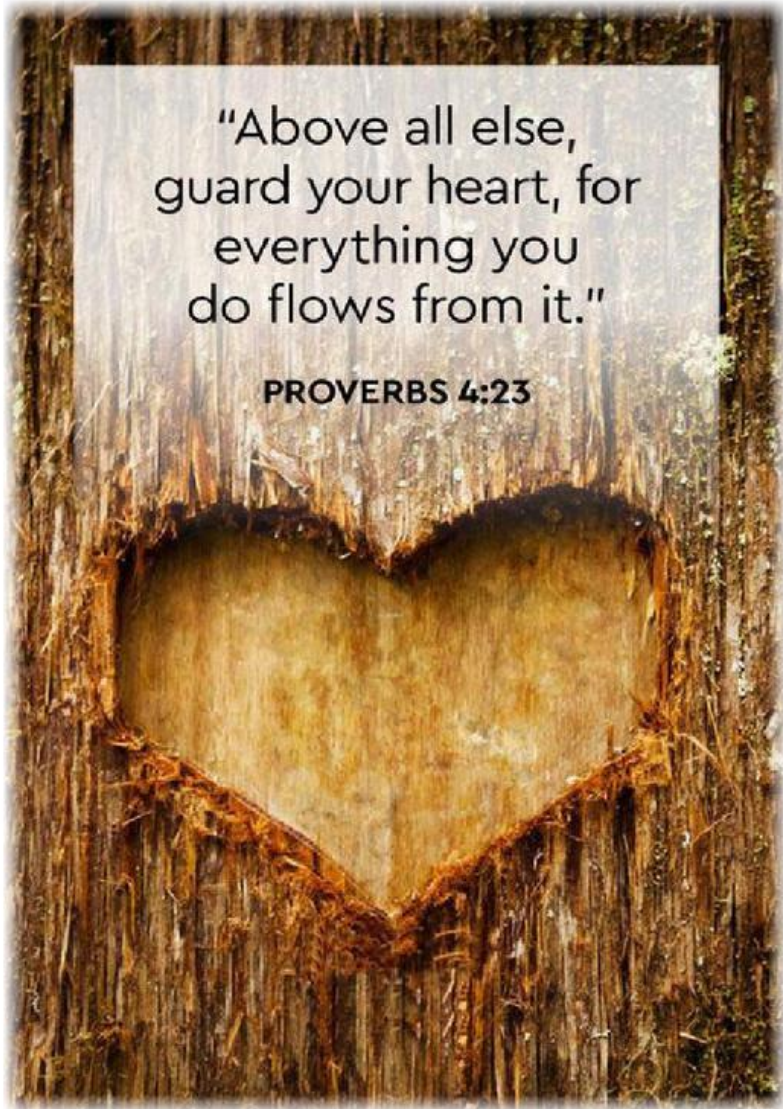





Instead, it will often result in mixture and confusion which may easily lead one into the realm of tainted wisdom spoken of in James 3:15.

Relying on anything outside of God's wisdom is like using a band aid to treat a mortal wound. God rebuked people for doing exactly this:

Jeremiah 6:14, NLT They offer superficial treatments for my people's mortal wound. They give assurances of peace when there is no peace.

Ezekiel 13:10, ESV Precisely because they have misled my people, saying, "Peace," when there is no peace, and because, when the people build a wall, these prophets smear it with whitewash.

To a deeper point: Some things might appear to resolve issues but they are not leading people to Christ. Some drugs/herbs seem to treat certain symptoms or ailments, but is that going to cause someone to live under the sway of Pharmacia? Some aspects of yoga and alternative spiritual practices can allegedly cure depression and help with various discomforts, but does this cause them to tap into a foreign spiritual source or idol? If God left people alone to find their own fixes, they may find some- but never find Him. Perhaps this explains and proves God's mercy in allowing certain trials and tribulations that are coming upon the earth.

A labyrinth is an ancient spiritual tool designed to foster contemplation and spiritual transformation. Labyrinths are typically formed as a circle with a singular path leading to a center and constructed out of a wide range of materials.



In modern culture, the terms “labyrinths” and “maze” were used interchangeably, but contemplative labyrinths are distinct from mazes in a key way. As Lauren Artress says, “A maze is designed to make you lose your way, while a labyrinth is designed to help you find your way.” Labyrinths lead you to a center, designed to increase wisdom and discernment; mazes, in contrast, are constructed to be confusing, leading you toward unforeseen dead ends and barriers.

After reading this small paragraph, I felt the Spirit of God witness truth to my situations. I couldn’t help but to take a moment to process.

Though labyrinths can be employed as spiritual tools in countless ways, there is a distinctively Christian interpretation: the labyrinth as a representation and embodiment of the Christian arc from “sin to redemption.” Additional interpretations of the labyrinth include walking the path Jesus Christ walked, finding the “mystery of Christ who is the center of faith” and life for Christian people, a “discipline of prayer,” and a “living symbol of the journey of faith in a sinful, broken world.” In Christianity, the labyrinth helps pilgrims connect to Christ’s sustaining, redeeming love.

Who would’ve thought a labyrinth could mean so much spiritually? God is good. I found this information immediately and it spoke to my spirit man in such a way I could not deny, God was trying to reveal the purpose of this labyrinth (wisdom, discernment, revelation and more). Humility and Dying to Self (Part 17)

“He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death.” (Philippians 2:8)

Humility is the path to death, because in death it gives the highest proof of perfection. Humility is the blossom of which death to self is the perfect fruit. Jesus humbled Himself unto death and opened the path; in which we too, must enter and pass through. It is here that the teaching is needed.

If you want to enter into full fellowship with Christ in His death, and know the full deliverance from self, humble yourself. This is your one duty. Place yourself before God in your utter helplessness. Consent heartily to the fact of your weakness to slay or make yourself alive. Sink down into your own nothingness, in the spirit of the meek and patient and trustful surrender to God. Accept every humiliation, look upon every fellow-man who tries or vexes you, as a means of grace to humble you. Use every opportunity of humbling your fellow-men as a help to remain humble before God.

When you are truly humble you are on a path that leads to perfect death, and the full and perfect experience that we are dead in Christ.

Prophetic Impartation in Faith, Healing, Signs, Wonders, and Miracles

Prophetic impartation is the gifts of the Holy Spirit, defined as having to do with giving and receiving spiritual gifts, blessings, healings, and baptism in the Holy Spirit, for the work of the ministry. It is the transfer of these "gifts" from one person of God to another, especially through the laying on of hands. God has called us all to have a prophetic gift.

In 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 Now there are different gifts, but one Spirit. 5 There are different ways to serve, but one Lord. 7 Each is given a special manifestation of the Spirit for the good of others. 8 To some God gives the word of wisdom by the Spirit, and to others by the same Spirit the word of knowledge; 9 To others, faith through the same Spirit; to others, and by the same Spirit, gifts to heal the sick; 10 To others, miraculous powers, to others prophecy, to others to discern spirits, to others to speak in various tongues, and to others to interpret tongues. 11 All this is done by the same Spirit, who distributes to each one as he determines.

The Holy Spirit gives us all different gifts to use in different areas. All believers have been given saving faith from God as the only means of salvation (Ephesians 2:8-9), but not all believers have been given the spiritual gift of faith. Like all gifts of the Holy Spirit, the spiritual gift of faith was given for the "common good," which means the building up of the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:7). The gift of faith is defined as the special gift by which the Spirit gives Christians extraordinary confidence in God's promises, power, and presence so that they can assume heroic positions for the future of God's work in the church.

The spiritual gift of faith is exhibited by someone with a firm and unwavering trust in God, His Word, and His promises. The spiritual gift of healing is the supernatural manifestation of the Spirit of God, who miraculously brings healing and deliverance from sickness or disease. It is the power of God that destroys the work of sin or the devil in the human body, such as the healings that Jesus and the disciples performed (Matthew 4:24; 15:30; Acts 5:15-16; 28:8-9)

Signs, wonders, and miracles are miracles such as speaking in tongues, visions, healing, rising from the dead, and prophesying. John 10:37-38 Jesus was, "If I do not do the works of my Father, do not believe me; but if I do them, even if you do not believe me, believe the works; so that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I in the Father is in me, and I in the Father."

WHAT TO CLEAN AFTER AN ILLNESS

During convalescence or recovery period after an illness or injury, our bodies are very vulnerable. It takes time for our immune systems to rest and recharge, so it's important to eliminate germs that could spread the illness or lead to reinfection.

DISINFECT SURFACES AND ITEMS – such items like the door knobs, light switches, TV remotes etc. Synthetic air fresheners only cover up odor but essential oils help eliminate odor for a freshness that lasts. Vinegar can kill many harmful pathogens on its own

-- You can make your own essential-oil-cleaner by mixing lemon, cedarwood, lemongrass, balsam fir, cypress, sweet orange and pine. This citrusy and woody blend is perfect for tackling unpleasant odors and packs an antimicrobial punch.

MATTRESS AND PILLOWS – you tend to sweat a lot when you're sick which ends up seeping into your pillows and mattress and leads to staining and odors. An easy way to prevent this is to double up on fitted sheets and pillowcases during the illness. The extra layer will absorb excess sweat and after illness, put pillow cases and mattress cover, and fitted sheets in the washer. Make sure to use hot water in your washer and leave the bed uncovered for a few hours to dry out any moisture that may be lingering on the surface of your mattress.

FRESH AIR – if it's not too cold, open your windows and let in some fresh air. This will dilute the stale air inside, reducing the concentration of any airborne pathogens.

WASH YOUR TOWELS – grab all the towels that have been touched or used during the illness, including bath towels, hand towels and wash cloths and throw them in the washer with the hottest setting. Be sure to wash any bathroom items that have touched your face like makeup brushes and so on, with soap and water.

TOOTHBRUSHES – Many people don't think of their toothbrush after illness, but this is extremely important. It's easier to just throw your toothbrush out and use a new one, especially if you have strep throat. If you are reluctant to throw it away, then use ¼ cup of hydrogen peroxide then soak it for several minutes to kill any lingering bacteria.

REPLACE YOUR AIR FILTER – this will help ensure that the air in your home is clean and healthy. Dispose of the old one so you can be sure those germs won't be recirculating in your home.

CLEAN OR DISPOSE OF THE CLEANING TOOLS – if you use a sponge or paper towels, be sure to throw them out afterward and wash any cleaning cloths you've used in hot water.
