


#### Bee Undertaker

In a honeybee hive, where each insect has a specific job to do, a small number of middle-aged workers serve as undertakers, removing dead bees and debris from the hive. These bees respond to the odor of the dead, finding the bodies among the wiggling living and carrying them sometimes 300 or more feet to drop them outside of the colony. It's solo work done by about 1% of the bees at a time. [Science Daily | December 2021]

#### Ultraviolet Radiation

Our planet's ozone layer — which is located in the stratosphere, about 9 to 18 miles above the earth's surface — protects all life from the sun's ultraviolet radiation. It acts like an invisible shield against harmful UV-B and UV-C rays, which have been linked to skin and eye damage, a reduction in the productivity and quality of crops, and changes in various biological functions for different species. Due to human activity and pollution, however, some atmospheric ozone has been depleted. Naturally occurring events and processes such as volcanic eruptions can also affect ozone levels. That's why the United Nations established International Day For the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, which has occurred every September 16 since 1994.

#### Who is the teddy bear named after?

Theodore "Teddy" Roosevelt was one of America's most beloved Presidents and was the inspiration for the teddy bear. While he did enjoy going bear hunting, his refusal to shoot a bear that someone had captured struck a chord with the nation. They made fun of him about it in political cartoons titled "Teddy and the Bear," but these comics gave a man named Morris Michtom a great idea. He created a plush, stuffed bear and named it Teddy, not knowing at the time that he was creating what would become one of the

most famous and well loved toys in history.

#### Number Place

In the mid-2000s, thanks to its incredible popularity, Sudoku became part of our everyday lexicon. But few people realize that the game has been around since 1979 or that its original name was Number Place. It's believed that the game was invented in the U.S. by a man named Howard Garns. 


