# Discover Egypt and the Nile Valley | Itinerary Highlights

Day EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day ARRIVE IN CAIRO, EGYPT Upon arrival to Cairo International Airport an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. Settle into your luxurious accommodations with time to refresh and unwind—the remainder of the afternoon and evening are at leisure. Cairo itself is bustling with vibrant energy, as locals move about their daily lives. Overnight: Marriott Mena House, Cairo

CAIRO I GIZA (B,L,D) Awake to extraordinary Day views of pyramids and palm trees situated against Cairo's expansive horizon. Following breakfast view the iconic Great Pyramidthe oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World—and the Great Sphinx, impressively carved from a single mass of limestone atop the Giza Plateau. Step over to the Grand Egyptian Museum, a newly opened complex described as the largest archaeological museum in the world and host to more than 100,000 artifacts. Overnight: Marriott Mena House, Cairo

Day CAIRO I FLIGHT TO LUXOR (B,L,D) Visit the vast necropolis of Sakkara, the 14th 4 century Mosque of Sultan Hassan and some of Cairo's ancient Coptic churches. Early this evening transfer to Cairo International Airport for the group flight to Luxor. Check into your hotel then gather for dinner. Overnight: Sofitel Winter Palace Luxor

Day LUXOR (B,L) Take a guided tour through the Karnak Temple Complex— a principal religious center in the New Kingdom-with its massive statues, towering obelisks, intricate hieroglyphics and the Avenue of Sphinxes. Tonight explore the magnificent Luxor Temple and enjoy its illuminated beauty. Dinner is at leisure at the hotel. Overnight: Sofitel Winter Palace Luxor

LUXOR | ESNA - EMBARKATION | NILE Day RIVER (B,L,D) Venture to the hallowed grounds of the Valley of the Kings, an ancient burial site of many influential Egyptian pharaohs and other prominent figures. Admire the Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut, a multi-story structure built to honor one of the few female pharaohs of the New Kingdom. Overnight: Dahabiya

Day EDFU | NILE (B,L,D) Join your Egyptologist

for a guided tour to the necropolis at El Kab. Continue to Edfu to tour the Ptolemaic Temple of Horus—the most complete and best-preserved temple in Egypt. The remainder of the day is at leisure to rejuvenate aboard the dahabiya. The elegantly appointed staterooms are a tranquil oasis after full days of exploration. Overnight: Dahabiya

Day EDFU | NILE | KOM OMBO (B,L,D) Visit Gebel el-Silsila, an ancient quarry where 8 pharaohs excavated sandstone and limestone blocks to build their temples and monuments. Return to the dahabiya to

unwind during an afternoon of sailing. Join a discussion with one of the Egyptologists or kick back on a plush lounger gazing at the scenery passing by. Tonight enjoy a special barbecue dinner on a nearby island. Overnight: Dahabiya

KOM OMBO I NILE (B,L,D) Explore the Day fascinating temple of Kom Ombo. Return to 9 the dahabiya for a final night of sailing, and partake in a special gala dinner on board. Overnight: Dahabiya

NILE - DISEMBARKATION | ASWAN (B,L) Day Tour Aswan High Dam. Later, take a 10 motorboat ride to Agilkia, site of the temples of Philae dedicated to the goddess Isis. Enjoy time at the hotel before exploring Aswan's famous market, Sharia Overnight: Sofitel Legend Old Cataract Aswan


Day ASWAN (B,D) Visit Elephantine Island to explore its UNESCO World Heritage 11 archaeological sites. The remainder of today is at leisure. Overnight: Sofitel Legend Old Cataract Aswan

Day **ASWAN | OPTIONAL ABU SIMBEL** EXCURSION | FLIGHT TO CAIRO (B,L,D) 12

Optional excursion guests fly round-trip between Aswan and Abu Simbel. Other quests enjoy a morning at leisure before the afternoon return flight to Cairo. Gather for a special farewell dinner. Overnight: Le Méridien Cairo Airport

Day CAIRO | DEPART FOR U.S. (B) Use the skybridge conveniently connecting the 13 hotel to Terminal 3 of Cairo International Airport for flights home.

Day +3 CAIRO I ALEXANDRIA After breakfast take a pleasant three-hour drive to Alexandria. Built under the reign of Alexander the Great, Alexandria is the playground for Egypt's elite, enriched with a spirit that is more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern. During a guided tour visit the Roman Amphitheatre, the famous Catacombs, and the Citadel of Qaitbay. The remainder of the day is free to explore the city. Overnight: Steigenberger Cecil Hotel (B,L)

Day +4 ALEXANDRIA This morning visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization, featuring exhibits spanning from prehistoric times to the present, a vast archaeological display and a royal mummies gallery. Afterward explore the architecturally stunning Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a recently constructed, modern interpretation of its ancient predecessor. This structure features four museums, a planetarium and can accommodate up to eight million books. The afternoon and evening are free to relax at the property or venture into town.


