OUR VISITORS



1980

The club was formed under the name Montagu FC by former secretary Russell Yezek, before being renamed to Sun FC.

1995

The club was renamed to its current name, Huntingdon Town, following a move from the West Anglian League to the Cambridgeshire League, and entered the Cambs League Division 2B for the 1996-97 season. The club committee had decided it wanted to progress through local football, and chose to resurrect the then-defunct Huntingdon Town name, the name formerly used until the 1940's by a Huntingdon-based team that then merged with Huntingdon Wanderers to form Huntingdon United in 1948.

1998-2003

The club was promoted from Division 2B to 1B in 1997-98, before winning Division 1B in 1999-2000, as well as winning the Huntingdon Junior Cup. The following year, the club retained the Hunts Junior Cup, but was defeated in the Hunts Scott Gatty Cup.

The 2001-02 season saw more success, with the club going one step better to win the Scott Gatty Cup, and retaining the Hunts Junior Cup for the third year in a row. The club also finished runners up in the Cambs League Senior B Division and the Percy Oldham Cup in that season.

In 2003, the club moved to its current-day home, Jubilee Park (presently known as Hunters Stadium), which allowed work to be undertaken on facility upgrades needed to continue the club's progression through the leagues.

2003 also saw the club debut in the UCL Division 1, having transferred from the Cambs League at the end of 2002-03.

2003-08

The club's first four years in the UCL were more challenging, with the club finishing 17th, 14th, 12th and 14th respectively. However, the club's fifth season in the UCL was much more fruitful, the 2007-08 season seeing the club finish 4th, only missing out on promotion by goal difference. The reserve team won the Reserve Division 2 title and won the Hunts Benevolent Cup.

In July 2004 the new floodlighting system was opened with a friendly against League 1 side Peterborough United, which attracted a crowd of nearly 1000 spectators.

2009-16

The new clubhouse was opened for the 2009-10 season, at a cost of £1.1 million. The only on-field success this season was the U18 side, who won the treble, the league, the League Cup and the County Cup.

2010-11 was an up-and-down year, with the team starting the season slowly until Ricky Marheineke & Paul Swannell took charge in February 2011, with the team sitting third bottom, and eventually guided the club to 5th by the end of the season.

Our visitors continued

The pair built on this success in their first full season, 2011-12, storming to the United Counties League Division 1 title, scoring over 100 goals along the way, with Marheineke winning two Manager of the Month awards. Town also reached the semi-finals of the Hinchingsbrooke Cup but lost 3-0 to St Neots Town. 2011-12 also saw a 50-seater stand erected.

2012-13 saw Town finish a lofty 4th in their first season in the Premier Division, scoring over 100 goals, and reaching the final of the Hunts Senior Cup, however the club were beaten on penalties after a 0-0 draw, once again to St Neots Town.

The second 50-seater stand was erected.

In 2013-14 Town finished 2nd in the league, but won the league KO cup and the Hinchingsbrooke Cup for the first time.

2014-15 and 2015-16 were far more difficult campaigns, with the club staving off relegation in 2014-15, before finishing rock bottom in 2015-16, however Town were reprieved from relegation by circumstance. 2015-16 also saw the loss of the Reserve and U18 teams by the end of the season.

2016 - present

Town finished bottom of the league again in 2016-17, and this time were relegated to Division 1, however the U18 team was restarted during the season.

Town finished 12th in Division 1 in its first season back (2017-18), but reached the final of the Hinchingsbrooke Cup.

2018-19 was another tough campaign for the club, finishing 3rd bottom.

2019-20 looked like more of the same, although investments were made to improve the pitch and other facilities at Jubilee Park. The club was 2nd bottom, however, when lockdown hit, and the season was suspended.

2020-21 was another curtailed season, with the club 10th when the season was suspended again. The club transferred to the Eastern Counties League Division 1 for 2021-22.

The club finished 7th in the ECL Division 1 in both 2021-22 and 2022-23, before being transferred again, to the Spartan South Midlands League Division One for 2023-24.

Under the new ownership of Richard Maxwell, and with a new coaching staff, ethos and new players, with facility upgrades over the off-season, the club finished 14th in 2023-24, and with more upgrades to the ground and facilities ahead of 2024-25, will be looking to move up the table.

ESSENTIAL READING FOR FOLLOWERS OF THE NATIONAL GAME

TWO rounds from gracing the hallowed turf at Wembley Stadium, it's perfectly natural to assume that players from the 16 clubs competing in this weekend's Isuzu FA Trophy and Vase quarter-finals are getting pretty twitchy right now.

So, as a football manager, the question is how do you channel those nerves, excitement, and perhaps a tinge of anxiety, into a winning mentality? Is it possible to keep emotions in check and feet on the ground?

Well, as Hartpury University manager Dr Martin Longworth told me this week, the answer is with great difficulty.

Dr Longworth's entire Hartpury squad are made up of current students aged between 16 and 25 with dreams of a lasting football careers, and they're making a pretty good fist of it so far, sitting pretty on top of the Hellenic League Premier Division table on the back of a 27-game unbeaten run stretching back to September.

"It's really hard to keep a 16-18-year-old's feet on the ground when you're two rounds from Wembley and we haven't shied away from that," Dr Longwell said.

"We've made it very clear that that could happen, there's no point hiding from it – it's good motivation for us.

"Yes, you've got to take each game as it comes but, ultimately, we are potentially two rounds from Wembley."

Hartpury's two-game mission starts this afternoon when Southern Counties East League side Erith & Belvedere are the visitors to the Hartpury University Stadium they share with the Rugby Championship club of the same name.

Many people's favourites for the Vase, Dr Longwell's men have won all four of their matches 1-0 to get to this stage, could history repeat itself all the way to the semi-finals this afternoon.

In the other three quarter-final ties, Southern Counties East League play-off chasers Whitstable Town take on Whitchurch Alport, of the Midland Football League, while bookies' favourites AFC Whyteleafe, of the Combined Counties Premier South, take on United Counties League Premier North opponents Bourne Town.

an ineligible player, complete the line-up with the Wessex League side hosting United Counties League side Heanor Town, making the last eight for

the first time in their history.

The Isuzu FA Trophy is just as intriguing.

Story of the season, undoubtedly, are Step 4 Isthmian League Division One South East club Sittingbourne FC.

Not only are the Brickies the last non-National League club standing, but they have also won through eight ties, scoring 18 goals along the way.

During that run, Ryan Maxwell's side have beaten SIX teams on higher standing, including away at National League Southend United in the last round.

According to our friends at @FATrophyFactfile, their run to the last eight in the club's 50th FA Trophy campaign, is a competition record.

This lunchtime, Sittingbourne host National League Aldershot Town for whom a victory would equal their best Trophy performances to the semi-finals, last achieved 17 years ago.

Since the original Aldershot FC were formed 99 years ago, the club has never reached a Wembley final.

Elsewhere, the Shots' local rivals, and three times former Trophy winners, Woking, travel to National League North opponents Oxford City who are equalling their best Trophy run from four years ago.

The Hoops will be looking to make it third time lucky against Woking in the FA Trophy having twice exited the competition at the hands of The Cards in the past.

The only other National League North club still involved are looking to prevent their opponents from avenging a past Trophy defeat. Spennymoor Town travel to National League side and 1980-81 Trophy finalists, Sutton United, hoping to replicate their 3-0 victory over the Us from six years ago.

And in the only all-National League affair, Rochdale, in just their second Trophy campaign, host an Altrincham side aiming to try to lift the Trophy for the third time in the club's history.

One thing's for sure, they'll be 16 squads of players going hell for leather this afternoon in a bid to get one step closer to Finals Day on Sunday May 11.

As the great Ossie Ardiles sung during Tottenham Hotspur's FA Cup song back in 1981, 'Ossie's Going To Wembley, His Knees Have Gone All Trembly'.

If the Vase and Trophy hopefuls aren't nervous and excited enough this weekend, they'll be plenty of trembly knees on the terraces, that's for sure.

CLUB HISTORY

Buckingham Football Club is a football club based in Buckingham, Buckinghamshire, England. Formed by a merger of Buckingham Athletic and Buckingham United in 2023, they are currently members of the Spartan South Midlands League Division One and play at Stratford Fields.

The club was first formed in 1933 as **Buckingham Juniors**, but it was three years before a ground was found, allowing the club to enter the Brackley and District League. When they got their ground, it was originally called Timm's Meadow, before later becoming Stratford Fields. In 1939 the club adopted **Buckingham Athletic FC** as its name. It then took the club 27 years to win its first trophy when in 1960–61 they won their first trophy, the North Bucks League Shield.

In 1965 they applied and was accepted to the Hellenic League where they played in Division 1 finishing a creditable mid-table position in their first season but also won the Berks & Bucks FA Junior Cup. Their success continued and in 68/69 was promoted to the Premier Division after finishing Division runners-up.

The late 60's brought about some good success for the whole club with the Youth, Reserve and First teams all picking up trophies with the First winning the Buckinghamshire Senior Cup for the first time.

After a steady decline in fortunes in 78/79 the club returned to the North Bucks League and it wasn't until the mid-80's that further success was achieved.

This was the start of a successful period for the club and after winning the North Bucks Premier League title they moved to the South Midlands Division 1 in 1985 winning the league at their first attempt, losing only 3 games throughout the season.

However, success came too quickly, and the ground facilities were not ready for promotion to the Premier Division so they had to remain in Division 1.

The following season they were once again knocking on the door of the Premier League as they finished runners-up but a last minute hold up on planning permission once again stalled promotion. However, promotion was achieved the following year when they did the league and cup double and with correct ground grading in place the club was promoted to the Premier League for the first time.

Throughout the 90's all the teams in the club consistently won trophies

although the highest the first team achieved in the Premier League was in 97 when they finished 5th.

The late 90's the club struggled financially, and they made a very difficult decision to drop out of the top flight and they were placed back in Division 2. A level of stability was brought about the club and in 2003 they were promoted back to Division 1.

Once again ground grading held the club back as in 2004 they finished runners-up in Division 1 and promotion back to the Premier league was denied.

Since 05/06 a huge amount of work has taken place to upgrade the clubhouse and football facilities but unfortunately success on the field has been sparse.

In 2023 Buckingham Athletic started talks with Buckingham United to bring the two clubs together with the sole purpose of having one senior football team in the town.

Buckingham United FC were formed in 2011 with the sole aim of providing local grassroots football. This began as a single Sunday side playing in Deanshanger due to a lack of local facilities. After the first season the club moved to Tingewick but it was not until 2016 when the club finally moved into Buckingham to the new Lace Hill Sports and Community Centre. The club joined the North Bucks and District League before joining the South Midlands League Division Two in 2019. Here the club grew quickly providing grassroots football across various levels and abilities which peaked with eight teams by 2021, this included Saturday First and Reserves, Sunday League A & B sides, Veterans, Ladies along with an Under 21s and Under 18s.

The club reached many cup finals across the teams including winning the North Bucks and District League Division One shield in 2018. In the final season under Buckingham United the ladies side really gave the club a wonderful finally winning the Northants Premier Division Title and League Cup double.

As a result of many meetings between the clubs, both Buckingham Athletic & Buckingham United formally agreed to pass the motion to combine both clubs, creating Buckingham Football Club, which now has one of the largest offerings of adult football in the region with a structured youth pathway with our strategic partners Moretonville Junior FC.

This is not an end to Buckingham Athletic or Buckingham United, this is very much a continuation in the story of these clubs and football within the town. The history of which won't be forgotten.

The ultimate aim of combining the clubs is to provide the town with a sustainable non-league football club by sharing resources, passionate volunteers, and great sporting facilities. A club with the aim of pushing up the pyramid while also providing structured football for the community, maintaining the fun and enjoyment of the game that everyone loves.

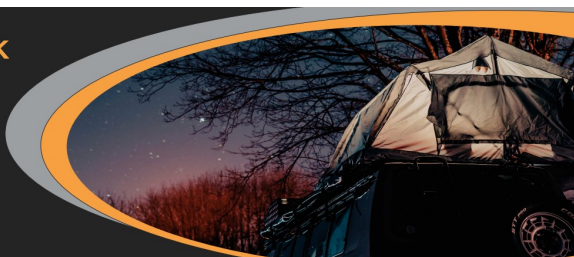
