Stay Informed

- Read credible news sources daily
-] Fact-check information before sharing it
- Stay updated on current events and important issues

Vote & Help Others Vote

- Register to vote and encourage others to do the same
- Volunteer with organizations that help with voter registration
- Remind friends and family about voting deadlines

Contact Your Representatives

- Call, email, or write your elected officials to demand action
- Attend town halls and ask questions
- Hold representatives accountable for their actions (or inactions)

Protest & Demonstrate

-) Join peaceful protests or marches in your community
- Organize a local demonstration or event
- Support others' efforts in peaceful civil disobedience

Support Independent Journalism

- Subscribe to and support investigative media outlets
- Share credible news stories to combat misinformation
- Spread awareness about media organizations that prioritize truth

Protect Civil Rights & Marginalized Communities

-) Volunteer with or donate to organizations defending civil rights
-) Speak up when you see discrimination or injustice
- Support initiatives for racial justice, LGBTQ+ rights, and more

Economic Resistance

- Boycott companies that fund harmful political agendas
-) Support businesses and organizations with values that align with justice
-) Promote ethical consumerism within your community

Build Local Power & Community

-) Organize or participate in local mutual aid groups
- Volunteer for community-based organizations
- Start or join neighborhood networks focused on social justice

Elect Better Leaders

- Volunteer/donate to campaigns of candidates who fight for democracy
- Educate yourself about the platforms of potential candidates
- Encourage others to vote for candidates who represent democratic values

Never Normalize Fascism

- Speak out against authoritarian behavior and harmful rhetoric
-) Challenge apathy and engage others in conversation about democracy
- Share resources to educate others on the importance of democracy

Support Legal Defenders & Judges Fighting Back

- Donate to legal defense funds or civil rights organizations
- Share the work of attorneys and judges who are defending democracy
- Write letters of encouragement to legal defenders and judges

Support Elected Officials Who Are Fighting Back

-) Volunteer for campaigns of elected officials standing up for justice
-) Write letters to support their work and achievements
-) Share their efforts on social media to raise awareness

Express Discontent with Non-Fighting Elected Officials

-) Organize or attend protests to demand accountability
-) Write letters or make phone calls to express your discontent
- Challenge or support efforts to recall unresponsive officials

Create & Join Virtual Movements

- Join or create online petitions advocating for change
- Share your activism on social media and encourage others to join
- Participate in or host virtual events to mobilize and educate others

Use Technology to Hold Power to Account
