



Leni Riefenstahl is considered one of the most controversial women of the 20th century. Her films TRIUMPH OF THE WILL and OLYMPIA stand for perfectly staged body worship and the celebration of the superior and victorious. At the same time, these images project contempt for the imperfect and weak. Riefenstahl's aesthetics are more present than ever today - but is that also true for their implied message? The film examines this question using documents from Riefenstahl's estate, including private films, photos, recordings and letters. It uncovers fragments of her biography and places them in an extended historical context. How could Riefenstahl become the Reich's preeminent filmmaker and keep denying any closer ties to Hitler and Goebbels? In personal documents, she mourns her "murdered ideals". Riefenstahl represents many postwar Germans who, in letters and recorded telephone calls from her estate, dream of an organizing hand that will finally clean up the "shit-hole state". Then, her work would also experience a renaissance, in a generation or two this time could come - what if they are right?

PANGOLIN

JOURNEY TO FREEDOM

Here is the story of Kosha, an orphaned Temminck's, or ground pangolin, from Zimbabwe. She's a small, harmless, scaly, ant-eating mammal with a ridiculously long tongue. Kosha was rescued from poachers in 2017 and taken to the Tikki Hywood Foundation when she was a pup. Here she was raised by caring humans and released back into the wild. Now fully grown, Kosha offers her main carers, Lisa, Ellen and Luke, a rare glimpse into her secret life. So little is known about pangolins in the wild. Six years of ups and downs – of life and death situations, of previously unknown pangolin behaviour culminating in the birth of her first pup, give Lisa, Ellen and Luke the clues they need to fill in some of the missing gaps in pangolin science. And those revelations will make a big difference to the liberation and survival of the many rescued pangolins to follow.

El Salvador is the smallest country in Central America and its last secret natural and animal paradise. The large national parks are home to uniquely green volcanic craters and turquoise-blue crater lakes rich in fish. From the north to the central plateau to the south, with its black coast and lava-formed coral reef, El Salvador is a true wildlife and natural discovery. Fantastic landscapes of savannas, forest-covered high mountains, cloud and rain forests and mangrove areas underline the diversity of this small country. The documentary shows how pumas are resettling in El Salvador, crocodiles lay eggs in the mangroves, the green sea turtle is observed in its reproduction and rattle snakes, spider monkeys and yellow-naped parrots find their natural habitats here.
