Golf at Le Kempferhof


DAY 3 Golf at St. Leon-Rot

Speyer & Mannheim

Arrive in the historic town of Speyer in the morning, known for its rich medieval heritage. From here, you'll transfer to the renowned St. Leon-Rot Golf Club, a top golfing destination near Heidelberg.



After your round, rejoin the ship in Mannheim, where it will remain docked for the rest of the day. Take time to relax on board or explore Mannheim's charming streets before the ship departs late at night.











DAY 4

Rüdesheim & Koblenz

Start the day in the charming town of Rüdesheim, where you'll transfer to the scenic Jakobsberg Golf Resort. Perched above the Rhine Valley, this course offers a unique golfing experience surrounded by forests and vineyards, with stunning views of the UNESCO-listed Upper Middle Rhine Valley, including the famous Lorelei Rock.

After your game, rejoin the ship in Koblenz, one of Germany's oldest towns. Take time to explore Koblenz's historic center or visit the impressive Ehrenbreitstein Fortress before enjoying a relaxing evening as the ship continues its journey along the Rhine.





SCENIC CRUISING AND COCHEM EXPLORATION

Rejoin the ship in the evening and continue the journey to Cologne.

- Qolf Club St. Leon-Rot
 Near Heidelberg, St. Leon-Rot offers two 18-hole
 championship courses, a 9-hole executive course,
 and a children's course. Designed by Dave Thomas
 and Hannes Schreiner, the club is known for its linksstyle features and signature island greens. It's a
 "Leading Golf Course in Germany" and an
 "European Tour Destination."
- 3 Jakobsberg Golf Resort
 Set atop the Lorelei Valley between Koblenz and
 Mainz, this 18-hole course, designed by Robert Trent
 Jones Jr., offers stunning views of the UNESCO-listed
 Rhine Valley. It features challenging fairways,
 bunkers, and water hazards, blending natural beauty
 with a dynamic golf experience.
- Golf & Country Club Gut Velderhof
 Situated 30 minutes from Cologne, Gut Velderhof
