Class of 2023 Seniors, Graduation is Ahead!

Plans are now underway for the Class of 2023's commencement ceremony, set for Sunday, June 4, beginning at 1 p.m. Some important details for this special day include:

- REHEARSAL The mandatory practice for graduation will be at noon on Friday, June 2, in the South Gym. All seniors who plan to participate in the graduation must attend the rehearsal or if they cannot attend must arrange for a stand-in. (Seniors who do not attend rehearsals or have a stand-in will be unable to participate in the ceremony.)
- **DISTRIBUTION** Graduation caps, gowns, honors cords and four tickets (two white & two red) will be distributed following the rehearsal from 2-3:30 p.m. on Friday, June 2, in the South Cafeteria.
- THE BIG DAY Graduates need to be in line at the South Building at noon on Sunday, June 4, for a prompt ceremony starting time of 1 p.m. If the ceremony can be held outside at H-F Stadium, all four tickets can be used for entry.
- WEATHER PERMITTING In the event of inclement weather, the graduation ceremony will be held indoors in the South Gym, which means there will be limited seating. Only the two white tickets given to seniors can be used if the ceremony is moved indoors. For your convenience, whether in the Stadium or South Gym, the graduation ceremony will be streamed and recorded.
