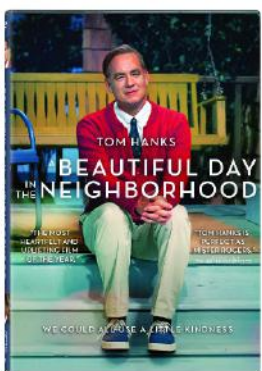

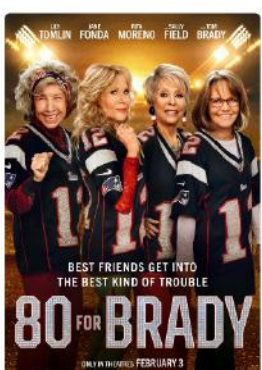
Monday, January 13 • Out to Sea (1997) • Comedy, Romance

Ronald Regan Museum, Eureka

In the fall of 1928 a young man from Dixon, Illinois, enrolled as a freshman at Eureka College. He became an active participant in many phases of campus life, culminating in his role as President of the student body as a senior. He was destined to become a prominent motion picture star, the Governor of California, and the 40th President of the United States of America .

Housed in the Donald B. Cerf Center at Eureka College, the Ronald Regan Museum collection has over 10,000 items from the President's Eureka College student days, his movie and TV career, his governorship of California and two terms as president of the United States. The Reagan Peace Garden located on the historic campus includes a bust of the 40th president and a section of the Berlin Wall. Peoria Historical Society – Pettengill – Morron House Museum

Pettengill-Morrison House was built in 1868 for Moses Pettengill (1802-1883) in the Second Empire architectural style. A Colonial Revival porch and porte cochere were added in about 1900 giving the house a grand Victorian appearance. After the death of its last occupant Jean McLean Morrison (1879-1966) the trustees of her estate gave the house and her family collection of mid-18th to mid-20th century furnishings, artwork, artifacts and textiles to the Peoria Historical Society. Operated today as a historic house museum, the collection also includes objects of former occupants including the Pettengill family. The house was listed on the U. S. National Register of Historic Places in 1976. **Please sign up and pay by March 13.**

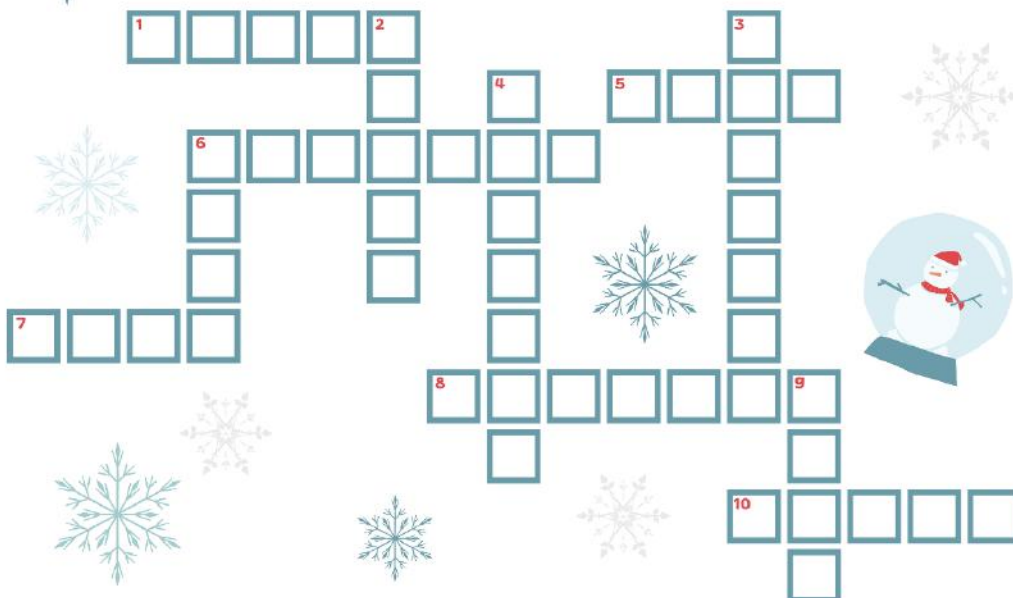

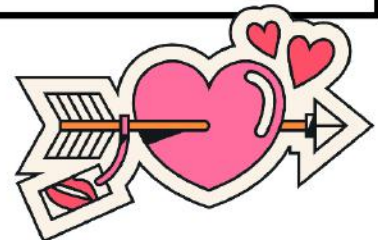

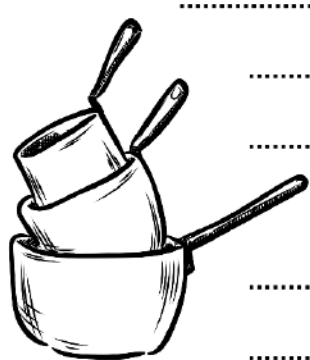
