DAY 1 – November 11 2027: LIMA ARRIVAL

Upon arrival at our destination, a representative will pick up passengers and take them from the airport to their hotel Accommodation: Aloft Lima Miraflores (3 Nights): Urban & Breezy Guest Room

DAY 2 – November 12 2027: LIMA (B)

DAY 3 – November 13 2027: LIMA (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private | Full Day Discovering the oracle of Pachacamac and Lima City Tour + Barranco

Pachacamac was the main sanctuary on the central coast of Peru in pre-Hispanic times. It was occupied by various civilizations and cultures for almost 1,000 years and today it is a living example of the country's rich cultural past. Before arriving at Pachacamac, we will tour part of modern Lima passing through the districts of Miraflores, Barranco and Chorrillos, the latter known for its close relationship with the sea. We will make a stop at the famous Santo del Fraile, a rock formation that offers a spectacular view of the Lima coast. Arriving at Pachacamac is like returning to the past among its adobe walls, temples, and plazas. In ancient times, Pachacamac was considered an accurate oracle capable of predicting the future and unleashing the fury of the earth (remember that Lima is a city prone to strong earthquakes), which is why it received hundreds of pilgrims who came from all over in search of answers to their troubles and to pay their respects. We will visit both the archaeological site and its modern museum, where we will appreciate the chronology of the occupation of Pachacamac, as well as archaeological pieces found during the excavations such as idols, ceramic offerings, and Inca quipus.

At the end, we will return to Lima to enjoy a tasty lunch at Huaca Pucllana Restaurant.

After lunch, we will delve into Lima's rich colonial past, exploring iconic landmarks such as the Government Palace, the Cathedral, and the Archbishop's Palace in the heart of the Plaza de Armas.

Then, we will go to Barranco District but first we will make a stop at Miraflores to take some pictures with Paddington Bear!

Visit the iconic Bridge of Sighs, immortalized in song by Chabuca Granda, and soak in the district's artistic energy. Our day will conclude with a delightful visit to El Cacaotal, where we'll savor the rich flavors of Peruvian chocolate or coffee while uncovering the stories behind these local treasures. Before wrapping up, we'll explore charming local art shops to find the perfect souvenir to mark this vibrant day in Lima.

DAY 4 – November 14 2027: LIMA – CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. At the scheduled time, a representative will accompany us during the transfer from the hotel to the airport. (Flight not included)

Upon our arrival at the destination, a representative will transfer us from the airport to your hotel.

On the way , you will visit Awanacancha Center where is a cultural and artisan center located in the Sacred Valley of the Incas, Peru. It is known for preserving traditional Andean textile techniques. Here you will learn about the traditional weaving process, from spinning and natural dyeing to loom weaving. Also you will see South American camelids up close, such as alpacas, llamas, vicuñas, and guanacos

At the end of the visit continue to your hotel.

DAY 5 – November 15 2027: SACRED VALLEY (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private | Full Day Pisac market and ruins & Ollantaytambo.

Today, we will learn about the tradition and history of the Sacred Valley, the traces left by its ancient inhabitants, and the culture of its current towns. We will stop at 3,200 meters above sea level. at the Taray viewpoint, from where we can obtain a stunning panoramic view of the valley. We will reach the top of the Apu Inti Huatana hill where we will find the archaeological complex of Pisac, which houses dazzling stone platforms and offers a privileged view of the traditional town that bears the same name. Walking through its buildings we will see why it is one of the most relevant in the valley, both for its urban planning (very advanced for its time) and for the variety of environments or “neighborhoods” dedicated to religious ceremonies, rooms, and temples. We will also visit Pisac town, characterized by its quiet streets and its market where it proudly lives its millenary heritage represented in its textile art, ceramics, jewelry pieces and other handicrafts. We will enjoy a delicious typical lunch in a local restaurant before continuing the tour to Ollantaytambo, an ancient military, religious, and agricultural center of the Incas. Strategically located on a mountain, its imposing fortress is a sample of all the Inca power. We will visit the main temple, terraces, and fountains while enjoying an unbeatable view of the town, the only one that maintains the original Inca urban design and which we can also visit to see its stone streets, its market and breathe the spirit of the Andes.

DAY 6 – November 16 2027: SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. At the scheduled time, a representative will accompany us during the transfer from the Hotel to Ollanta Station. (Train ticket included)

One of the most important tourist landmarks in the world awaits us: Machu Picchu! Our adventure will begin aboard the train to Aguas Calientes, also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo, a picturesque town at the foot of the emblematic Inca citadel. During the train ride we can enjoy the natural beauty of the surroundings, with impressive views of majestic mountains, the Vilcanota river and small towns of the Peruvian Andes; a visual feast that fills us with anticipation for the visit to the wonder that is Machu Picchu.

Private | Full Day Machu Picchu

After a short bus ride from Aguas Calientes we will find ourselves in front of one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World – an unforgettable sight! From there, we will explore the ancient ruins, learning all about the history and mysteries that this mystical and impressive place holds. Surrounded by incomparable landscapes, there will be no shortage of spectacular photo opportunities! Once we have recharged ourselves with the magical energy of Machu Picchu, we will return to Aguas Calientes where we will have free time to have lunch and check in at your hotel to have a leisure and relax time. Dinner at Chullos Restaurant on your own.

DAY 7 – November 17 2027: MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, you have a second chance to explore the marvelous Machu Picchu on your own and discover the treasures it holds for you! Entrance & round trip bus ticket included

At schedule time, return to Aguas Calientes train station to board your return train to Ollanta Station. (Train ticket included). At the scheduled time, you will be picked up from Ollanta Station to transfer us to the Hotel in Cusco

DAY 8 – November 18 2027: CUSCO (B)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private | Half Day City tour, San Pedro market & nearby ruins.

This charming half-day tour of Cusco offers us history, living culture and art. We will be able to appreciate how the Andean and Spanish cultures, as well as the past and the present, coexist in harmony in the Imperial City. We will arrive at the center to walk the halls of the San Pedro market, the oldest in the city. Designed in 1925 by Gustave Eiffel, today it brings together hundreds of merchants selling local products. We will also visit the Koricancha temple, which during the Inca empire was a center of worship of the Sun and on which the Santo Domingo convent was later built as part of the evangelization process. Its baroque style façade built on solid Inca walls perfectly summarizes the syncretism of cultures in the city of Cusco. To appreciate the greatness of the Incas, we will ascend to the monumental fortress of Sacsayhuaman, which with its enormous carved stone walls constitutes one of the best examples of Inca military architecture. We will tour the archaeological center of Kenko, a ceremonial place where the sun, the moon and the stars were worshiped. We couldn't take a tour of the city without visiting the Cathedral, the most important temple in the city. It was built by the Spanish on top of the palace of the Inca Huiracocha. Its interior houses a wonderful collection of colonial art composed of goldsmith pieces and representative canvases of the Cusco School of Art.

DAY 9 – November 19 2027: CUSCO - LIMA DEPARTURE (B/D)

Breakfast at the hotel. At the scheduled time, a representative will accompany us during the transfer from the hotel to the airport. (Flight not included)

Upon arrival at our destination, a representative will pick up passengers and take them from the airport to Larco Museum. First we will make a stop in a restaurant in Miraflores to have lunch (on your own)

At the end, we will have the experience of Larco Museum. Our journey continues at the renowned Larco Museum, which boasts an impressive collection of nearly 45,000 pre-Hispanic artifacts, including intricate Moche ceramics and the famed erotic collection.

We'll enjoy dinner at the museum's charming café before heading to Lima Airport to board your flight to home.
