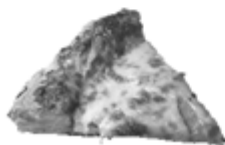

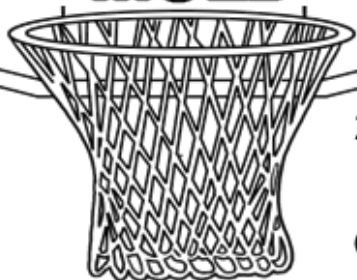

6. Also:
 - A. Five minutes between halves.
 - B. At least five minutes between games for warm-ups.
 - C. The top team in the bracket is the home team. It uses the locker room inside the gym proper, the basket (2nd half) and the bench on the north end. (exception when Grafton plays).
7. Cheerleaders: One group only cheers during a time out. Leave the floor immediately when the horn or whistle sounds.
