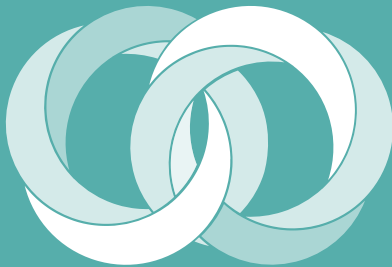
NETWORK
