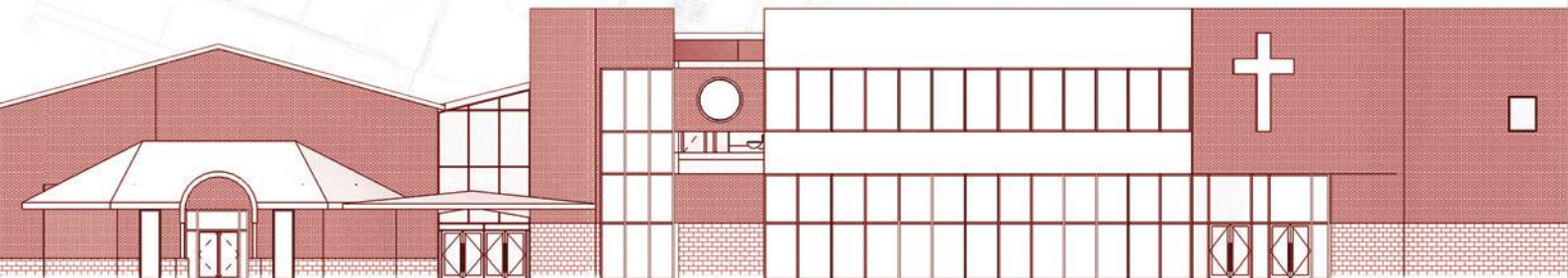
THE *VISION*

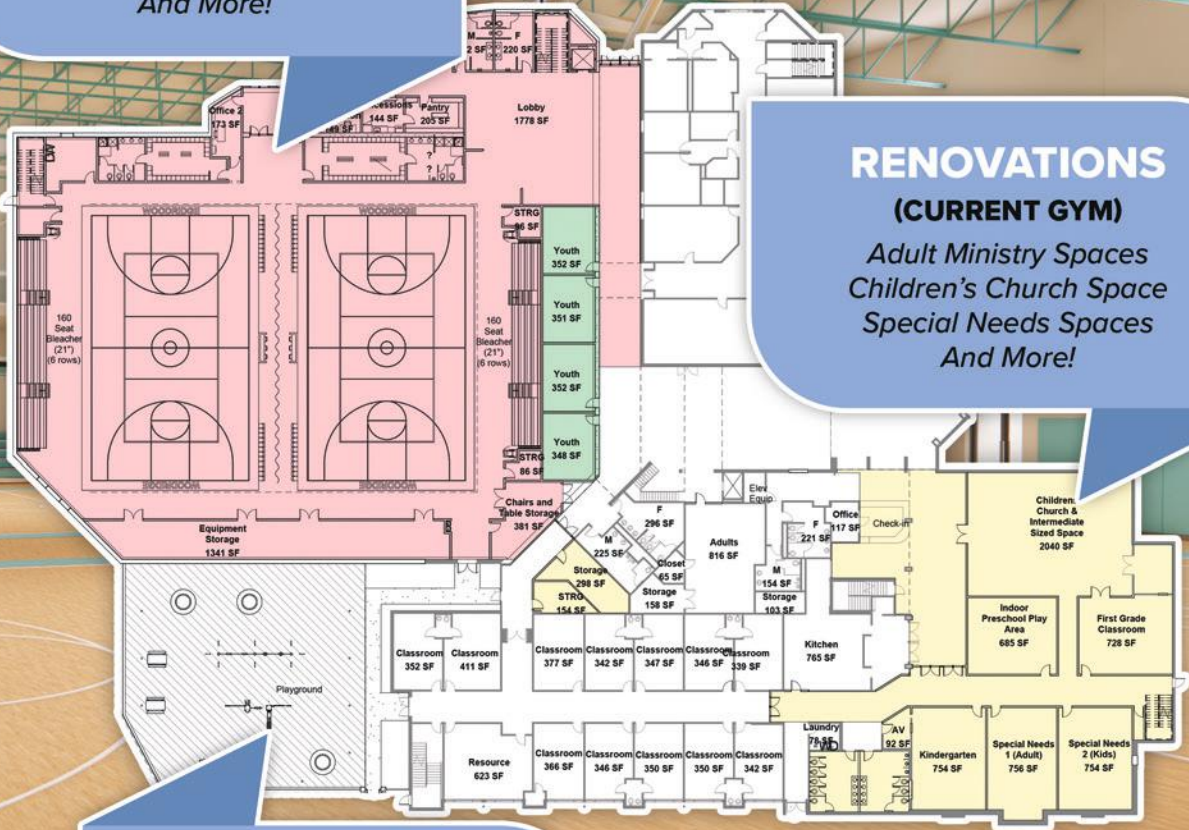
