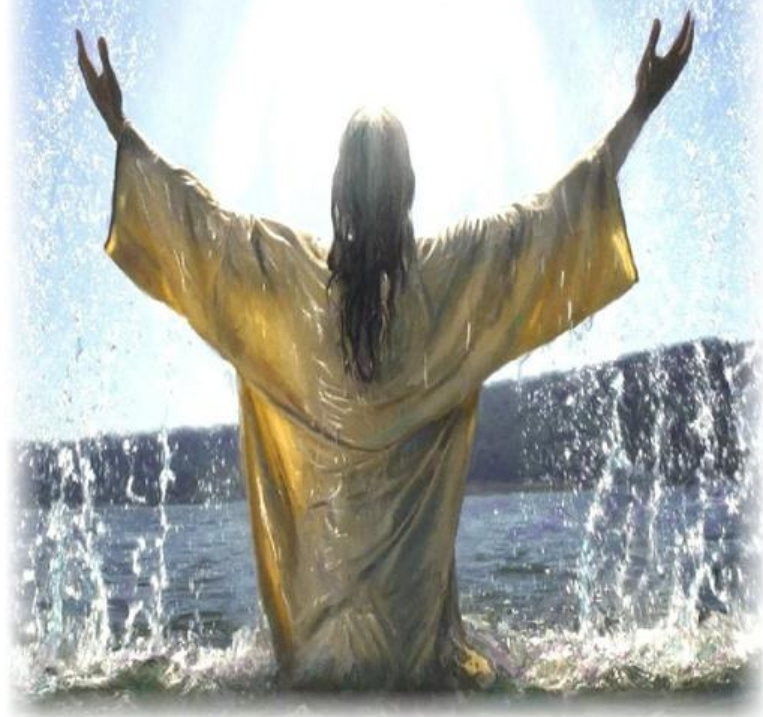

Isaiah 43:16-19: God declares, "I am the Lord, who opened a way through the waters, making a path right through the sea. I called forth the mighty army of Egypt with all its chariots and horses" 1. This passage refers to the miraculous parting of the Red Sea during the Israelites' escape from Egypt. It demonstrates God's power to create a path where there seemed to be none.

Keepers of the Stuff – Unwanted Gifts in the Body of Christ...Part 3

We saw last week in Numbers 18: 2 – 4 that there was organization amongst the priests. Everyone had a role to play and it was necessary for those roles to be carried out. God has an order to everything that He does in His kingdom and this order is necessary amongst His people and in His house. As the “Body of Christ” we should be operating in a spirit of excellence. We find the spirit of excellence in Daniel 6: 2 – 3.

“And over these, three governors, of whom Daniel was one, that the satraps might give account to them, so that the king would suffer no loss. Then this Daniel distinguished himself above the governors and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king gave thought to setting him over the whole realm.” Daniel 6: 2 – 3 [NKJV].

If you follow God with the entirety of your heart the anointing for excellence will be a part of whatever you do for Him. I feel that the “Body of Christ” takes this for granted. When you look at the priesthood and the qualifications necessary to be a part of this group there was a strict standard set by God. God didn't just accept anything. Even when it came to the animals that they used for the sacrifices there was strict criteria that had to be upheld. If the animals did not meet these criteria they could not be used. Failure to comply would stir the wrath of God and people would die.

The spirit of excellence that was inside of Daniel is an anointing that is inside of you because it is a character trait of God. We find Daniel having this character trait and it set him above the other administrators in the kingdom that he served.

There is no reason for slackness or laziness in the “Body of Christ”. Slackness and laziness exist because God's people don't take the anointing seriously. Going back to the priests in the temple. Everything was done with precision. On the surface this can seem like this is overkill but it is not. When you look at the meticulousness of how they put the Bible together. If one jot or tittle was out of place that particular version was tainted and immediately thrown out. The workers took their work seriously and they enjoyed it.

Nothing by God is done haphazardly and nothing that we do for God should be done haphazardly. Those who have been anointed with the “gift of helps” and gift of administrations” are often detail-oriented people. God has gifted them to manage every one of the details that they are responsible for in order for perfection to be in His house. We see this in how detail oriented the descriptions are for the items that are used in the temple.

At times this detail orientation causes conflicts with the other giftings in the “Body of Christ”. This is due to the immaturity of the people who carry those gifts. This is where the unity of the Spirit needs to be brought forth and humility should come in on the part of those who are involved.

Bag to go

Family and other responsibilities had me driving back and forth on the interstate highways - hundreds of times over the years. I keep a "gotta-get-out-of-Dodge-bag" packed in the car. [The real 'Preppers' call it a Bug-Out-Bag]. I'm not really a big prepper - just some things I've used when needed.

KEEP IN CAR: Things like a flashlight, blankets, water, Orange or nightglow vest - like the hunters wear. Any kind of glow safety shirt or vest. (Walmart, Roses has them - 10 bucks). If lights ever go out, or you're in a flash flood or need to be seen or in danger - you'll be glad for it.

If someone is in or near you or your car - this will get enough quick attention.

You Speak out of the Abundance of the Heart

During World War 2, there was a hospital attendant with the British army in North Africa. He was appointed to the NCO in charge of a small reception station in the desert that catered only to dysentery patients. Each morning the doctor under whom he worked, would summon him and they would go on their rounds of their patients. He noticed that every morning the doctor always greeted each patient the same way. First with, "Good morning how are you?" then, "Show me your tongue." He noticed one thing, the doctor paid very little attention to the answer of the first question, "How are you?", but once they stuck out their tongue, He would then look very carefully at it. Then he would form his estimate of the patient's condition, much more from looking at his tongue than from the answer that the patient gave to the question "How are you?"

God does much the same with us. He may ask "How are you?" and we may answer Him, but the next thing that He does is more or less say- "show Me your tongue", or "show Me who you think you are in Me." At this point He forms His own estimation of our true spiritual condition. The state of your tongue is a very sure guide to your spiritual condition.

Now let us look at Matthew 12:33-37, "Either make the tree good, and its fruit good; or make the tree rotten, and its fruit rotten; for the tree is known for it's fruit. You brood of vipers (He is speaking to the religious leaders of the time), how can you, being evil, speak what is good? For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart. The good man out of his good treasure bring forth what is good; and the evil man out of his evil treasure brings forth what is evil. And I say to you, that every careless word that man shall speak, they shall render account for it in the day of judgement. For by your words you shall be justified, and by your words you shall be condemned. Jesus here has established the direct connection between the mouth and the heart using parabolic language. He refers to the heart as the tree and the words that come out of the mouth as the fruit. And the kind of words that come out of the mouth will indicate the condition of your heart.

In Matthew 7:17-18 Jesus says it this way, "...every good tree bears good fruit, but the rotten tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot produce bad fruit, nor can a rotten tree produce good fruit. The nature of the tree inevitably determines the kind of fruit, and when we see the fruit, we will know the nature of the tree. The tree is the heart and the fruit is the mouth. If the heart is good then the fruit will be good. But if the words from the mouth are evil, then we know that the heart is also evil.

There is an inescapable connection between the state of the heart and the state of the mouth. You may be able to deceive yourself about the state of your heart, but the sure indicator is what comes out of your mouth. If what comes out of your mouth is corrupt, then your heart is corrupt also. Ask yourself, "What is the condition of my heart?"

Our Position Surrendered-Humility

God's Blessing and Favor in Times of Delay

There are times in our lives when our prayers linger in times of desperation. God wants to test us to see if we persevere and seek His presence and He wants to bring restoration to our lives, to glorify the miracle obtained.

Luke 18:35-43 As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the side of the road begging for alms. 36 When he heard the crowd passing by, he asked what was going on. 37 "Jesus of Nazareth is passing by," they answered. 38 "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" cried the blind man. 39 Those who were ahead rebuked him to be quiet, but he began to shout even louder, "Son of David, have mercy on me! 40 Jesus stopped and ordered him to be brought to him. When the blind man approached, Jesus asked, 41 "What do you want me to do for you?" And he said, "Sir, I want to see." And he said: 42 "Get your sight!" Jesus said to him, "Your faith has healed you." 43 Immediately he regained his sight. Then, glorifying God, he began to follow Jesus and all who saw him gave praise to God.

In this case, we need to cry out for God's favor and blessing. We must make a promise to God and fulfill it, prophesy, and declare that God will do it by faith. Another case was that of Hannah in 1 Samuel 1:9-11.

1 Samuel 1: 9-11 While she was in Shiloh, Hannah got up after she had eaten and drunk. And at the sight of Eli the priest, who was sitting in his chair by the door of the sanctuary of the Lord, 10 he began to pray to the Lord in great anguish and to weep inconsolably. 11 Then he made this promise: "Lord of hosts, if you will look at the misery of this handmaid of yours, and if instead of forgetting me you remember me and give me a son, I will give him to you for the rest of his life, and his hair will never be cut off."

Hannah had God's favor. God's favor is defined as the Lord's favor expressed by His approval, acceptance, support, provision, power, and joy. And so, He demonstrated this to both Noah and Mary, the mother of Christ (Luke 1:28), which also manifests itself to all of us who have been saved through Jesus Christ.

The name Anna in the Spirit means grace and is derived from the Hebrew word *chanan* which means favor or favored. Hannah, the prophetess also prayed and fasted day, and night in the temple, prophesying about the birth of a child, Jesus, who was called the great prophet (Luke 7:16), as well as Samuel.

Grace is linked to God's favor, someone's support or liking, an act of kindness above and beyond, an act of kindness, helping, assisting. For a Christian, receiving God's favor and blessing in times of despair is when our prayers have been manifested in the natural and we can bear witness to it. In this case, we can conclude that grace and favor were Hannah's identity.

Ringworm isn't a worm. It's a skin infection that's caused by moldlike fungi that live on the dead tissues of your skin, hair and nails. When you get it between your toes, it's called athlete's foot or if you get it in your groin, it's called jock itch.

CAUSE

- * From another person – spreads by skin-to-skin contact.
- * From your pets – rubbing or grooming your pet. Wash your hands when you're finished. It's also very common in cows
- * By touching objects – the fungus that causes ringworm can linger on surfaces, clothes, towels and in combs and brushes.
- * From soil – if you're working or standing barefoot in soil that's infected with fungus that causes ringworm, you can get it too.

SYMPTOMS

- * On skin - red, scaly patch on light skin or brown or gray patches on skin of color. Bumps that itch will over time, turn into a ring or circle-shaped patch which may turn into several rings. The inside of the patch is usually clear or scaly and the outside might be slightly raised and bumpy.
- * On scalp- it starts out as a bump or small sore and turns flaky and scaly and your scalp may feel tender and sore to the touch. You will notice that your hair starts to fall out in patches.

TREATMENT

How the infection is treated depends on where it is and how bad it is. In many cases, your doctor may recommend an over-the-counter medicine you can get at the drugstore such as antifungal cream, lotion or powder - clotrimazole (Lotrimin, Mycelex) and miconazole. Use these medicines on your skin for 2 to 4 weeks to make sure you kill the fungus that causes ringworm. It also will lower its chance of coming back.

PREVENTION

- * wear flip-flops in locker rooms and public showers.
- * change socks and underwear at least once each day.
- * don't share clothes or towels with someone who has ringworm.
- * if you play sports, don't share your gear and uniform with other players.

The voice of death over your identity speaks to you that you are unwanted, unseen, and unloved. But the blood of Jesus says otherwise. [Ephesians 1:7] Because of the blood of Jesus you were brought nearer to God. It speaks of how precious you are to God and the lengths that was taken to bring you closer to Him. It speaks LOVE, acceptance, and adoption in the kingdom of God – ETERNAL LIFE through salvation.
