Lectures take place at the Faculty of Psychology, UGM. However, for international class students (IUP), lectures may also be held at foreign universities starting from the 5th semester (student exchange program).

Lectures (144 Credit Units (SKS))

Lectures are conducted over a minimum of 8 semesters (4 years) and a maximum of 10 semesters (5 years), with a tolerance for an extension of up to 2 years.

What is psychology?

Psychology is the science that studies human behavior and its application to the problems faced by individuals. The goal of studying psychology is to provide explanations and insights into human behavior, as well as to make predictions about the likelihood of certain behaviors occurring and to implement behavior modification techniques.

Why should you choose the Faculty of Psychology at UGM?

The Faculty of Psychology at UGM is recognized as one of the leading psychology programs in Indonesia. The learning process utilizes the latest and engaging techniques, with a focus on student-centered learning methods such as discussions, collaborative learning, and problem-based learning.

What are the subjects studied?

Students learn about human behavior, both observable and unobservable, which is a manifestation of the psyche. They study various aspects of human behavior through the lens of human development (from prenatal to old age), social interactions (intrapersonal and interpersonal), and the integration of physical, mental, and spiritual elements. This knowledge forms the basis for understanding various phenomena in the fields of education, clinical practice, industry, organizations, and society as a whole.

Career opportunities

The results of the alumni tracer study show that graduates of the Faculty of Psychology UGM work in various institutions, both in the government and private sectors, both domestically and internationally. Generally, their profiles or roles include counselors, assistant assessors, researchers, assistant managers, consultants, educators, facilitators, program training designers, developers of measurement tools, administrators of psychological tests, and entrepreneurs.

Lecturing and Supporting facilities

The Faculty of Psychology UGM provides various facilities to support the learning process, including the library, Psychodiagnostics Laboratory, and Experimental Psychology Laboratory, as well as sports and arts facilities. In addition to the mentioned facilities, it also has several research units and service units, namely the Center of Indigenous and Cultural Psychology (CICP); Center for Public Mental Health (CPMH); Center for Life-Development (CLSD); Psychological span Consultation Unit (UKP); Human Quality Development Unit (UPKM); Psychodiagnostic Tool Development Unit (UPAP); Research, Community Service, and Publication Development Unit (UP4), Unit, Learning Technology Information Development, and Multimedia Unit (UIPTB).
