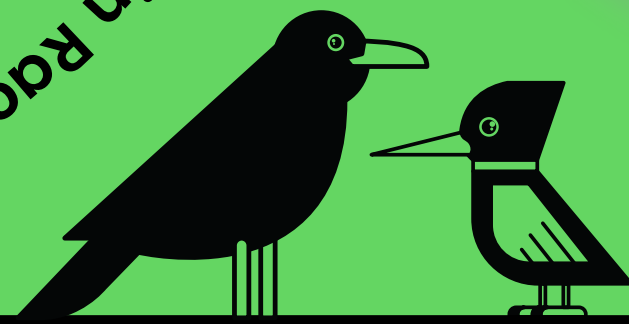
