Meet the Instructors

SHEIKH ABU SUHAIB BASSAM

Sheikh Abu Suhaib Bassam, a Jordanian of Palestinian origin, began attending the lessons of Sheikh Al-Albani (Rahimahullah) in Jordan from 1992 onwards. He subsequently studied under Sheikh Al-Albani's students and received tazkiyyah from Shaykh Mashhoor Aal Salmaan, Shaykh Ali Al-Halabi, and Shaykh Saleem Al-Hilaali. After completing his undergraduate studies in Manchester, Sheikh Abu Suhaib returned to the UK, where he has been engaged in da'wah for over twenty years, serving as an imam and delivering lectures and khutbahs across the country.



SHEIKH ABU RUMAYSA

Abu Rumaysa Refi Shafi was born and raised in High Wycombe, UK. He is the chairman of WISE (Wycombe Islamic Society) and is deeply active in his local community and masjid. He has translated numerous works—including Ibn Taymiyyah's *The Criterion between the Friends of Allah and the Friends of Shaytan* and *Relief from Distress* (the Dua of Yunus 'alayhi al-Salām), as well as Sheikh Muhammad Ibn Abdul Wahhab's *Kitab-ut-tawhid* & authored *The Spiritual Cure*, an explanation of *Sūrahaḥ-Fātiḥah*. He delivers lectures primarily within his local area.

Born in Denmark, Ustadh Yahya Raaby moved to the UK at a young age and studied under Somali sheyookh before spending approximately two years in the ma'had programme at Masjid An-Nabawi. Fiqh of 'Ibādah

- **Book:** Umdat al-Fiqh – Imām Ibn Qudāmah al-Maqdisi.
- **Rulings of worship:** purification, prayer, zakāh, fasting, and hajj.

Arbaʿīn al-Nawawiyyah (Part 1)

- **Book:** Al-Arbaʿīn al-Nawawiyyah by Imām al-Nawawī.
- **About the Book:** A collection of 42 ahadith that summarise the essential principles of Islam. Each hadith is considered a cornerstone in understanding the religion.

- Topics Covered

- The foundations of faith and sincerity.
- Principles of worship and devotion.
- Dealings with people and moral conduct.

Sirah (Life of the Prophet ﷺ) – Part 1

- **Book:** When the Moon Split* by Ṣafīur-Raḥmān al-Mubārakpūrī.

- **About the Book:** A respected biography of the Prophet ﷺ that presents the story of his life in a simple and engaging style. It covers the key events of the Makkan and Madinan periods, the challenges faced, and the lessons drawn from them.

- Topics Covered:

- The Prophet's birth and upbringing.
- Revelation and the early da'wah in Makkah.
- Persecution of the believers.
- Migration (Hijrah) to Madinah.
- Key battles and treaties.

Aqidah & Manhaj (Part 1)

- Usul al-Sunnah – Imām Aḥmad ibn Ḥanbal:

- Holding firmly to the Qur'an and Sunnah.
- Respecting the Companions of the Prophet ﷺ
- Belief in Qadar (divine decree).
- The attributes of Allah without distortion or denial.
- Avoiding innovations and remaining upon the path of the early generations.

- Tawḥīd:

- The categories of Tawḥīd (Lordship, Worship, Names & Attributes).
- The dangers of shirk (associating partners with Allah).
- Practical examples of Tawḥīd in a Muslim's life.

Syllabus Breakdown

Year-2

Fiqh of Mu'āmalāt

- **Book:** Umdat al-Fiqh – Imām Ibn Qudāmah al-Maqdisī.
- **Topics:**
 - Financial transactions: buying, selling, contracts.
 - Family matters: marriage, divorce, inheritance.
 - Social responsibilities and interactions.

Aqidah & Manhaj (Part 2)

- **Firaq (Sects):**
 - *Bid'ah and Sunnah*: what constitutes innovation and the importance of Sunnah.
 - **Atharīs, Ash'arīs, Mātūrīdīs:**
 - Their history.
 - Main theological positions.
- Differences in understanding Allah's attributes and creed.

Tazkiyat al-Nafs (Purification of the Soul)

- Recognising diseases of the heart: pride, envy, arrogance.
- Cultivating sincerity, humility, patience, reliance on Allah.
- Building a balanced and sound character.

Ta'fiyyah wa-Tarbiyyah

- Based on the writings and lectures of Shaykh al-Albānī (رحمه الله).
- **Taṣfiyyah (Purification):** removing misguidance, false practices, and weak narrations.
- **Tarbiyyah (Nurturing):** building Muslims upon authentic knowledge, sound understanding, and good character.

Sirah (Life of the Prophet ﷺ) – Part 2

- **Book:** When the Moon Split* by Ṣafiur-Raḥmān al-Mubārakpūrī.
- **Topics Covered:**
 - From the expeditions of Ḥunayn and Ṭā'if until the passing of the Prophet ﷺ.
 - His family life, appearance, and character.
 - The Farewell Ḥajj and final days.

Tafsīr

- Selected sūrahs and passages from the Qur'an.
- Lessons related to faith, worship, character, and society.

Arba'in al-Nawawiyyah (Part 2)

- **Book:** Al-Arba'in al-Nawawiyyah by Imām al-Nawawī.
- **Topics Covered:**
 - Ahadith on worship.
 - Social dealings.
 - Comprehensive principles of Islam.

Milestone by end of Year 1

- Understand the key manners and etiquettes of a student of knowledge (Adab Talib al-Ilm).
- Be familiar with the basic rulings of worship in Islam (Fiqh of Ibadah): purification, prayer, zakah, fasting, hajj, and umrah.
- Gain a clear overview of the Prophet's ﷺ life from his birth up to the Conquest of Makkah.
- Learn the essential principles of Islamic creed through Usul al-Sunnah and develop a firm understanding of Tawhid.
- Memorise (optional) and understand approximately the first half of Arba'in al-Nawawiyyah, covering core principles of belief, worship, and conduct.

Milestone by end of Year 2

- Understand key rulings of daily interactions (marriage, divorce, trade, riba, contracts).
- Study selected Qur'an passages through Tafsir for worship and character.
- Build spiritual awareness through Tazkiyat al-Nafs (diseases of the heart, sincerity, humility).
- Learn about the Prophet's ﷺ final years: Hunayn, Ta'if, family, character, and passing.
- Recognise the balance between Tasfiyyah (purification) and Tarbiyyah (nurturing).
- Grasp the concept of Bidah and defend the correct belief.
- Study Atharis, Asharis, and Maturidis: history, beliefs, and differences.
- Memorise (optional) and understand the second half of Arba'in al-Nawawiyyah.

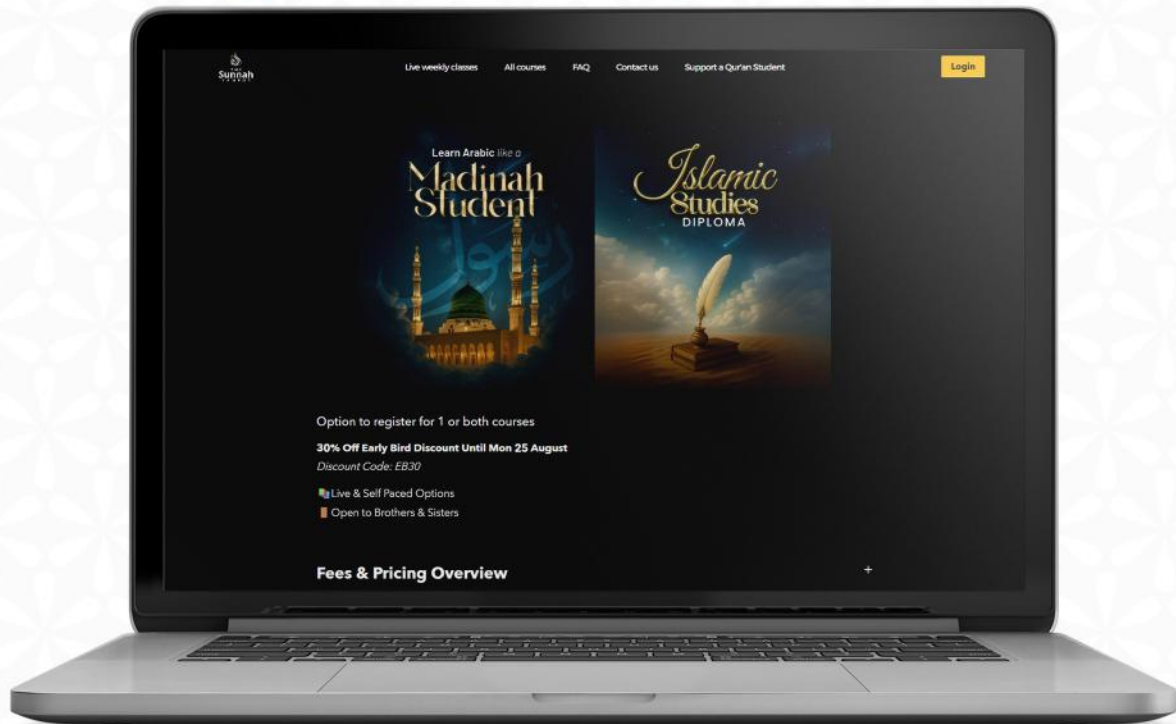
