


WHAT SETS UNISUS APART?

UNISUS students consider both global perspectives and their own ideas and experiences. They use critical and creative thinking skills to perform in-depth analysis and take responsible action to solve complex problems. They exercise initiative in making reasoned and ethical decisions. Our students learn this way because of the three core focuses at UNISUS: Student Learning, Student Empowerment and Student Enrichment.

Research shows that when students are engaged in learning within their areas of interest, they experience heightened success across all facets of their lives. That is the UNISUS Student Enrichment objective.

Our enrichment programs are designed to extend daily academic learning, incorporating experiential studentempowered learning opportunities to prepare students for self leadership in life and in their future careers. In some programs, we partner with expert external providers from the community or connect to virtual learning opportunities from across the globe. Enrichment programs provide opportunities to build competency sets beyond the regular curriculum. Some of the enrichment programs may qualify for academic credits.



Each strand is a focused area of enrichment. All Academy programs are offered at this time as a double strand activity.




To equip our students for success in a fast-evolving, digitally advanced, and globally interconnected world, we offer:



MUSIC ENRICHMENT

Ignite your passion for music — whether you're driven to master an instrument, write your own songs, perform in a rock band, or explore the world of digital music production, this program is designed to help you thrive.

Students get exposure to various disciplines through the year, which are carefully curated to provide a well-rounded experience. Learning focuses include:

- Concert Band
- Rock Band
- Music Theory & Composition
- Songwriting & Recording
- Digital Music Creation

Students set both personal and group goals, with opportunities to perform, collaborate, and support school productions. The program blends creative freedom with skill-building, guided by expert instructors.

TECHNOLOGY & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Prepare to thrive in a rapidly changing, highly digital, technical, and connected world.

The UNISUS Technology & Entrepreneurship Enrichment Program equips students with the tools to think creatively, communicate clearly, build innovative products, and compete with confidence. Each week, students engage in a three-day cycle that blends communication, business, and digital technology through hands-on, team-based learning.

DAY 1: SPARK SPEAK - SELL YOUR IDEA

Does your child have big ideas? Are they ready to build confidence, strengthen their communication skills, and tap into their entrepreneurial spirit?

In Spark Speak, students will learn how to bring their ideas to life—and communicate them with clarity and confidence. Through fun, hands-on activities, they'll explore blogging, debates, elevator pitches, and TED-style presentations. They'll discover how to spark curiosity, speak with impact, and sell their ideas—essential skills for school, future careers, and life.

Whether your child dreams of launching a business, becoming a confident speaker, or simply building their communication toolkit, this session is the perfect place to start.



DAY 2: START-UP LABS - BUILD YOUR PRODUCT

In this interactive session, students will explore market trends and identify areas where innovation is needed. Using the design cycle, they will develop an original business idea and create a working prototype to test and refine.

The experience will culminate in Unisus' Young Entrepreneurship Fair, where students will pitch their products to an audience of peers, staff, and community members—bringing their ideas to life and gaining real-world feedback.

DAY 3: E-SPORTS – MARKET, COLLABORATE, PERFORM

In this session, students will channel their love of gaming into teamwork, strategy, and healthy competition, facing off against schools from across North America in league games. With a focus on collaboration, personal growth, and—above all—fun, this program encourages players to be part of a high performing team.

As part of the broader Spark Speak and Start-up Labs experience, students will also build team brands, design merchandise, and explore streaming strategies to market and pitch their team identity.

VISUAL ARTS

Unlock your creativity through beautiful art work in oil, acrylics, watercolours and sketching. Be amazed at your artistic talents!

Fuel your artistic passion with three days of painting a week to master your creative skillset! Modules are offered in acrylics and oils, watercolours and sketching. Watch yourself create masterpieces! You will learn how to recognize and mix unique colours found in paintings, understand depth and light, re-create masterpieces, and then create your own masterpiece. You will have the opportunity to create a digital portfolio of their work and participate in art exhibitions.

Learning outcomes include:

- Colour theory and brush strokes. Learning to paint portraits, landscapes and still life. Study of watercolours, acrylics and oils.
- Sketching, portraits, acrylics with oil, learning depth Study of master's original paintings through replication.
- Learning to master your own creations and compositions, creatively or from photos.

WORLD LANGUAGES & CULTURE

Become a Global Citizen and ignite your passion for learning foreign languages and cultures at UNISUS!

MANDARIN

Our Mandarin program will cover different forms of the Chinese language, starting with the Chinese phonetic alphabet. Students will also explore Chinese calligraphy, and will learn Chinese culture, foods, and cities through virtual tours.

Students will learn about the culture through movies, art, food, and music in a fun-filled learning environment.

FRENCH

French is offered as enrichment options for students interested in learning vocabulary, conversational language, writing, and reading through classroom instruction and immersive cultural experiences such as foods, songs, movies, and the celebration of culture-specific holidays and events.

STRUCTURED STUDY AND INDEPENDENT PROJECTS (GRADES 9-12)

Whether you're eager to launch your own business, pursue a passion project, work ahead academically, or seek additional academic support — this enrichment stream offers the time, structure, and support to make it happen.

Structured Study & Independent Projects provides dedicated time for students to pursue personal growth, academic support, or interest-based projects.

Designed for those students looking for the following:

- Time Management: Students balancing intensive extracurriculars who need space to complete academic tasks during the day, or want to dedicate this time to their passion projects.
- Deep Dive: Students who want to explore topics beyond the curriculum through inquiry, research, or creative output, or students who want to work ahead independently through on-line courses.
- Subject Support: Students looking for focused time and access to specialist teachers for help with specific subjects or assignments.

This program is supervised by the Enrichment Coordinator. Students must maintain a term-long tracking document to log goals, time use, and progress. Reflections and outcomes are included in school reports as part of their enrichment record.

Facilitated by our University Guidance Counsellor, Ms. Hayley Shannon, this program helps students build real-world experience while completing key graduation requirements.

Students will:

- Fulfill their IB CAS hours and BC Dogwood volunteer requirements
- Explore leadership and service roles within the school and wider community
- Develop career readiness skills through hands-on involvement and mentorship

Students can lead in planning school events, running student clubs, and mentoring younger learners. Beyond the campus, they'll connect with community organizations for volunteer placements, job shadowing and work experience opportunities.

Students will also reflect on their growth and learn to communicate their experiences effectively through:

- Resume writing
- Cover letter development
- University application preparation

Future in Action empowers students to build purpose, leadership, and pathways — all while making a meaningful impact.

REGISTRATION, PAYMENTS & CHANGE POLICY

ENROLMENT

- Enrichment selections are available at the end of August.
- Once registered, students are enrolled for the full term in their selected strands.
- Students may request changes upon completing the first week of enrichment.
- Students are automatically enrolled in their selections for the entire year. One additional change may be requested prior to the start of the next term.
- All selections and changes must be approved by a parent or guardian.

PAYMENTS

- Payment is required at the time of registration.
- Course fees vary by enrichment offering and are paid at time of registration.
- Every strand offers an enrichment option free of charge.
- Refunds in the form of credits will be applied to future enrichment activity registration.

ENRICHMENT FAIR & PROGRAM PLACEMENT

• To help students and families make informed choices, we host a Student & Parent Enrichment Fair in the first week of school. This is an opportunity to meet enrichment providers, ask questions, and explore the program options in detail.

MINIMUM & MAXIMUM PARTICIPATION

- To ensure effective delivery of activities, a minimum number of students may be required for a course to be offered.
- Some courses may have a maximum enrolment cap to ensure a high-quality experience.

ENRICHMENT COORDINATION AND LEADERSHIP

- We are committed to providing a rich and diverse enrichment experience for all students and appreciate your support in making this program successful.
- A dedicated coordinator will be assigned to ensuring efficient and effective operations of the program.
