
The Board of Governors of Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE) is proud to announce that the College has successfully achieved institutional accreditation for operating Postgraduate programmes at Qualifications Framework (QF) Level 6 with the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ), paving the way for new degrees to be launched in the 2025/26 Academic Year.

The College announced that Professor Kerry Lee has been appointed as the next President and Chair Professor of Child Development, and assumed his roles in early November 2024. Professor Lee brings extensive experience from The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK), where he served as Director of the Centre for Educational and Development Sciences and Head of the Department of Early Childhood Education. His previous roles include key positions at the National Institute of Education in Singapore and Bond University in Australia. Professor Lee holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Sydney and a doctorate from Macquarie University. He is recognised among the top 2% most-cited scientists globally, with a research focus on cognitive developmental psychology.

YCCECE Signs MOU with Guangzhou Zhongshan Whampoa International School 耀中幼教學院與廣州市中黃港澳子弟學校 簽署合作諒解備忘錄



Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education signed a Memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Guangzhou Zhongshan Whampoa International School on 29 November 2024 at the latter's campus. This collaboration aims to encourage educational exchange and student development in the future.

Dr Frank Lam, Vice President (Administration) of YCCECE, and Dr Zhai Peiqi, Principal of Guangzhou Zhongshan Whampoa International School, represented their respective institutions in signing the cooperation agreement. The Ceremony was also attended by Mr Cheng chongming, Director of Yew Chung Education Group, Mr Lao Huangiang, General Manager of Yew Chung Education Group's Greater Bay Area Operations, Ms Xie Haiyin, Admissions Manager of YCCECE, Mr Huang Haifeng, Chairman of Zhonghuang Education Group, Ms Li Xia, Director and Chief Financial Officer of Zhonghuang Education Group, Ms Yang Lixia, Vice Principal of Guangzhou Zhongshan Whampoa International School and special guest Dr Wu Chuntao, Director of the Talent Empowerment and Innovation Research Institute at Jinan University. In addition to the formal signing ceremony, the event included interactive sessions between the delegation, students and staff. YCCECE gave an introduction to its courses and professional development opportunities. Dr Frank Lam and Dr Zhai Peigi both delivered concluding remark. ## YCCECE Teaching Team Earned an Honorable Mention in the FSTE Teaching Excellence Award 2024

### 耀中幼教學院教學團隊獲得自資高等教育聯盟年度傑出教學獎榮譽大獎



FSTE Teaching Excellence Award is established to recognise and reward FSTE Member Institutions' teachers with excellent teaching performance. This annual sector-wide Award also aims to promote and share good practices for learning and teaching in order to foster a culture of quality enhancement amongst member tertiary institutions. The Jockey Club 'CoolPlay' Project scored the Honorable Mention award this year. It is the first award won by teaching staff of YCCECE. The teaching members of this project include Dr Brad Chan, Ms Esther Chong, Ms Ruoyu Wen and Ms Joey Chan.

Commenced in 2023, Jockey Club 'CoolPlay' Project Phase 2 is a four-year research initiative funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust and coorganised by YCCECE and Hong Kong Christian Service. This project offers teacher training to pre-service teachers and in-service teachers. The project followed a child-centric approach and extended its reach to handpicked grassroot communities in Hong Kong, providing early childhood educators and parents with educational resources, training, and support tailored for young children. In school and daily life, young children are encouraged to put into practice 'exploratory learning', equipping them with 21st century key skills including innovation, communications, and collaboration. This project covered various community and research activities, this year it launched the 'Exploratory Kindergarten Certification Scheme' this year and arranged the 4th CoolPlay' International Conference on Early Exploration. Exploratory Kindergarten Certification Scheme' aims to recognize local education organizations and elites with outstanding performance in early childhood education. The scheme also carries the aspiration of setting a standard of excellence for early childhood education in Hong Kong, providing professional guidance to pioneer the industry to reinvent by injecting innovation in implementing 'exploratory learning'.

"We are honoured to receive the Honorable Mention in the FSTE Teaching Excellence Award. This achievement is a vital piece of the bigger picture we have been building. Our teaching materials JumpStarter series has won multiple international awards for its innovative design, and now this recognition from FSTE completes the picture by affirming our excellence in teaching itself. Our mission has always been to empower teachers to inspire exploration and curiosity in young learners. We believe that impactful education requires both outstanding materials and effective teaching. The success of our JumpStarter series showed the power of the resources we created. This teaching award now validates our ability to bring those materials to life in the classroom, empowering teachers to foster exploration through play-based learning in young children," said Dr Brad Chan, Co-leader of the project.

YCCECE teaching team for Jockey Club 'CoolPlay' Project has received an Honorable Mention in the FSTE Teaching Excellence Award (TEA) 2024. The prizes were presented by Dr Christine Choi, Secretary for Education at the FSTE 30th anniversary ceremony on 22 November 2024.

耀中幼教學院教學團隊憑藉賽馬會「智·幼·趣」計劃,其優秀的教與學表現和成就獲頒本年度《自資高等教育聯盟年度傑出教學獎》榮譽大獎。頒獎典禮在2024年11月22日於自資高等教育聯盟成立 30 週年珍禧誌慶上舉行,由教育局長蔡若蓮女士頒發。

自資高等教育聯盟傑出教學獎旨在表彰和獎勵自 資高等教育聯盟成員機構中教學表現優秀的教師。這個年度行業獎項還旨在促進和分享良好的 學習與教學實踐,以培養成員高等教育機構之間 的質量提升文化。今年,賽馬會「智·幼·趣」計劃 團隊獲得了榮譽大獎,亦是院校教學人員首個項 目獲得此項殊榮。賽馬會「智.幼.趣」計劃團 隊成員包括耀中幼教學院助理教授陳裕榮博士、 莊淯嫺講師、文若予講師及陳可兒講師。

賽馬會「智.幼.趣」計劃第二階段於2023年展 開,由香港賽馬會慈善信託基金捐助,耀中幼教 學院聯同香港基督教服務處合辦為期4年的幼兒 教育項目。項目為未來教師及在職教師提供教師 培訓。計劃以「兒童為本」理念,為幼教同業及 家長提供切合幼兒所需的教學資源、培訓及支 援,引導幼兒從校內以至日常生活中實踐「探索 式學習」,從而培養創意、溝通及合作等21世紀 關鍵技能。在計劃下推進多項社會及學術研究項 目,包括於今年首辦「卓越探索式幼稚園認證計 劃」及「智.幼.趣」早期探索國際研討會。「卓 越探索式幼稚園認證計劃」旨在嘉許於幼兒早期 探索教育有傑出表現的本地幼教機構和業界精 英,同時期望為香港幼兒教育樹立業界新標竿, 為同業建構一個基礎框架,並提供專業指引,推 動業界以創新方法實踐「探索式學習」,引領本地 幼教行業開啟百花齊放的新格局。

陳裕榮博士表示:「我們很榮幸在自資高等教育聯盟傑出教學獎中獲得榮譽大獎。這個成就是我們正在構建的更大發展藍圖中的重要一部分。我們的《JumpStarter》系列教學材料因其創新設計獲得多個國際獎項,而現在自資高等教育聯盟的這一認可進一步確認了我們在教學方面的卓越表現。我們的使命始終是賦能教師,激勵學童探索和好奇心。我們相信,有影響力的教育需要配備出色的教材和有效的教學指引。《JumpStarter》系列的成功展示了我們所創造資源的力量。這項教學獎項驗證了我們將這些材料帶入課堂的能力,使教師能夠通過基於遊戲的學習來促進幼兒的探索。」



Shenzhen-Hong Kong Early Childhood Education Symposium 深港幼教交流研討會

Co-hosted by Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE) and the Institute of Education Research at Shenzhen University (SZU), the inaugural Shenzhen-Hong Kong Early Childhood Education Symposium was successfully held at the International Conference Hall of Shenzhen Yuehai University's Campus on 21 November 2024. Renowned scholars, researchers, and educational practitioners in early childhood education from China and abroad gathered to discuss and share insights under the theme Research on Early Childhood Education Curriculum and Teaching.

國內外幼教領域的知 名學者、研究人員及 教育實踐者圍繞"幼 稚教育課程和教學研 究"主題展開了分享 與學術探討。

Professor Li Chen, Party Secretary of the Faculty of Education of SZU, presided over the opening ceremony. Professor Li Yonghua, Vice President of SZU, delivered an inspiring welcome speech, emphasizing that the forum aligns with educational reform and development trends and holds significant practical implications. He highlighted the importance of education cooperation in the Greater Bay Area as a catalyst for innovation and shared growth in early childhood education.

Professor Kerry Lee, President of YCCECE, remarked that the forum brought together experts from academia and practice to explore cutting-edge topics in the high-quality development of early childhood education. He noted that collaboration and knowledge exchange are key to fostering innovative practices in the field.

Shenzhen-Hong Kong Early Childhood Education Symposium 深港幼教交流研討會

The afternoon session, co-chaired by Professor Eric Cheng, Vice President (Academic) at YCCECE, and Dr Gao Chunhai, Senior Research Fellow at SZU, offered further insightful discussions.

Dr Brad Chan from YCCECE introduced the HKJC Coolplay Project, a Jockey Club-funded initiative integrating STEM education into early childhood curricula. He detailed the project's teacher training, classroom trials, and interschool collaboration, highlighting its success in enhancing children's scientific literacy and creativity.

Dr Gao Chunhai from SZU cited the Chinese poem Quiet Night Thoughts to explore children's aesthetic appreciation of poetry through a neuroeducation lens. He presented a three-element model of poetic aesthetics rooted in localized research.

The morning session, chaired by Professor Li Shuying, Dean of the Institute of Education Research at SZU, featured notable keynote speeches.

Professor Kathy Sylva, Honorary Fellow and Professor of Educational Psychology at the University of Oxford and member of the Board of Governors of YCCECE, delivered a presentation titled "Assessing the Early Childhood Curriculum and Pedagogical Quality". Her talk shared findings from a longitudinal study involving six regions, 141 kindergartens, and 3,000 children, exploring the impact of child, family, and school factors on academic and social behavior outcomes from aged 3 to 18.

Professor Liu Guoyan from SZU presented a talk on "Challenges and Opportunities in Collaborative Education under the Background of High-Quality Development". She analyzed survey data on home-kindergarten collaboration, addressing parental guidance needs, kindergarten support, and community involvement. Based on a "teaching alliance" framework, she proposed practical strategies for collaborative education.


下午的專題演講為與會者帶來了更多啟發,由耀中幼教學院副校長(學術)鄭志 強教授和深圳大學教育學部特聘副研究員 高淳海博士主持。

耀中幼教學院陳裕榮博士介紹了由香港賽馬會支持的「智·幼·趣」計劃,深入探討了STEM教育如何融入幼兒課程,並分享了該計劃的實施過程,包括標準化的教師培訓、使用JumpStarter教材、課堂試驗與到校支援、以及學校間的成功方法和經驗交流。陳博士通過具體的實踐案例,生動展示了"智·幼·趣"計畫在提高幼兒科學素養和創造力方面的顯著成果。

深圳大學高淳海博士以詩歌《靜夜思》為 引,解析了詩歌的美育功能。高博士進一 步探討了"美育"背後的行為機制,以神經 教育學的視角,分享了本土化探索幼兒詩 歌審美機制的研究設計與實踐成果,展示 了詩歌審美三要素模型。 上午的研討會由深圳大學教育研 究院院長李樹英教授主持。







## Shenzhen-Hong Kong Early Childhood Education Symposium 深港幼教交流研討會

Dr Rohnii Tse from YCCECE (Upper right photo) shared findings from the Jockey Club-supported The Bright Start Project, emphasizing the critical role of in-service training in improving infant care quality. She demonstrated how enhanced teacherchild interactions positively impact attachment, fine motor skills, and learning engagement.

Principal Liu Hongli of the Shenzhen Nanshan Government Agency Early Childhood Education Group (Lower right photo) shared her experiences in designing and implementing inquiry-based curricula under the theme "Igniting Curiosity: Construction and Practice of Kindergarten Inquiry-Based Activity Curriculum System." She emphasized that "Education for the future can take various curricular models, content carriers, and technological paths. A curriculum is never static, definitive, or fixed in its outcomes."









Professor Shi Ping from YCCECE (Upper left photo) delivered a keynote report titled "The Cultural Foundations, Theoretical Basis, and Practical Pathways of the Yew Chung Approach to Early Childhood Education." She highlighted the enduring core elements of Yew Chung's 90-year educational journey, underscoring the importance of educators deeply engaging in practice. Citing Dr. Betty Chan's unwavering dedication to teacher professional development, she called for a relentless pursuit of professional growth. Professor Shi emphasized that education must be rooted in practice, reflection, and improvement to deepen the understanding and application of theory. She described Yew Chung's pedagogy as a culmination of insights drawn from nine decades of experience. Finally, she offered a comprehensive analysis of the pedagogy's cultural foundations, theoretical underpinnings, and its application within an international educational context.

Principal Gan Lu of the Early Childhood Education Group of Longhua District Institute of Education Sciences in Shenzhen (Lower left photo) presented "Empowering Children's Learning Technology." She explored the profound value of technology in education from the perspectives of space, tools, and data empowerment. Principal Gan argued that when technology is seamlessly integrated into every aspect of education, it should become an inherent part of the learning process rather than a separate entity. She stressed that parents and educators should not restrict children's use of digital media but instead provide thoughtful intervention and support. The focus, she explained. should be on the quality of digital learning content and activities rather than merely limiting screen time.

耀中幼教學院時萍教授(左上圖) 分享專題報告《耀中幼教教學 法基於的文化、理論及其實踐 路徑》。闡釋了耀中90餘年教育 歷程中恒久不變的核心要素。 她通過"校長婆婆"(耀中教育機 構創始人曾楚珩女士) 的勤奮 實踐,強調教育者深入實踐的 重要性; 以陳保琼博士對教師 專業發展的持續關注,提醒大 家追求專業發展的不懈精神; 並指出教育必須親歷親為,通 過實踐、反思和改進來深化理 論的理解與應用。耀中幼教教 學法正是在90年實踐基礎上梳 理總結而成。最後,時教授深 入解析了其文化根基、理論依 據及國際化教育環境中的實踐 路徑。






Dr Zhang Ye from YCCECE gave a detailed presentation titled "Designing the Chinese Kindergarten Quality Rating Scale (CKQRS): Integrating Cultural Considerations." She provided insights into the project's background, literature review, research process, outcomes, and its considerations for cultural appropriateness. The CKQRS aims to create an evidence-based quality assessment tool tailored to China's cultural context, featuring actionable structural and process quality indicators. Dr Zhang explained that the project involved two stages: development and validation. During the development stage, the research team employed the Delphi method, engaging 18 early childhood education experts in two rounds of revisions to ensure content validity. A pilot study conducted in 40 kindergartens in Shenzhen led to the finalized version of the scale. In the validation stage, the scale was applied to 112 kindergartens across Shenzhen and Jiangsu, undergoing confirmatory factor analysis and tests for criterionrelated validity and reliability while being compared against existing scales.

Principal Li Chunling of the Daxin Early Childhood Education Group in Nanshan District, Shenzhen, shared insights into the group's philosophy, "Embracing Diversity and Embracing Change: The Path of School Management from the Perspective of Adaptability and Flexibility." She outlined the group's practices and development strategies across various management dimensions.

耀中幼教學院張曄博士詳細闡 述了"幼稚園品質評估研究"專案 的研究背景、文獻回顧、研究 過程、研究成果、以及量表在 文化適宜性6個方面的考量。該 專案旨在建構一套基於實證 的、適合我國文化的《幼稚園 品質評估量表 (CKQRS)》,包含 可操作的結構性和過程性質量 評價指標。張曄博士分享該量 表經歷了構建和驗證兩個階 段。在第一階段,研究團隊採 用德爾菲法,經過18位幼教專 家審閱及兩輪修訂, 以確保量 表的內容效度。隨後,研究團 隊在深圳市40所幼稚園進行試 點研究,形成了量表的終試用 版本。在量表的驗證階段,研 究團隊在深圳和江蘇兩地112所 幼稚園中使用此量表進行評 估,與其他既有量表進行對 照,進行了驗證性因數分析和 校標相關的信效度檢驗。

深圳市南山區大新幼教集團李春玲園長深入梳理了大新幼教集團秉承"有容為大有變乃新"的辦園理念,主動探索"容變"視角下的辦園之路,並分享其在管理領域的實踐探索與發展路徑。

## Shenzhen-Hong Kong Early Childhood Education Symposium 深港幼教交流研討會



## 耀中楚珩日 FOUNDER'S DAY



每年10月的第二個星期五,耀中耀華社區會聚在一起慶祝「耀中楚珩日」,以紀念曾楚珩女士於1932年創立耀中! 自2020年起,耀中耀華設立「校友名人堂」,以表彰對社區作出卓越貢獻的畢業生,並在楚珩日當天頒發獎項。

來自全球20所學校的師生通過直播一起歡度楚珩日。校務委員會主席陳麗生博士及校長袁教授在耀中幼教學院頒獎給2024年耀中耀華「校友名人堂」得獎者劉萌然博士。劉博士於2018年在耀中幼教學院完成幼兒教育高級文憑,隨後在新西蘭的奧克蘭大學取得博士學位,再回到耀中幼教學院擔任助理教授。

慶典結束後,耀中幼教學院師生按照傳統以健康運動作慶祝,師生們分成 幾個小隊,參加由學院舉辦的活動,包括K-pop舞蹈、瑜伽及自由搏擊, 度過了一個愉快的下午。

Every year on the second Friday of October, the Yew Chung Yew Wah community celebrates "Founder's Day", commemorating the founding of Yew Chung by Madam Tsang Chor Hang in 1932. Since 2020, YCYW have established the "Alumni Hall of Fame" to recognize graduates for their outstanding contributions to the community, with awards given on Founder's Day.

Students and staff from 20 schools around the world celebrated together via livestream broadcasting. Dr Lydia Chan, YCCECE's Council Chairperson, and President Professor Allan Yuen presented the award to Dr Mengran Liu, the 2024 recipient of YCYW Alumni Hall of Fame. Dr Liu earned her Higher Diploma in Early Childhood Education at YCCECE in 2018 and later received her Ph.D. from the University of Auckland, and returning to serve as an Assistant Professor in YCCECE.

After the ceremony, staff and studnets joined various health activities, including K-pop dancing, yoga practice, and kickboxing, enjoying a fun afternoon together!





## "Child-Centered" Curriculum Practices — Kindergarten Teaching Design Template

### 校長論壇|以「兒童為本」課程實踐 —— 幼稚園教學設計範例

Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE) hosted an engaging Principal Forum themed "Child-Centered" Curriculum Practices - Kindergarten Teaching Design Template on Thursday, 12 December 2024.

The event aimed to explore ways of delivering top-notch early childhood education in line with the "Child-Centered" educational philosophy, focusing on the diverse growth needs of young learners

Speakers including Ms Joey Chan, Lecturer (Practice) of YCCECE, Principal Li Shuk Yin of Oi Kwan Road Baptist Church Lui Kwok Pat Fong Kindergarten, Principal Wong Yuk Hing of The Endeavourers Chan Cheng Kit Wan Kindergarten, and Ms Chow Wai Chun, chairman of Hong Kong Early Childhood Educators Association.

Professor Kerry Lee, President and Chair Professor of Child Development of YCCECE, delivered a welcome note and kicked off the event. He emphasized the importance of childcentric approaches and learning through play. 在2024年12月12日(星期四),耀中幼教學院舉辦了一場富有啟發性的校長論壇,主題為「以『兒童為本』課程實踐——幼稚園教學設計範例」。

教育局強調幼兒教育應做到「以兒童為本」,照顧幼兒多方面成長需要。這次活動旨在探討如何實踐優質幼兒教育,符合教育局「以兒童為本」的理念,關注幼兒多方面成長需求。

活動邀請了多位教育專業人士,包 括耀中幼教學院講師(專業實踐) 陳可兒女士、愛群道浸信會呂郭碧 鳳幼稚園李淑賢校長、勵志會陳鄭 潔雲幼稚園黃玉卿校長及香港幼兒 教育人員協會周慧珍會長出席分享 並與各參會者交流意見。

在講座開始前,耀中幼教學院校長暨兒童發展講座教授李敬廉教授致辭歡迎各位來賓,他特別強調教育應以幼兒為中心,以及「遊戲中學習」的重要性。











Principal Li Shuk Yin and Ms Lau from Oi Kwan Road Baptist Church Lui Kwok Pat Fong Kindergarten shared their picture book education. The school's picture book teaching curriculum gradually cultivates children's interest in reading over a period of three years, adds picture books to extended learning, and then replaces part of the unit teaching with picture books, and further launches the "Parent-Child Reading Book Scheme", which moves books from the library on the second floor to the first floor every week for parents to easily borrow. It also organizes drama teaching training for teachers and parents, and arranges picture book extended drama activities for children, so as to enhance the ability of teachers, students and parents to grasp and interpret picture books in all aspects. The school will continue to turn "picture book education" into a teaching tool through drama techniques, and hopes that other schools will learn from the experience to develop picture book

Principal Wong Yuk Hing introduced the JELIC "Multitalents Program" used in the Endeavourers Chan Cheng Kit Wan Kindergarten, designing to help children build learning habits and concepts, nurturing their judgment, emotional management, logical thinking, and creative abilities.

The chairman of Hong Kong Early Childhood Educators Association Ms Chow Wai Chun stressed the importance of "Unity of Knowledge and Action" emphasizing the need for teachers to apply educational theories and for principals to seek teaching resources, empowering teachers to implement "Child-Centered" Curriculum Practices.

愛群道浸信會呂郭碧鳳幼稚園的李淑賢校 長和劉主任分享了他們的繪本教育經驗, 詳細介紹了校本繪本教學課程和親子伴 圖書計劃。該校的校本繪本教學課程循 , 漸進地以三年時間培養幼兒閱讀興趣 , 前 論本延伸學習,再以繪本代替部分單 , 並推出「親子伴讀圖書計劃」,每 思 把圖書由二樓圖書館搬至一樓,方便家長 借閱;又為教師和家長舉辦戲劇教學培 訓,為幼兒安排繪本延展戲劇活動等,全 方面提升師生和家長掌握和演繹繪本的能 力。

黃玉卿校長介紹了勵志會陳鄭潔雲幼稚園的 (JELIC)多元智能課程,該課程旨在幫助幼兒建立學習習慣和概念,培育他們的判斷、情緒管理、邏輯思維和創造能力。 JELIC 是以下各項的縮寫: 判斷商 (JQ)、情緒商 (EQ)、邏輯商 (LQ)、智商 (IQ)和創造力商 (CQ)。JELIC 計劃由幼兒教育工作者、數學教育工作者和心理學家設計,結合了蒙特梭利、加德納和皮亞傑的理論。該計劃在美國、中國大陸/台灣、新加坡等地廣泛推廣。 黃校長隨即播放學生玩JELIC寶盒的片段展示學習成果,現場參加者均深感興趣。

周慧珍會長總結了活動,強調了「知行合一」的重要性,教師應該實踐教學理論,校長應該尋找教學資源,讓教師有時間實踐「以兒童為本」的教學。



## 為校園注入 繽紛色彩 Let the Campus filled with Colors

在九月,藝術家 Haruka Ostley 帶領廣州耀華國際學校的學生創作了一幅充滿活力的壁畫,以慶祝學校成立十周年。這幅壁畫的主題為「根與翼」,象徵著 Haruka 希望學生們的最大夢想和熱情能在未來蓬勃發展,將愛與和平傳播到全世界!同月下旬,她來到耀中幼教學院,帶領學生一起繪製壁畫。

### 問: 您能告訴我們您的背景和壁畫藝術經驗 嗎?

您好! 我是 Haruka Ostley,一名居住在充滿活力的上海的跨媒體藝術家,目前在 耀中國際學校 浦東校區工作。我的藝術旅程使我能夠在各個 耀中耀華網絡的校園以及中國以外的地區創作無數的合作壁畫。在此之前,我曾是一名美國的自由藝術家,有幸通過在各種公共空間創作壁畫來團結社區。我的背景是美術,創作的作品曾在中國、日本和美國的畫廊和博物館展出。

## 問:您創作這幅壁畫的靈感來自於什麼? 您希望傳達哪些特定的主題或信息? 這幅壁畫是專 門為耀中幼教學院設計的嗎?

這幅壁畫的主要目的是為耀中幼教學院的學生提供一個寧靜的校園空間,讓他們能夠在繁忙的學習生活中暫時靜心反思和祈禱。我的靈感來源於大自然的美麗和我的家鄉,在那裡我總是感受到與上帝的親近,以及這座城鎮與水和魚之間的深厚聯繫。壁畫中描繪的一群魚,強烈地象徵著團結與共融。

In September, artist Haruka Ostley guided students at YWIES Guangzhou in creating a vibrant mural wall to celebrate the school's 10th Anniversary. The theme, "Roots and Wings," symbolizes Haruka's hope that the students' wildest dreams and passions will flourish, spreading love and peace to the world! Later in the month, she came to YCCECE and led students in completing a mural project.

### Q. Can you tell us about your background and experience in mural art?

Hello! I'm Haruka Ostley, a multidisciplinary artist based in the vibrant city of Shanghai, currently working at the YCIS Pudong Campus. My artistic journey has allowed me to create numerous collaborative murals across various YCYW campuses and even beyond the borders of China. Prior to this, I was a freelance artist in the United States, where I had the incredible opportunity to unite communities through my murals in diverse public spaces. With a background in fine art, I have developed a body of work that has been exhibited in galleries and museums across China, Japan, and the United States.

## Q. What inspired you to create this mural? Are there specific themes or messages you want to convey? Is it specially designed for YCCECE?

The primary purpose of this mural is to offer YCCECE students a serene space on campus where they can pause for reflection and prayer amidst their hectic study schedules. My inspiration comes from the beauty of nature and my hometown, where I have always felt closest to God, as well as the town's deep connection to water and fish. The depiction of a school of fish serves as a powerful metaphor for unity and togetherness.

In designing this mural, I considered the diverse backgrounds, cultures, and beliefs of our students. As they embark on their journey to become the next generation of early childhood educators, it is essential for all educators to embody respect and trust, moving forward together toward the light of divine love. To express this message, I utilized a variety of colors and landscapeinspired shapes, creating a vibrant and inviting atmosphere that reflects our collective spirit and aspirations.





問: 您認為這幅壁畫將如何影響耀中幼教學院師生和當地 社區?

我相信這幅壁畫將為我們的社區注入活力,因為創作過程 是一次合作的努力,吸引了許多學生在空閒時間參與其 中。我非常重視讓社區參與這類活動;這些共同的經歷不 僅將我們團結在一起,還培養了對我們集體身份的自豪 感。我希望每一筆每一色都能成為持久的記憶,激勵他們 在日常生活中勇敢追夢並傳播正能量。通過共同努力,我 們創造了美麗的作品,真實地反映了我們共同的精神和願 望。

## 問: 能否與我們分享這幅壁畫的設計過程? 從概念到執行,您採取了哪些步驟?

在來到校園之前,我有幾個不同的壁畫想法,但這些概念 往往在看到實際空間後會有所變化。第一次參觀時,我立 刻感受到這個區域需要充滿活力的顏色——那些能夠與年 輕孩子的能量和精神產生共鳴的色調。這一認識促使我重 新考慮我的初步計劃。

最初,我有一個特定的牆面作為壁畫的設計對象,但當我探索走廊時,我意識到整個區域都需要營造一種歡迎社區的氛圍。這種視角的轉變帶來了新的挑戰,特別是考慮到我面臨的時間限制!我設想的設計應該能夠從一端流暢地延伸到另一端,吸引人們進入這個空間。由於牆面尚未準備好進行繪畫,我首先進行了底漆處理。整個設計逐漸發展,一段一段地進行。我仔細考慮周圍的形狀,並選擇了相互協調的顏色。

在開始時,我保持形狀相當抽象,故意避免任何具體的表現。我的目標是創造一個可以引發不同解釋的設計,就像孩子們凝視雲彩時想像出不同的形狀——「看!那是一隻羊!」我希望這幅壁畫能夠激發觀眾的想像力,讓他們看到一條河、一條滑梯或一棟房子,鼓勵他們在探索藝術作品時進行思考。我的希望是,當人們與這幅壁畫互動時,他們能夠持續發現新意義和新元素。

## Q. How do you believe this mural will impact the people in YCCECE and the local community?

I believe this mural will invigorate our community, as the painting process was a collaborative effort that engaged many students during their free time. I place great importance on involving the community in such initiatives; these shared experiences not only unite us but also cultivate a sense of pride in our collective identity. My hope is that every brushstroke and vibrant color they contributed will become a lasting memory, inspiring them to dream big and spread positivity in their daily lives. Together, we have crafted something beautiful that truly reflects our shared spirit and aspirations.

## Q. Can you walk us through your design process for this mural? What steps did you take from concept to execution?

Before arriving on campus, I had several ideas for the mural, but those concepts often evolve once I see the actual space. Upon my first visit, I immediately sensed that this area called for vibrant colors—hues that resonate with the energy and spirit of young children. This realization prompted me to rethink my initial plan.

Originally, I had a specific wall in mind for the mural, but as I explored the hallway, it became clear that the entire area needed to create a welcoming atmosphere for the community. This shift in perspective presented a new challenge, especially given the time constraints I faced! I envisioned a design that would flow seamlessly from one end to the other, inviting people into the space. Since the wall wasn't ready for painting, I began by priming it. The design itself evolved gradually, section by section. I carefully considered the shapes around me and selected colors that harmonized beautifully.

To start, I kept the shapes quite abstract, intentionally avoiding any specific representations. My aim was to create a design that could evoke various interpretations, much like how children gaze at clouds and envision different forms—"Look! There's a sheep!" I wanted the mural to inspire viewers to see a river, a slide, or a house, encouraging them to engage their imaginations as they explore the artwork. My hope is that, as people interact with the mural, they continue to discover new meanings and elements within it.



## Principal and Career Master Day 耀中幼教學院校長與生涯規劃教育組導師日

On 4 December 2024, Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE) successfully hosted the "Principal and Career Master Day," an event designed to foster meaningful discussions among school principals and career masters about the updated programs offered by the and the future of Early Childhood Education (ECE) in Hong Kong.

The event began with a welcoming speech from President Professor Kerry Lee, who shared his teaching journey in childhood education. He recounted his beginnings at a private college in Australia, his teaching career at Education University of Hong Kong, and his current role at YCCECE. Professor Lee expressed his aspiration to elevate early childhood education through the strong network and legacy of Yew Chung, both in Hong Kong and globally. He emphasised his belief that a new era of ECE learning is on the horizon, filled with opportunities for innovation and growth.

The day featured two insightful talks from esteemed faculty members of the College. Dr Crystal Zheng presented on the topic of "Enhancing Students' Chances of Getting an Undergraduate Degree." She highlighted case studies demonstrating how students have successfully obtained their degrees through multiple entry points, showcasing the flexibility and support available to them.











Following Dr Zheng's presentation, Dr Bradley Mellen delivered a talk titled "Effective Ways to Boost Students' Language Proficiency and Confidence." He shared compelling statistics on the improvement of students' language skills through personalized tutoring and immersive language environments, illustrating the impact of targeted educational strategies. The event attracted a diverse group of principals and career masters, primarily from local schools. Attendees expressed their eagerness to gain more information from YCCECE that could benefit their students and explore potential career pathways in early childhood education.

活動開始由校長李敬廉教授致歡迎致辭,他分享了自己在幼兒教育領域的教學旅程。他回顧自己的教學路由澳洲一所私立學院起步,其後加入香港教育大學,目前在耀中幼教學院。李教授表示通過耀中在香港及全球的強大網絡和傳承提升幼兒教育的願景。他強調,相信一個充滿創新與成長機會的幼兒教育學習新時代即將來臨。

當天的活動中,學院的兩位卓越教師發表了深刻的演講。鄭婉薇博士以"提升學生獲得學士學位的機會"為題進行了演講。她分享案例,展示了學生如何通過多種入學途徑成功獲得學位,突顯了學院課程的靈活性及對學生的支持。

在鄭博士的演講之後,Brad Mellen博士發表了題為"提升學生語言能力和自信心的有效方法"的演講。他分享了統計數據,有關通過個人輔導和沉浸式語言環境提高學生語言技能,說明了針對性教育策略的影響。

此次活動吸引了來自主要本地學校的多位校長和職業導師參加。與會者表達了希望獲取更多有助於學生了解耀中幼教學院的資訊,並希望探索幼兒教育相關的職業發展路徑。

# Introducing the "Yew Chung Approach to Early Childhood Education" 發揚《耀中幼教教學法》







Professor Shi Ping delivered a captivating public talk on the Yew Chung Approach to Early Childhood Education during the Expo on 13 December 2024. The mini stage attracted numerous educators eager to explore the unique aspects of this approach compared to other pedagogies. By participating in the seminars and workshops, educators could accrue CPD hours at the Expo. Several students who took part in the event expressed that it provided them with valuable opportunities to network with industry experts and gain insights into the current and future trends in education.

In addition to showcasing the Yew Chung Approach to Early Childhood Education, the College actively participated in the Expo with the HKJC CoolPlay Project, generously supported by the Jockey Club Charity Trust. Over the course of three days, the project conducted seven engaging workshops, attracting near 80 participants. Dr Brad Chan Yuwing, Assistant Professor of the College and Co-Director of the Project, emphasized, "This year's event has expanded, serving as a platform for industry professionals to exchange ideas and strengthen the teacher professional community. The HKJC CoolPlay Project not only drew interest from kindergartens but also from innovative suppliers, particularly those focusing on exploring learning and sustainability for young children, opening up new avenues for the future of early childhood education."

時萍教授於12月13日在學與教博覽上發表了《耀中幼教教學法》的公開演講。這個迷你舞台吸引了許多教育工作者,包括其他院校幼教老師,他們對比較這種方法與其他教學法感到興趣。另外學院教師於學院展位推廣《耀中幼教教學法》,三日共舉行六場迷你分享,參加者更即場自製教學法十二項信條鎖匙扣。幾位參與協助的同學均表示活動令他們有機會接觸更多業界人士,更可以了解現時及未來教育的發展趨勢。

除了向業界展示《耀中幼教教學法》之外,學院引以為傲並由賽馬會捐款支持的「智·幼·趣」計劃亦有參展,三日內共舉辦7個工作坊,向業界簡介計劃的內容及推行細節,吸引約80位幼教界人士踴躍參與。學院助理教授兼計劃聯席總監陳裕榮博士表示:「這個博覧規模比往年更大,成為業內專業人士交流創新意念的平台、加強教育界別互相認識。賽馬會『智·幼·趣』計劃吸引不只幼稚園,更多的是為幼兒提供服務的包括科技、環保等新品供應商,為未來幼兒教育提供新的發展機遇。」

### **Child Caregiving Seminar for Expectant Moms**

給孕媽媽的講座: 嬰幼兒照顧

On 24 November 2024, the Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE) participated in the Pregnancy Seminar organised by Champimom, drawing over 200 expectant mothers eager to learn more about childcare and early childhood development.

Lecturer Joey Chan presented an insightful talk on the latest continuing professional development course: the Certificate in Child Caregiving, which is recognised under the Qualifications Framework (QF Level 3). This course is designed to introduce key concepts of early childhood development and care for children from newborns to age 8. It covers various prominent child development theories, equipping participants with the knowledge to apply positive strategies and practices that best support a child's growth and development.

## YCCECE, Bring Me a Book and OneSky Global Centre Collaborate to Boost Children's Literacy 耀中幼教學院、書伴我行基金會和 一片天國際啟育中心合作強化兒童讀寫能力



耀中幼教學院很高興與本地慈善機構書伴我行基金會(BMAB)合作,為一班學院幼兒教育榮譽學士學位課程二年級學生提供「講故事」技巧的專業培訓工作坊。「兒童語言和讀寫能力」為幼兒教育榮譽學士二年級課程其中的一個重點科目,學院的學生通過本課程能夠學習如何有效地以「講故事」來提高兒童讀寫能力的最佳方法。

在完成專業的培訓後,兩團學院學生分別在10月16日的上午和下午獲安排到訪位於深水埗的李伯中一片天國際啟育中心(OSGC),為二十個家庭舉行兩場別開生面且趣味盎然的講故事活動,將理論實踐,並學以至用。

Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education (YCCECE) collaborated with Bring Me A Book Hong Kong (BMAB), a local charity advocating for family literacy, to arrange Storytelling training for a group of Year 2 Bachelor of Education student teachers. This is part of their study module focusing on "Child language and literacy", in which YCCECE students can learn the best practices for effective storytelling to enhance children's literacy.

Following the taught training session, YCCECE student teachers conducted a vibrant storytelling session for 20 families at the P. C. Lee OneSky Global Centre (OSGC) for Early Childhood Development in Sham Shui Po on 16 October 2024 over two sessions in the morning and afternoon.





## YCCECE Dinosaur Charity Run Comes Back 恐龍慈善跑
