what you need to know a designer or an architect

Independent of you project type, scale, or professional qualifications of the consultant you wish to hire

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there is considerable overlap and dependency between the **design** services offered by interior designers and architects

for construction, and the contractor prices the execution

The designer then documents it in a specific, suitable way of the design and builds it according to those documents.

what is design

"Design" is what the designer and client make together.

All design meets this definition, whether it is a standard service, Dochia-microservice or nanoservice, or any other form that any other designer would present you with.

Designers "make and give" the design to the contractor based on the client's list of needs.





what is design

"Design" is not a product, but *a process*. What you are buying when hiring a designer or architect is their process.

The **"Design solution"** is the outcome of that process.

The **"Drawings"** are the documents that explain the solution and are finalized after the design solution is approved. **"Design"** means the "drawings" that deliver a solution.

how long does design take

The design part for commercial or large buildings renovation can take anywhere from 4 months to 6 months plus.

The design part for any new built that requires permit is a minimum of 5-8 months and can be 2 years plus for large developments.

The design part for residential renovation can take anywhere from 4 weeks to 4 months plus.

A few weeks... at most a few months...



Some designers have the capacity to take on part of these roles. When done, it is sometimes a separate service, since some of the tasks are outside the mainstream scope of interior design.

design vs management

The designer is not the project manager nor the construction manager. These are separate services by separate professionals with distinct roles, tasks, and responsibilities.



The designer will design as well as deal with the contractor, engineers and everyone. They are the ones that take care of everything.



the design process

Clients are active members of the design team and work together with the designer to advance the process.

The design solutions are *always* the result of a

vision, ideas, and decisions between the two.

The client is a semi-passive observer.

Is a browsing and ideation process with meetings to discuss ideas, materials, options that the designer presents, and the client will select from.



Standard design/construction process

The client's **"wish list"** is one variable^{!!} of many that the designer uses to establish the "to do list" of the project.



Designers only provide part of the services you need to build. Other professionals will be needed.



The fees & services are based on the designer's "to do list," not on the client's "wish list."

> *!! Variables are assumed, thus important to be* reviewed by client. Example: number of revisions and meetings, how long they are, how many design solutions will be discussed...

Client's "wish list" is what the designer will price and provide design for.

Contractor will then build.

Standard design/construction process

Has 8 steps, all critical and indispensable: (4) design documentation (drawings and specifications), (8) furniture purchases & install.

(1) Pre-design, (2) concept design, (3) design development, (5) costing, (6) construction, (7) Furniture & decor selections,

> The designer is highly involved in 2, 3, 4, and 7. Their extent of involvement in 1, 5, 6, and 8 varies.

Neither microservices nor standard services will give you a 100% complete package at step 4 because such a package does not exist. The construction packages are only one information component required to quote and build.

These steps are independent of the scale of the project.



Standard design/construction process

to evaluate and make firm progressive decisions. Changing your mind or adding new avenues to explore generate "extras".

The designer guides steps 1 through 3 and presents

"progress documents" to illustrate proposed solutions. But to move forward, the responsibility lies with the client

A comprehensive approval is needed for the designer to proceed with (4) the design documents.



Clients are fully responsible for step (1) but often unable to complete it on their own.

The designer is the professional, hence does all the work.



Standard design/construction process

While the overall process structure is relatively common, steps 1, 2, 3, and 4 have significant discrepancies between what certain designers provide you with versus others.

The level of "completion" of the documents and information you need to build can also vary greatly.

Good (4) design documents are expected to cover 80% to 85% of the decisions needed for construction.

The designers are all following same process.

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In residential projects designers are not highly involved all the way to the very end unless you want "soup-to-nuts." A good designer will give you the high-level designstrategy, then guide the process up to a certain point, after which you should expect that some of the decisions, drawings, and detail-work will be done by suppliers and trades – with or without the designer's review or overseeing of the work.
