

This award was created in memory of Joan Beaudry, a longtime Biddeford Pool resident and passionate educator, to provide assistance for any college student who has ties to the Biddeford Pool Community Center. Applicants' immediate family shall be members of BPCC (grandchildren of active members are also eligible). Candidates interested in applying MUST have applications completed and submitted no later than June 1st, or forfeit eligibility for the year.

The application is available on our website and includes a 500-word essay describing personal goals and objectives and addressing what the student perceives his/her role in the community to be. All award recipients will be asked to give back to the Biddeford Pool community by completing some community service (minimum 2 hours). The amount of the reward is based on available funds and will be no more than \$1,000 per year. We encourage all qualified candidates to apply.


